

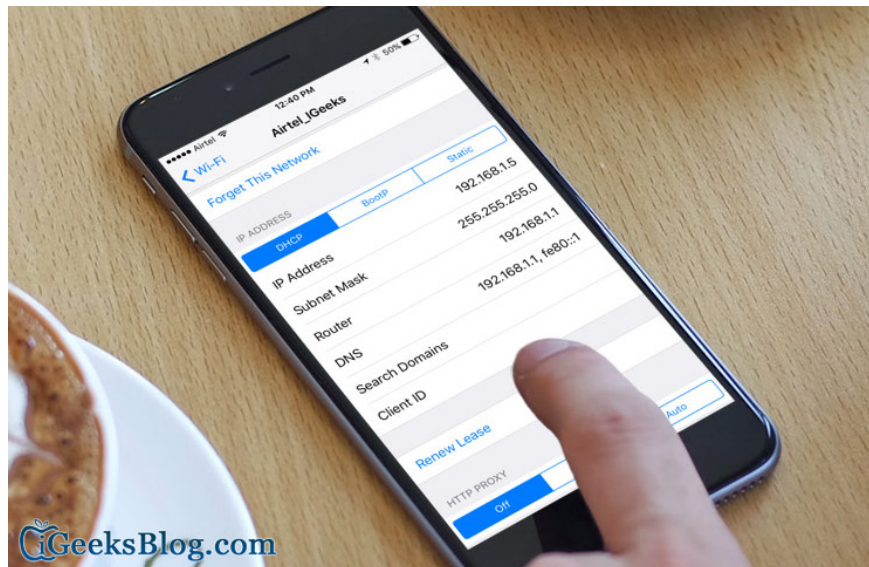
Conflict of IP address error when connecting to Wifi on iPhone, iPad, this is a fix

If you are unable to connect to websites or cannot download any applications, music ... to your device, you are most likely having an IP address conflict error when connecting to Wi-Fi. The cause of the error may be because more than one device on the same network has the same IP address.

Error with IP address conflicts occurs more often on Mac. However, in some cases this error may occur on iPhone and iPad devices.

If you are unable to connect to websites or cannot download any applications, music . to your device, you are most likely having an IP address conflict error when connecting to Wi-Fi. The cause of the error may be because more than one device on the same network has the same IP address.

To fix this error, please refer to the following article of Network Administrator.

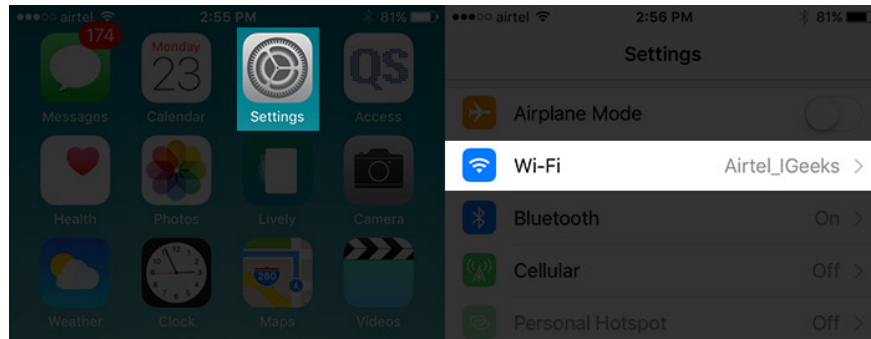


1. Fix IP conflict error during Wifi connection on iPhone

To fix IP conflict error during Wifi connection on iPhone, follow the steps below:

