

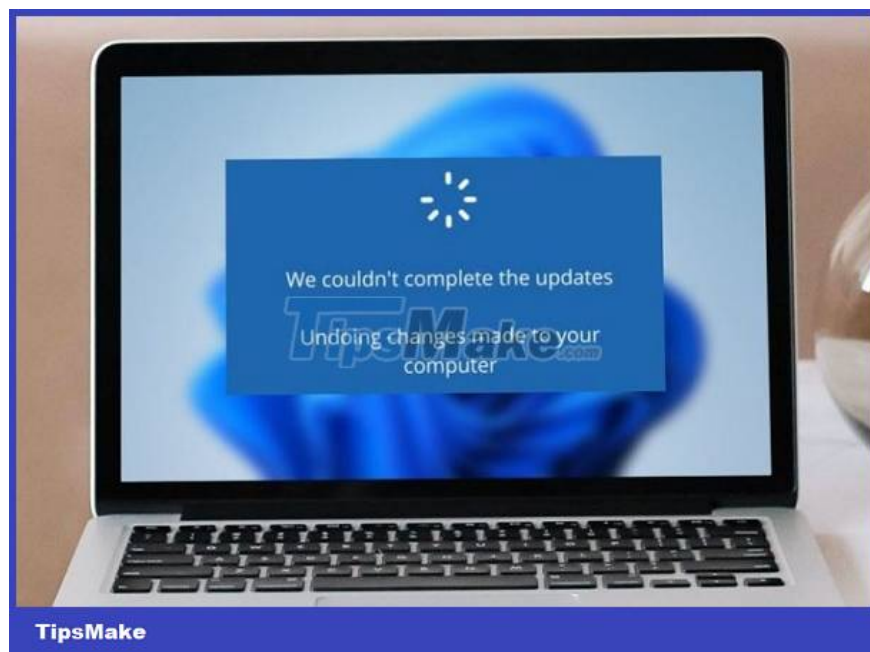

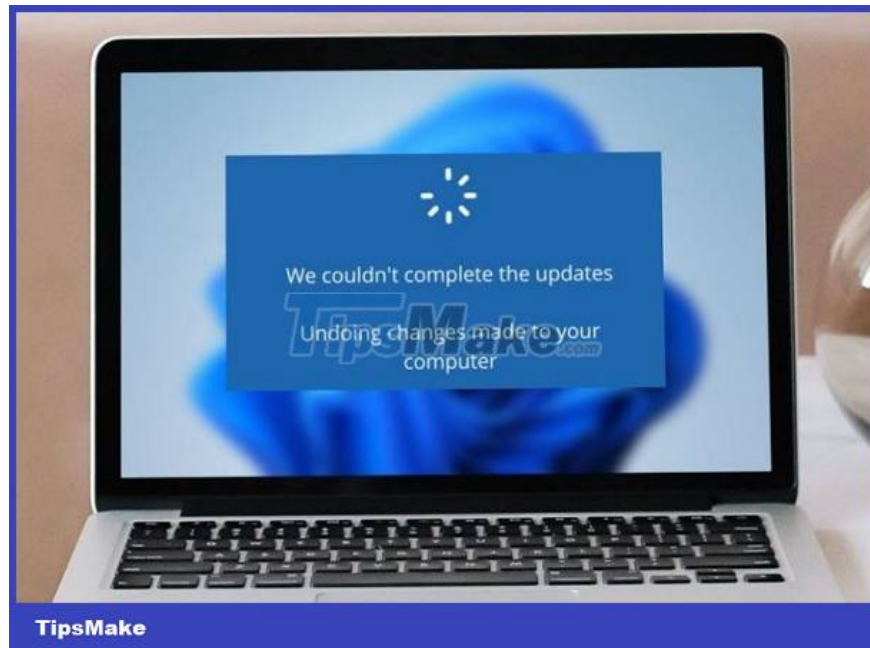

Cause and how to fix Computer error Undoing changes made to your computer

What is undoing changes made to your computer? First, we can see that the undoing changes made to your computer error on Windows 11/10 is a notification of an update problem. It is very difficult to determine the cause of the computer crash. Undoing changes made to your computer. It's possible that the Windows Update service stopped working during the update process. Or suddenly turns off during the update process, or system files are corrupted.

Here are some ways for you to apply and fix the undoing changes made to your computer error on Windows 10/11.

