Martial arts legend Bruce Lee has established many top martial arts records that so far no one in the world can break.

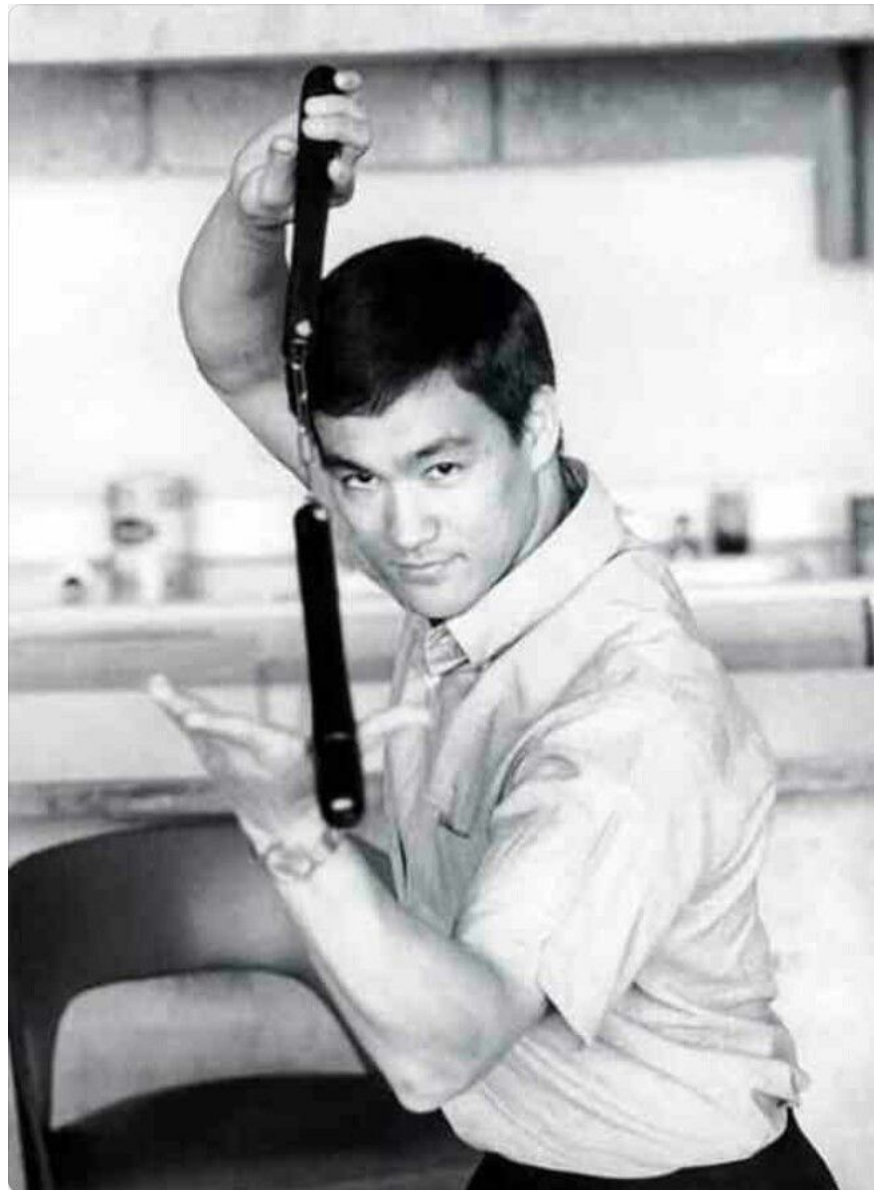

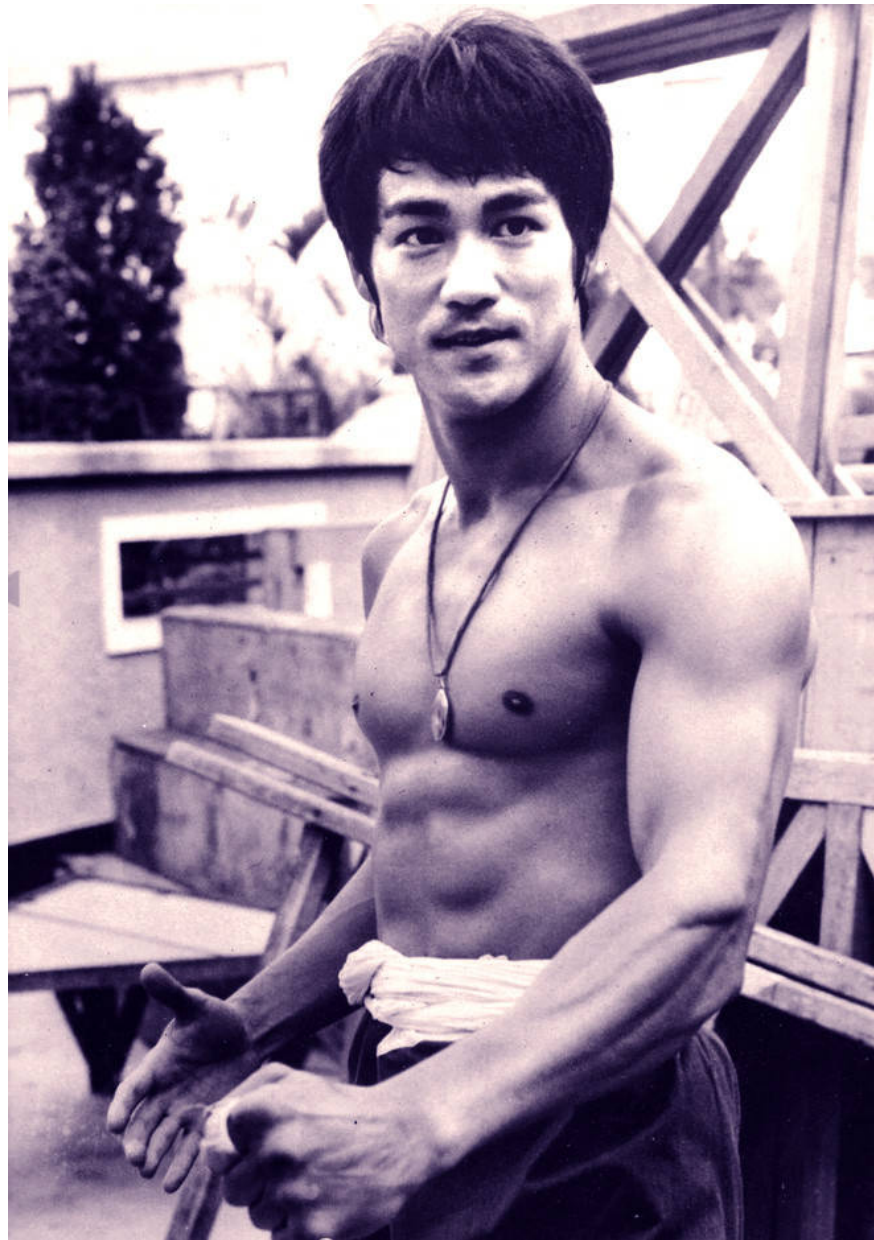
Not only is the martial arts master, Bruce is also a famous actor in Hollywood's leading kungfu movies. Bruce has set many top martial arts records that so far no one in the world can break.



Bruce once launched a strong slanting kick that broke the 45kg sandbag.



Bruce used to use tapered bites to produce a force of about 7.25kg, equivalent to 1600 pounds.



Bruce can launch 9 blows in a second, according to his record, his strongest right can make a person weigh 150 kg to 5 meters away.



Bruce can pierce 1 Coca-cola can (made of steel and unopened cover) with one finger very easily.



He can resist push with two hands 1,500 times, 400 times with one hand (both left and right hands are okay), with 2 fingers (thumb and forefinger) 200 times, and 100 times with one finger what.



