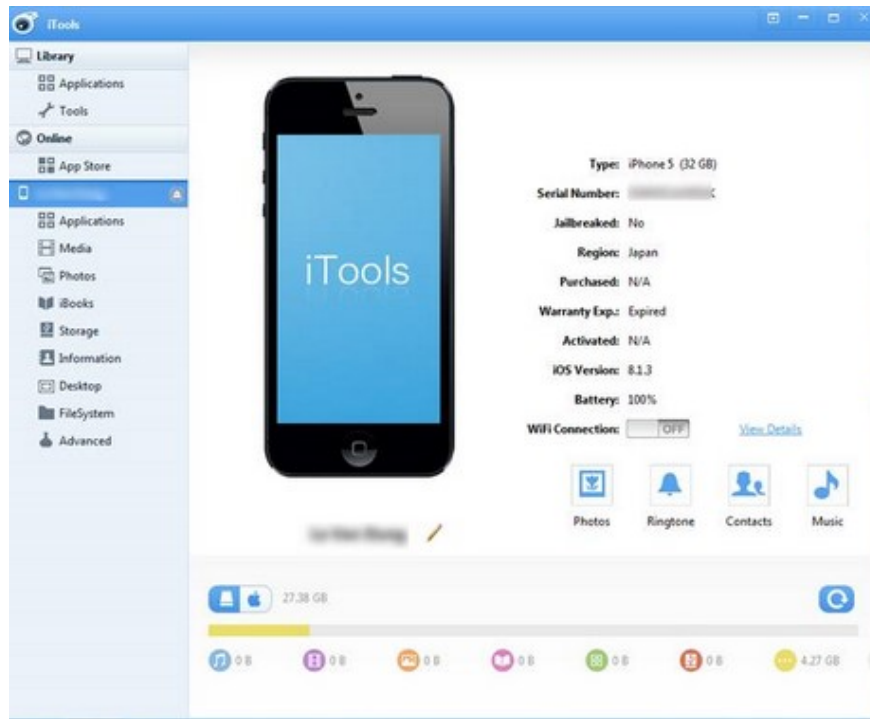
Requirements:

After successful installation, connect your iPhone to your computer, then launch iTools. The program will then recognize your connected iPhone. The interface will look like the image below.

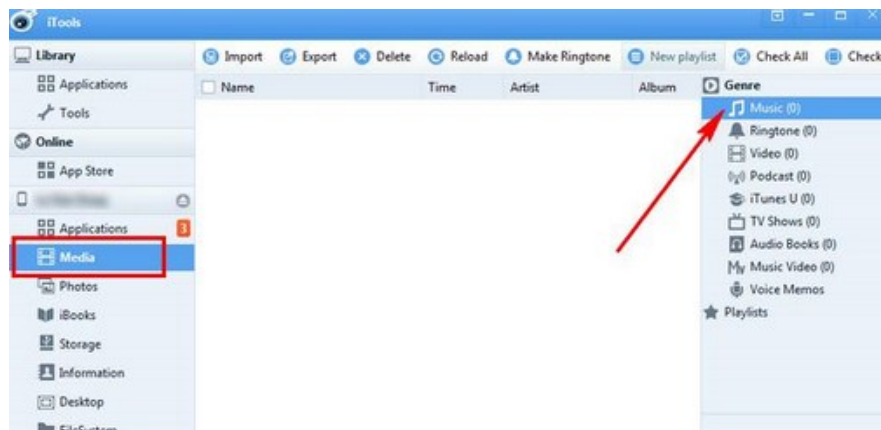


To copy photos from your computer to your iPhone via iTunes, click on **Photos** ---> **Photos**.



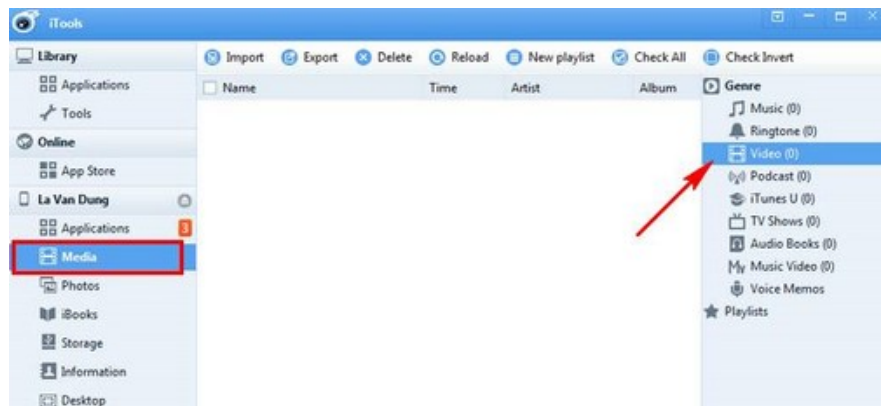
Here you can create albums (**New Album**) to store your images, then drag and drop photos from your computer into the album you created.

To copy music to your iPhone, click on the **Media** tab ---> **Music**.



Here you also use the drag and drop method to transfer music from your computer to your iPhone.

To copy videos, click on the **Media tab** ---> **Video**



and also use the drag and drop method to transfer videos from your computer to your iPhone.