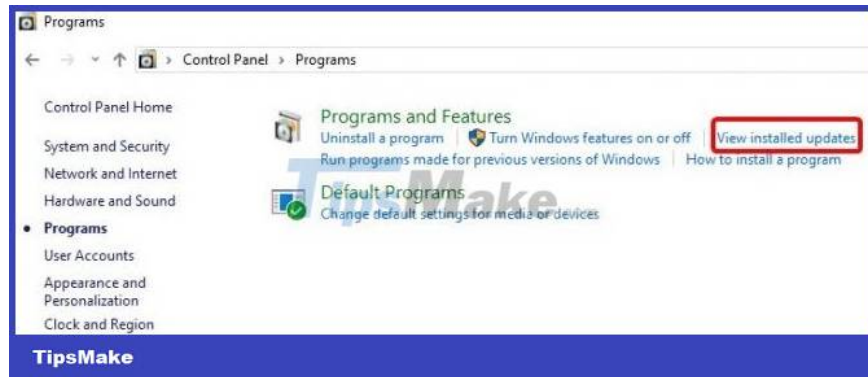
NOTE: You should not try to force reboot the device first as this will only make the problem worse and you could be stuck in a reboot loop for a long time.

1/ Turn off your PC and turn off the wifi connection

It sounds quite 'strong' but you can first disconnect the wifi by unplugging the router to turn off the wifi > Then turn the connection back on and turn the system back on to see if the error is fixed or not. Not yet.

In this case, the user can restart the computer as usual. You need to run the system file checker to repair problematic files as follows:

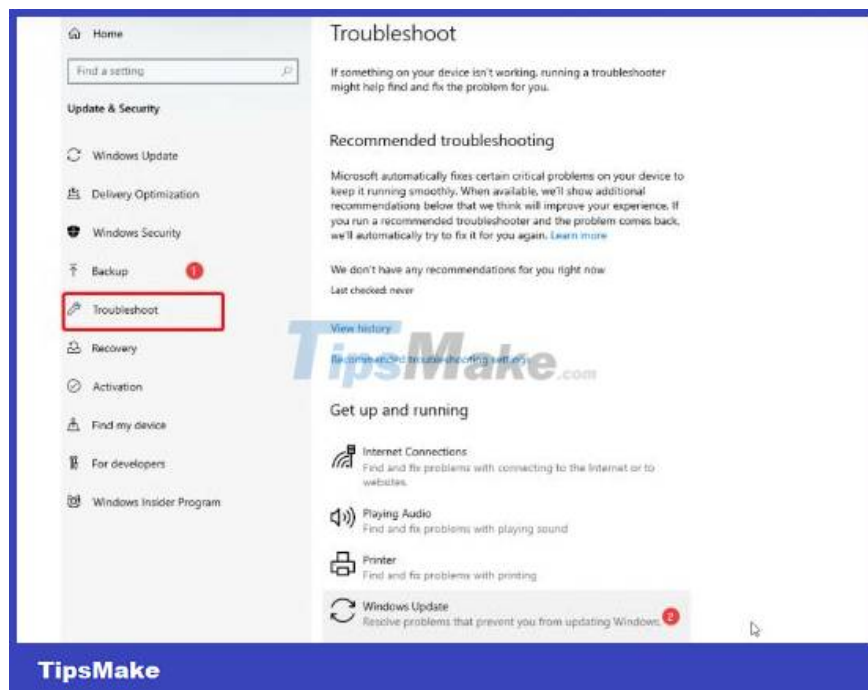
1. **Step 1** : Click on the magnifying glass search icon > Then type cmd and open **Command Prompt (Admin)** by clicking on the line as shown.