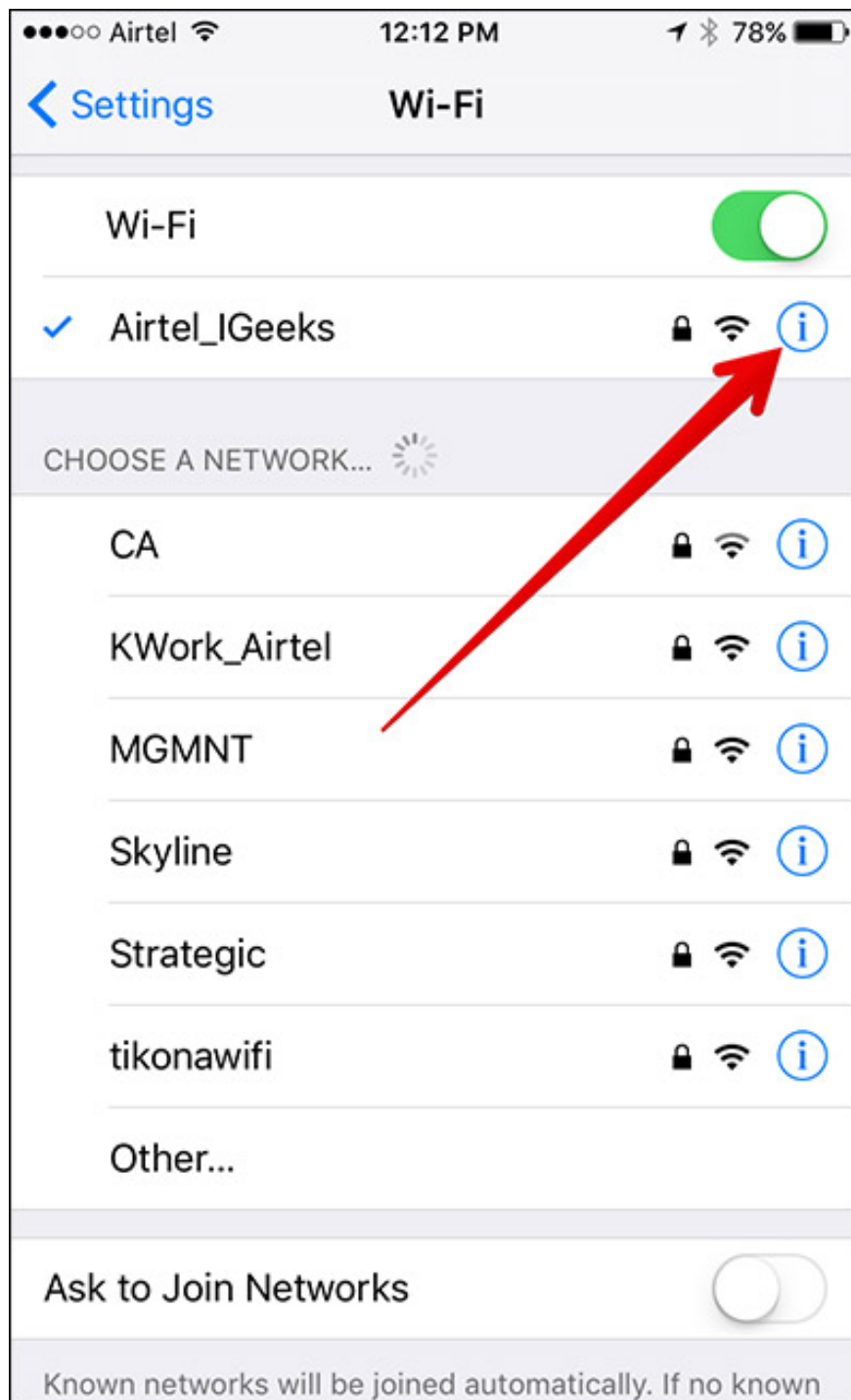
Step 1:

On the iPhone, iPad screen, click the **Settings** app and navigate to **Wifi** .



