**For example** , Sheet 1 has the standard format you want to copy this Sheet to Sheet 2 you do as follows:

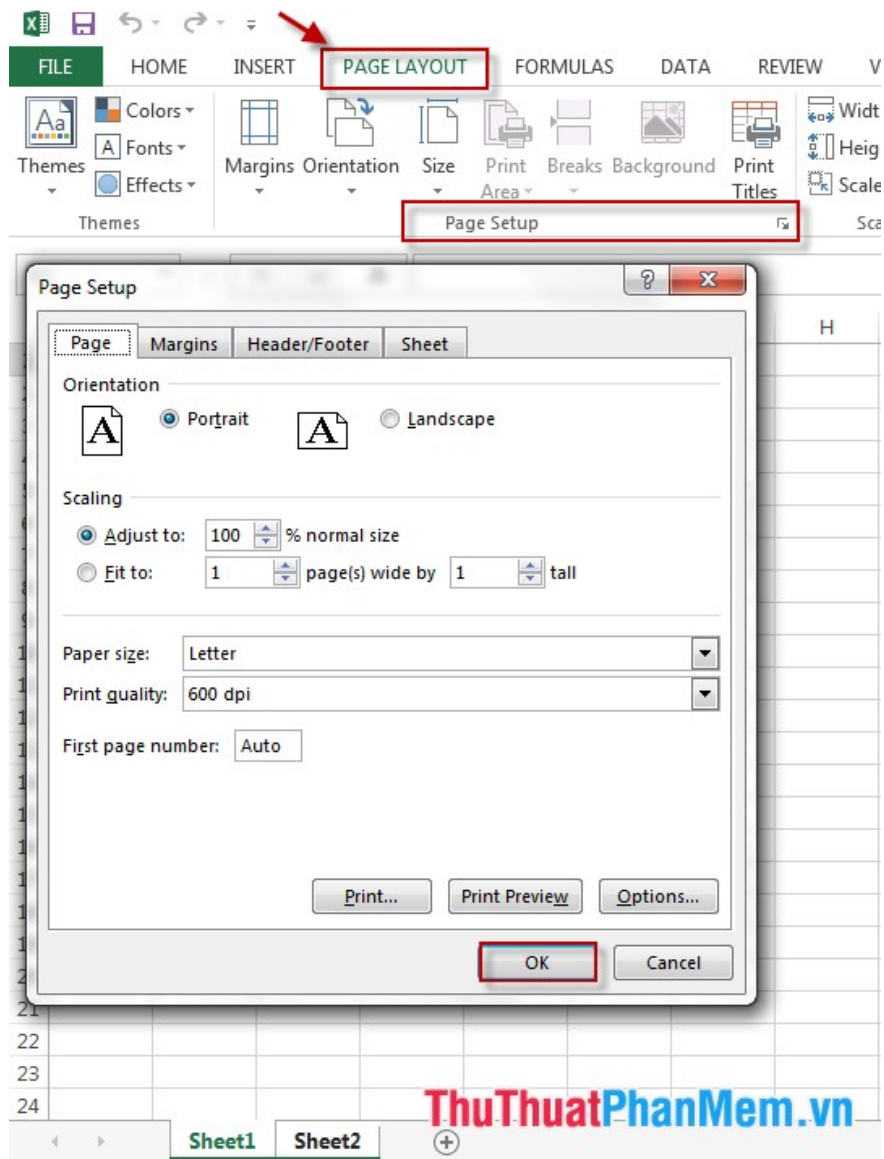
**Step 1:** Select the **Sheet** format to copy ( **Sheet 1** ).



**Step 2:** Hold down **Ctrl** and click the name of the Sheet to be copied (here is **Sheet 2** ).



**Step 3:** Select Tab **Page Layout** -> **Page Setup** . The **Page Setup** dialog box appears, click **OK** .
