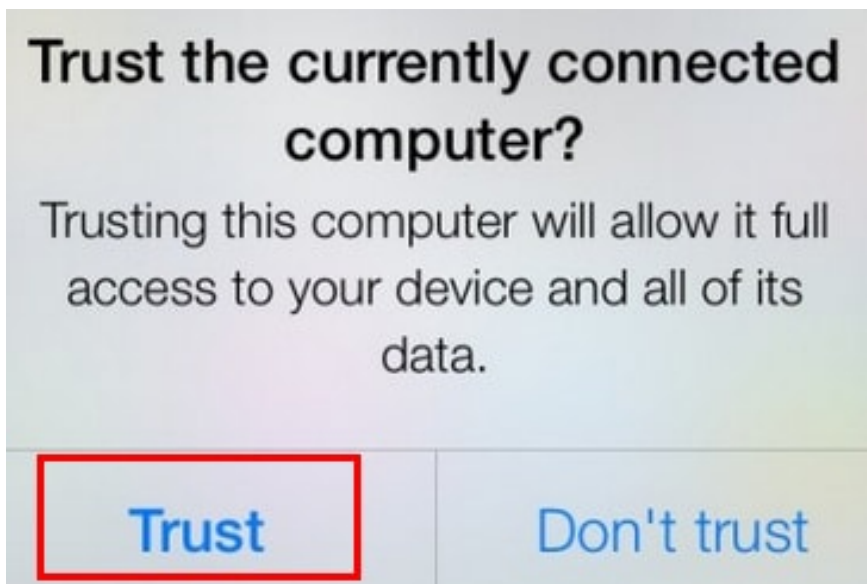

Quickly copy photos from your iPhone to your computer.

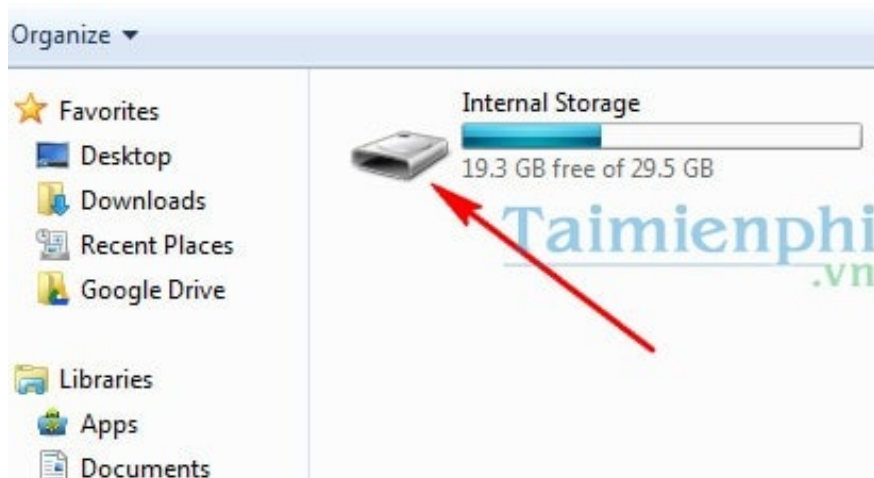

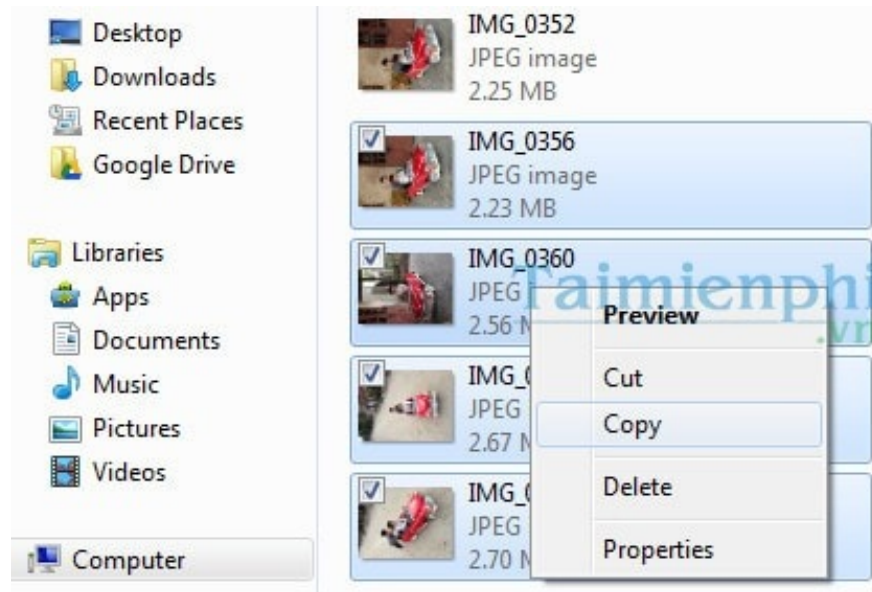
Step 2: Your computer will then detect your connected iPhone or iPad.