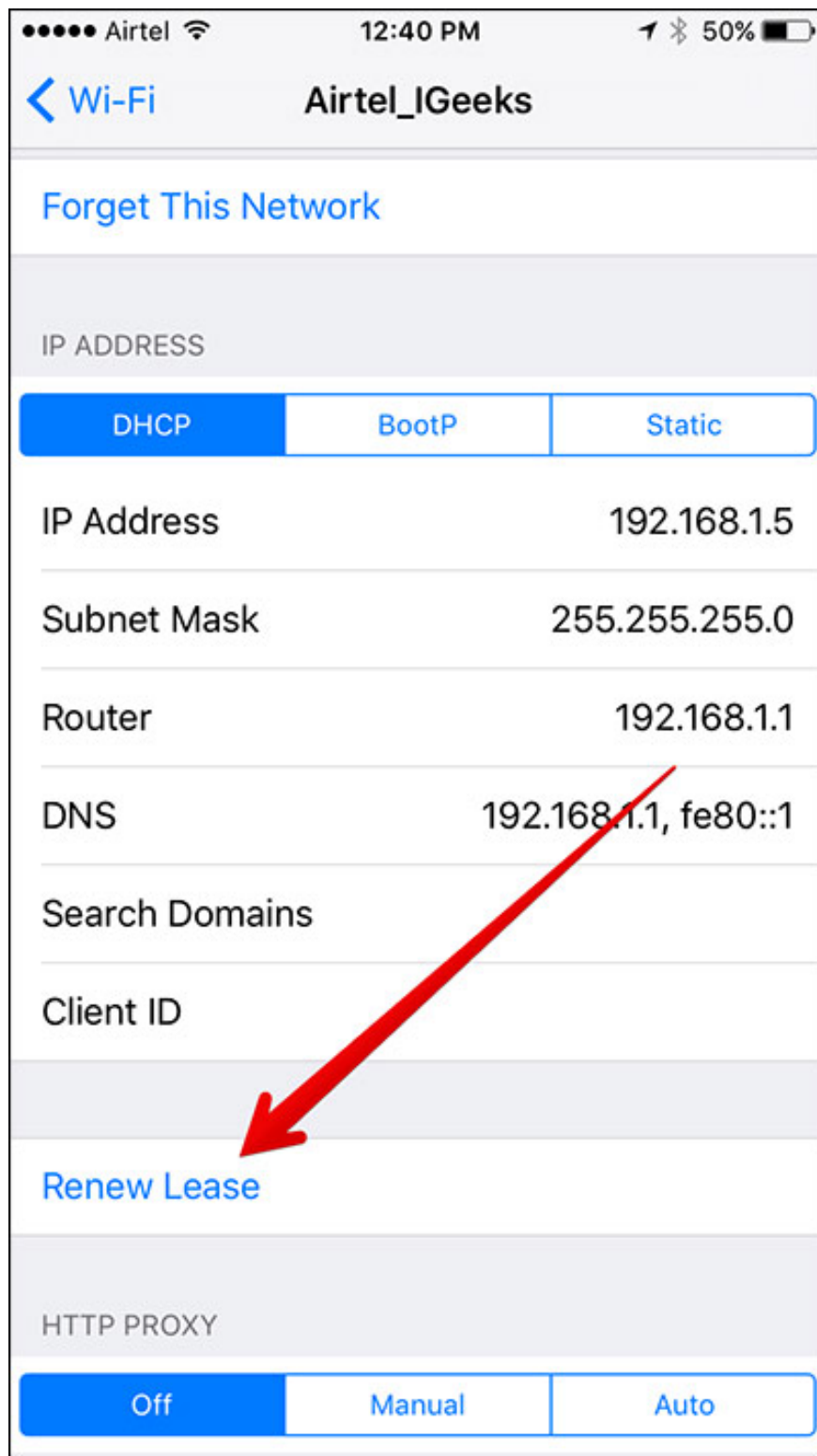
Step 2:

Here you will see the Wi-Fi network you connected, just press the "i" button next to the Wifi network.



Step 3:

Now on the iPhone device screen, your iPad will display information related to the Wifi network. Here you click **Renew Lease** to reset your iPhone, iPad IP address.