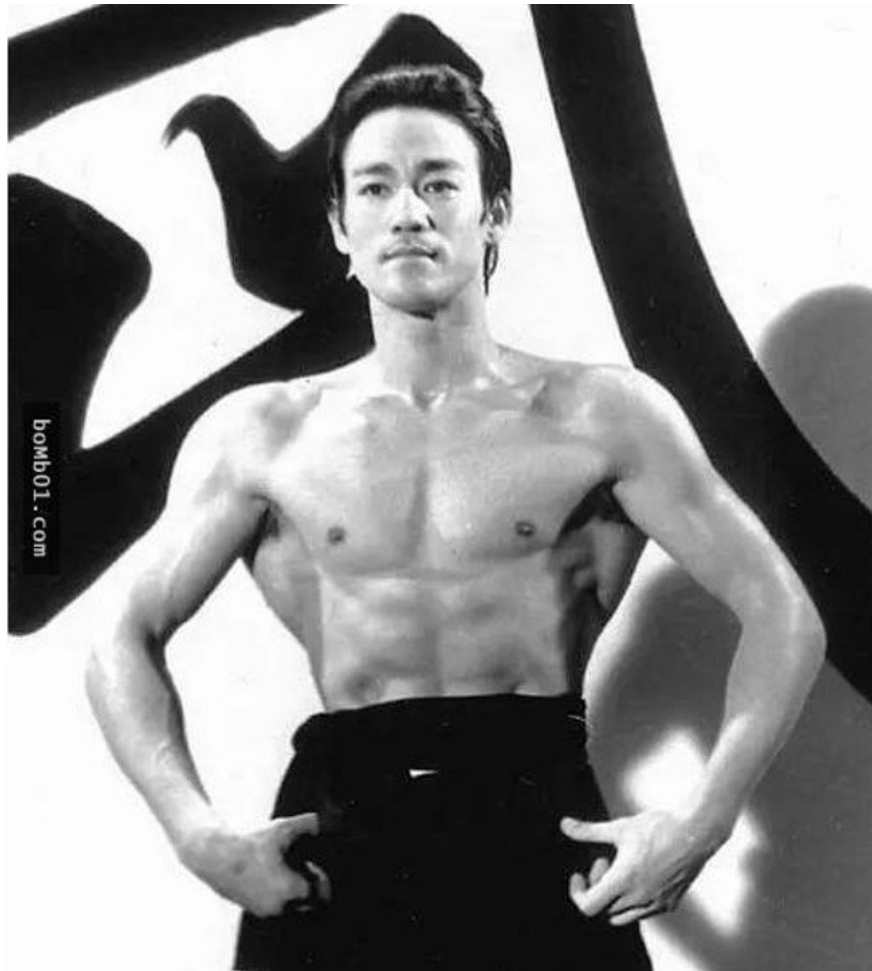
Bruce can launch a punch with a power of about 400kg. Muhammad Ali, a former American boxing athlete may also launch a similar punch but his body weight is twice as heavy as Bruce Lee.



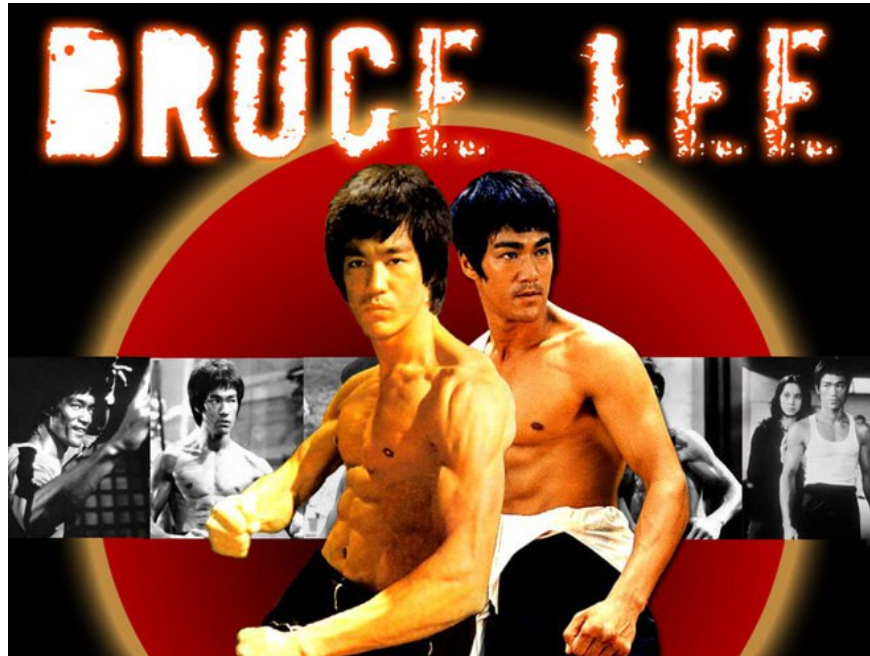
In 1 second, Bruce could use 6 feet to kick his feet, he could kick a man with a body weight of 200 pounds or 90.7kg away from him 20 meters away.



Bruce once kicked a sack weighing about 135 kg on the ceiling about 5 meters high.



Bruce can lift a weight of 34 kg with one hand and straighten it for 20 seconds. After retracting his hand, he can immediately hold the 56 kg bar to straighten it for a few seconds.



Throughout his life, Bruce fought about 300 matches and never failed. Bruce has set a record to defeat opponents in a match in just 5 seconds.