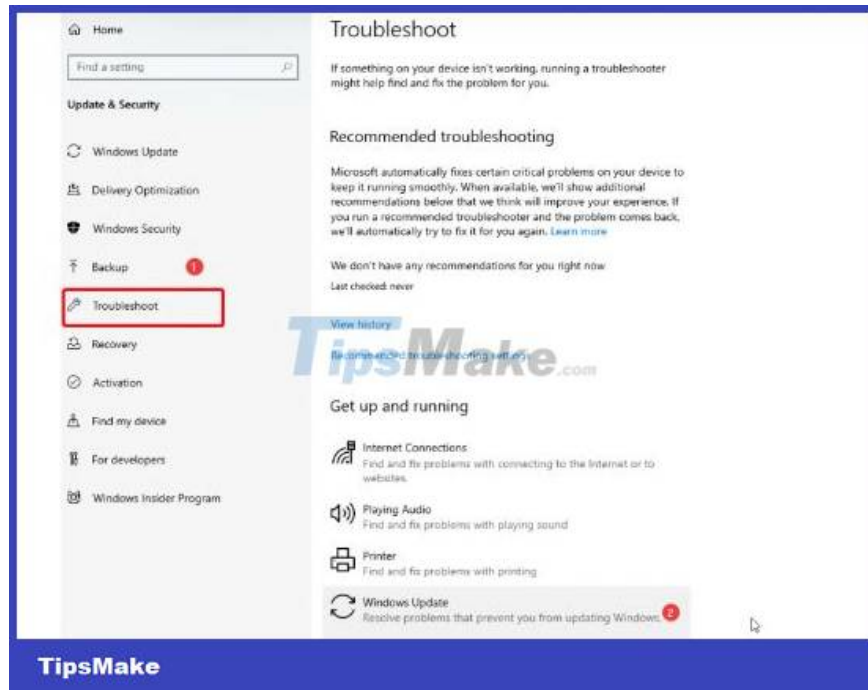


1. **Step 3** : A list of Windows updates will display > Click to select and uninstall the most recent version > Restart Windows and check for problems.

3/ Run the Windows Update Troubleshooter

What you need to do is: Press the key combination **Windows + I** > **Update & Security** > **Troubleshoot** > **Windows Update** > **Run the troubleshooter** .

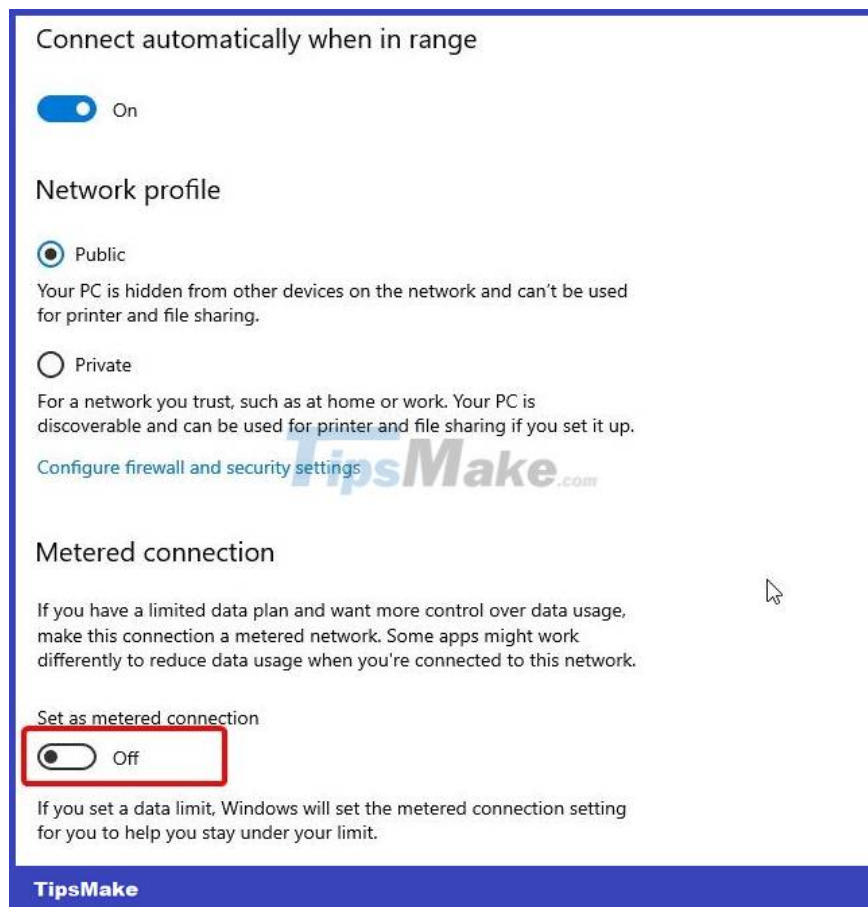




Then, follow the prompts on the screen > After completing this process, restart the computer and see if the error still occurs!

4/ Turn off Windows automatic updates

1. Continue pressing **Windows + I** to open settings > Select **Network & Internet** > Next, select **Status** in the list on the left.
2. **Click on the Change connection properties link** > Find the **Metered connection** section > Enable this section and you're done.



Note:

If the error Undoing changes made to your computer does not open the computer, it continues to occur. You should scan and remove viruses if any, check and update drivers, install Windows updates manually. If that doesn't work anymore, bring your device to a trusted laptop repair center for a technician to help you!