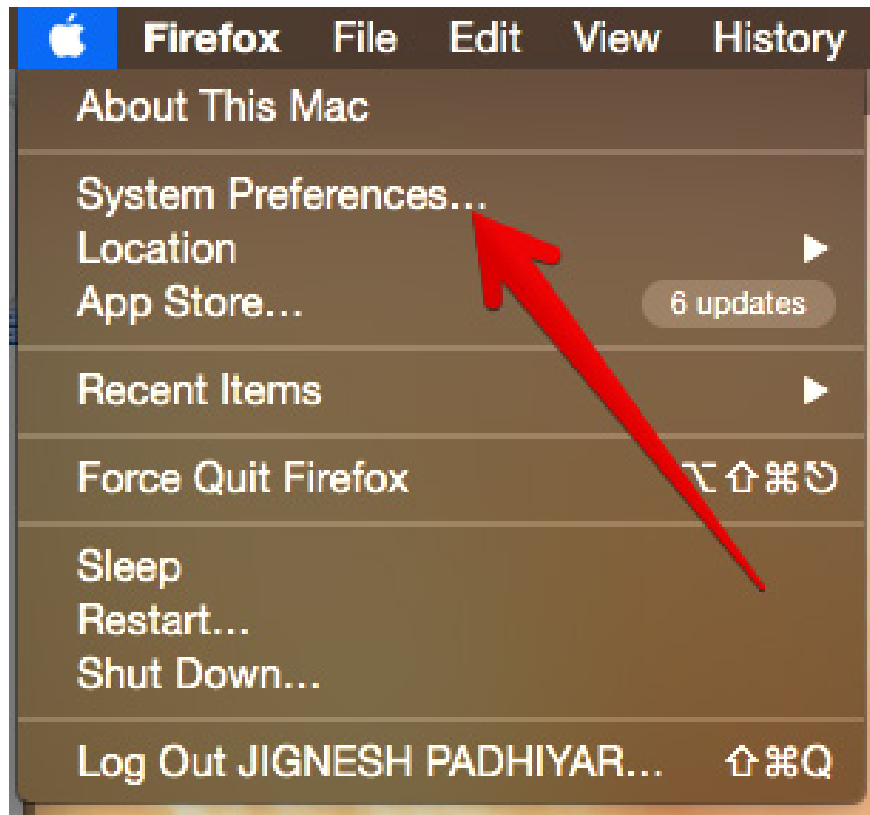
From now on you can connect to Wifi on your iPhone, iPad without having to worry about errors again.

2. Fix IP conflict error during Wifi connection on Mac

To fix IP conflict errors during Wifi connection on Mac, follow the steps below:

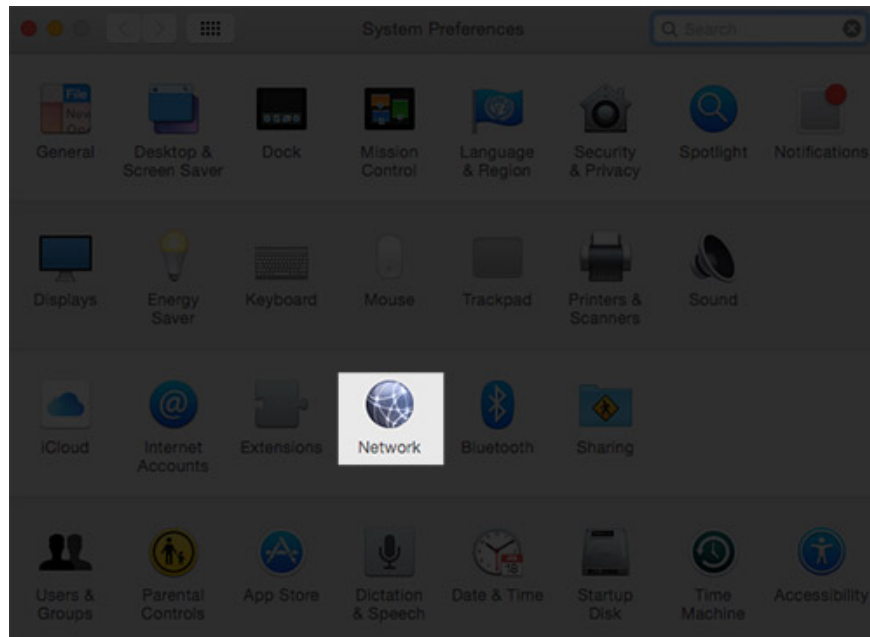
Step 1:

On your Mac, open **System Preferences** .



Step 2:

On the Preferences panel, open **Network** .

