

# Configure Diablo 4 on PC

## Minimum configuration Diablo 4 on PC (720P, 30FPS)

Diablo IV at minimum configuration will attempt to run on hardware with below-minimum specs, including HDDs, dual-core CPUs, and GPUs. However, the game experience can be significantly reduced.

The Open Beta only allows players to take their character up to level 25, from the level 100 cap you can take your character up through the entire gameplay. It also only hangs around the first level of the game, located in the area of ??Fractured Peaks, lasting about five hours of gameplay.

For better or worse, Diablo IV's familiar gameplay loop stays true to what fans expect from a game in the Diablo series. It's most reminiscent of the feel of Diablo III, so those who picked up Diablo II: Resurrect will have a more modern Diablo gameplay once again.

Perhaps the simplest and most impactful addition to the game's gameplay is the addition of dodge abilities to all characters. This is a skill that was once locked to certain character classes. This allows Blizzard to make character actions more frantic and allows them to approach battles with more flexibility. This also makes battles much more dynamic and engaging than before.
