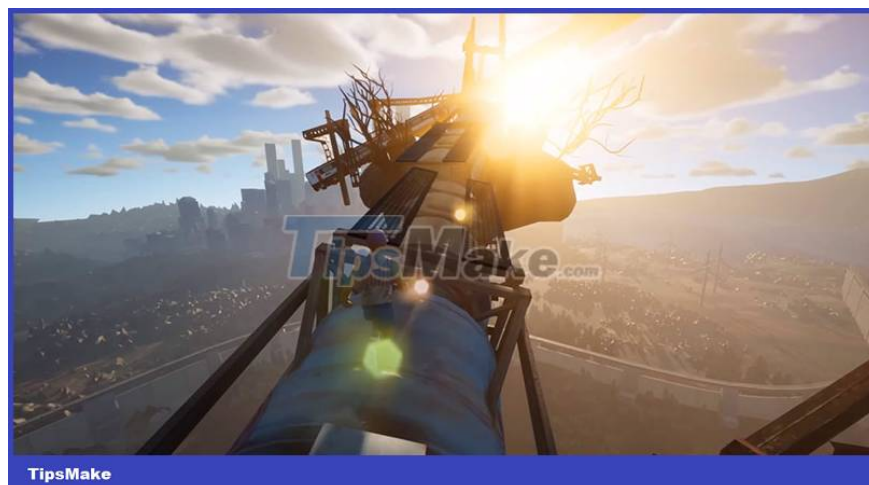

## Only Up is what game? How to play?

Only Up is a 3D game with parkour-style gameplay released on Steam on May 24, 2023.

Only Up will put you in the role of Jackie, a boy who dreams of a better life. He decides to climb a giant bean tree that leads to a mysterious world in the clouds. Along the way, he faces many challenges and uncovers many secrets. He can also use special abilities to slow down time and change his speed. The game is based on the classic fairy tale "Jack and the Beanstalk" but with a modern twist. This is a game that tests your skills and patience, but also gives you a lot of fun and exciting experiences.



1. The goal of the game is very simple, just go through a series of complex roads until the end is clearance.
2. If you've heard of or played 'Jump King' or 'Spelunky' then you're probably familiar with this type of frustrating game.
3. They are very similar in gameplay, but only when 'Only Up' is 3D, with better graphics and models, and works more multidimensionally and realistically than other games.

Games like this usually don't have checkpoints or save games, so if you accidentally slip, you'll fall to the ground and start over. It is similar to the games ALTF4 or Getting Over It.

So when you fall, if you're lucky, you fall in the right place in the obstacle below, you can return to the point you came to in a shorter time. And if you exit the game, you will have to start over from the beginning. This means you have to finish the game in one sitting. According to calculations, if the player finishes quickly, it may only take 40-60 minutes to complete it. While the player may take longer, play when you are not busy.
