

Cool things you can do with Pumpkin in Minecraft

Pumpkin in Minecraft can also do nothing but lights and golems in the game, take a look at 5 ways to use pumpkins below.

Pumpkin is arguably one of the most versatile fruits in Minecraft. Pumpkins can be found naturally in most biomes in Minecraft. Pumpkin and its seeds can also be found in treasure chests.

In taiga forests and in mountainous villages, players can also use pumpkins instead of hay.

Ax is the fastest way to break pumpkins in Minecraft. Unlike a watermelon, a pumpkin is just one block instead of single pieces like a watermelon. A pumpkin block yields only 4 pumpkin seeds. Plant them and you will get more pumpkins.

So besides farming, what can pumpkins can do in Minecraft, let's take a look at 5 ways to use pumpkins below.

Pumpkin carving



You can turn an ordinary pumpkin into a carved pumpkin. In addition, when cutting pumpkin seeds, they also drop seeds.

You may not know it, but if you put a carved pumpkin on your head. Enderman won't attack you if you wear this pumpkin.

Make pumpkin lights



Lanterns are a beautiful light source next to signboards, beacons, glowing stones . This is an easy-to-find alternative to the above options.

Place an engraved pumpkin and a torch on the crafting table to make a pumpkin lamp and hang it on a pole. This item is also quite similar to the Halloween pumpkin lamp in real life, so it is very suitable for Halloween theme decoration in the game.

Crafting Golems



There are two types of golems that you can craft with pumpkins in Minecraft, snowman and iron man. These Golems are responsible for protecting villagers and players by destroying mobs that often see creepers, zombies and bone monsters.



Without pumpkins, you definitely can't make golems. To craft a snowman, place two vertical blocks of snow and place the carved pumpkin on top of the two snow blocks. As for the iron man, create a T with 4 iron blocks and place the pumpkin above the T to form an iron Golem.

Change into gemstone



Some players were unaware that pumpkins could be exchanged for precious Emeralds. These gems you can exchange with low level villagers.

They will buy you 6 pumpkins for you with an emerald, which you can only redeem 2 times per day. If you have a pumpkin farm, you can get unlimited emeralds from the villagers.

Harvest Bone Meal



It takes about 10 to 30 minutes from seeding to get Pumpkin. After that, the player can grow as many pumpkins as they want without having to sow more seeds. Therefore, players can use it to get tons of bone meal with ease.

Building an automatic pumpkin farm is one of the easiest ways to get bone meal. You can get bone meal by right clicking on the pumpkin on the compost bin.
