

# Copy music to your iPhone using CopyTrans Manager without iTunes.

Copying music to your iPhone using CopyTrans Manager allows you to copy the hottest songs from your computer to your iPhone when your phone doesn't have Wi-Fi or 4G connectivity to download music from online music streaming sites. Additionally, you can also back up photos, videos, and contacts from your iPhone to your computer using CopyTrans Manager.

Typically, to copy music to an iPhone or other iOS devices, users usually **copy music to the iPhone using iTunes** . However, using iTunes can be somewhat difficult for users due to its many advanced features, and if not used familiarly, users may lose all their music during **data synchronization** .



Therefore, another option available to you to overcome this problem is CopyTrans Manager software, which allows users **to copy music to their iPhone** without using iTunes. However, if you still want to use iTunes, you can download the latest version.

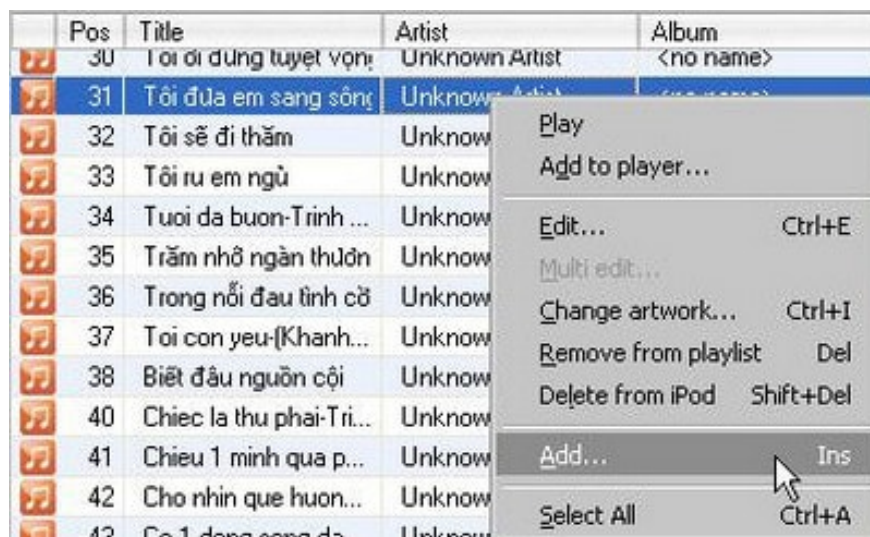

The program's functions can be summarized as follows:



### Add/remove songs from the library.

You can use CopyTrans Manager to add songs to your library. Simply select the "Update button" and then navigate to the music path. Users can add multiple songs at once. Alternatively, you can right-click on the song list and select "Add". To preview a song, click the play icon. To delete a song from the library, select it and click the play button, or right-click and select "Delete from iPod".



### Playlist Management:

You can also use CopyTrans Manager to create new playlists. In the playlist management area, click the add playlist icon (the + sign) or right-click, select **Add playlist**, and then name the playlist. To change the name, right-click on **the playlist** and select **Rename playlist**.



To delete a playlist, select the playlist and press the **Delete** key . If you want to delete the playlist along with all the songs within it from memory, right-click and select "**Delete playlist and tracks from iPod**" (or press **Shift + Delete**) .

The most important step is to add songs from your library. In the Playlists section, click on the iPod name to display all the songs, then use your mouse to select, drag, and drop the song into the desired playlist. For faster selection, you can search for songs using the search box on the toolbar.



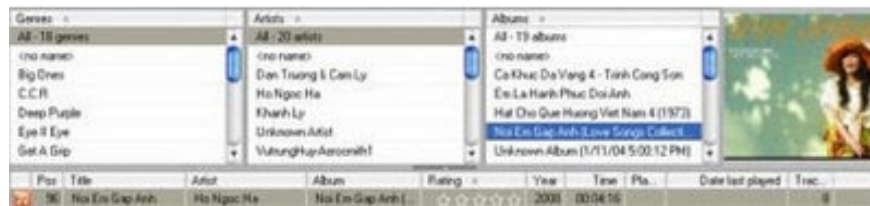
Whenever you want to remove a song from a playlist, right-click on it and select " **Remove from playlist**".

### **Manage**

your library by album information. Your iPhone's music playlist can contain thousands of songs. Album information acts as a filter, allowing you to categorize music more efficiently by genre. To add album information, right-click on a song, select **Edit** , and enter the information in the **Title, Artist, and Album** fields . You can also set a cover art image by clicking **Change artwork**.



In the album information section, simply select the artist name and album title to get the results you're looking for.



Copying music, photos, or videos to your iPhone using CopyTrans Manager, which doesn't require iTunes, makes using the features much more convenient and easier. Compared to iTunes, CopyTrans Manager's advantage that users love is its ease of use; with just a few drag-and-drop actions, synchronizing music becomes easy without worrying about losing all the music already on your device.