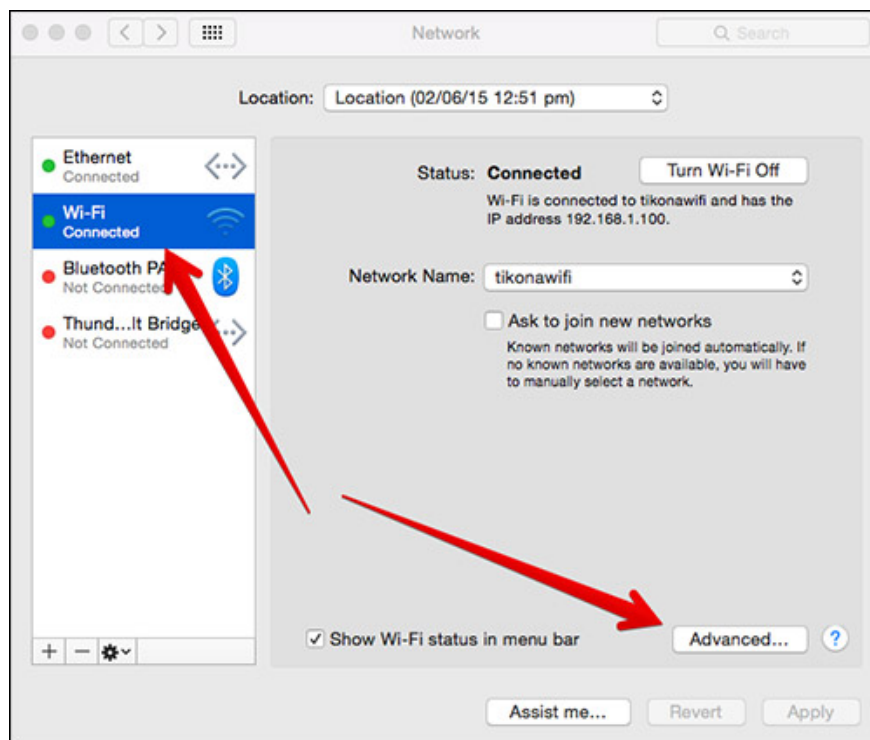


Step 3:

Next in the list of Wifi connections on the left side, select any Wifi that you are having trouble connecting to.

Step 4:

Look to the right of the screen, find and select the **Advanced** option .

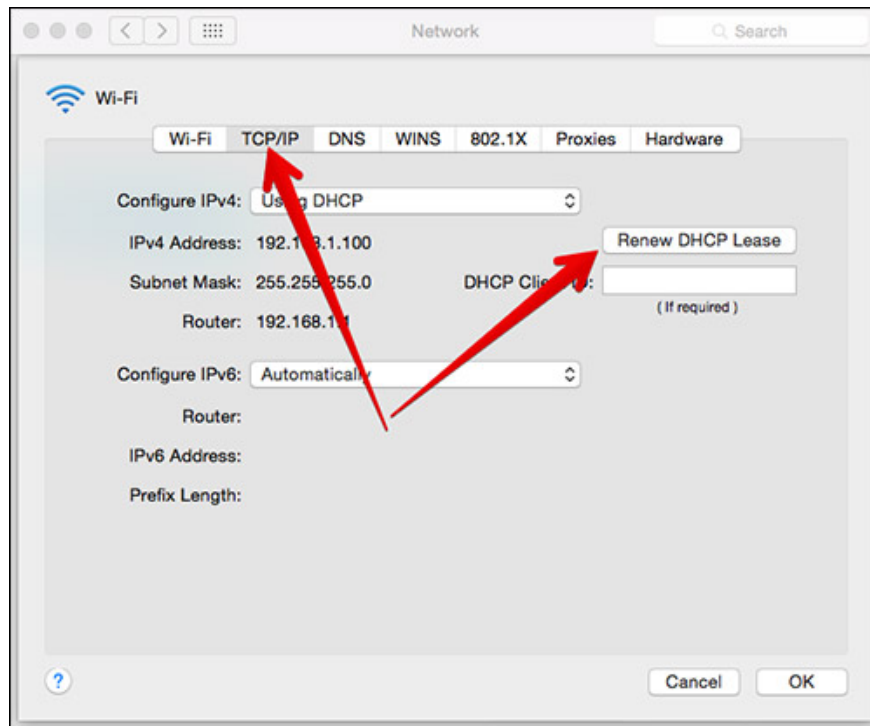


Step 5:

On the next window, click **TCP / IP** tab.

Step 6:

The last step is to select **Renew DHCP Lease** .



Now the IP address on your Mac will be reset. From now on when you connect to Wifi will not occur any more errors.
