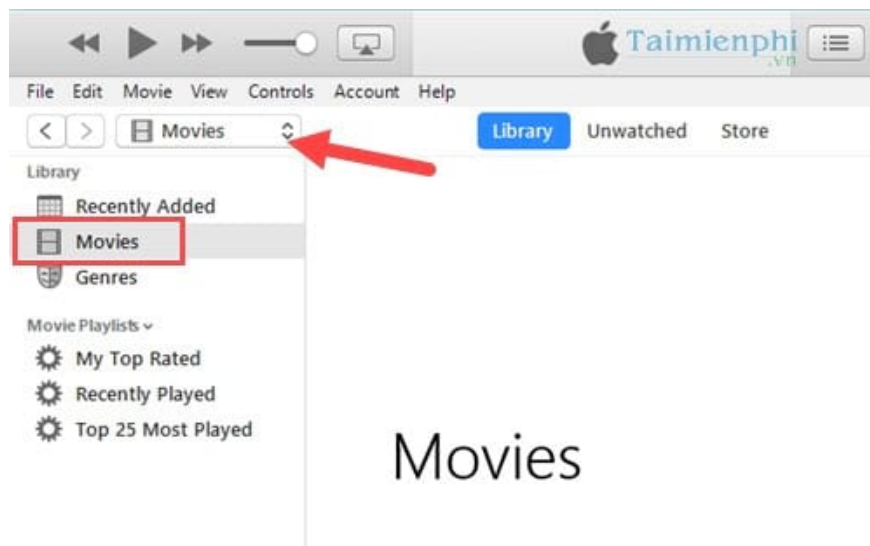

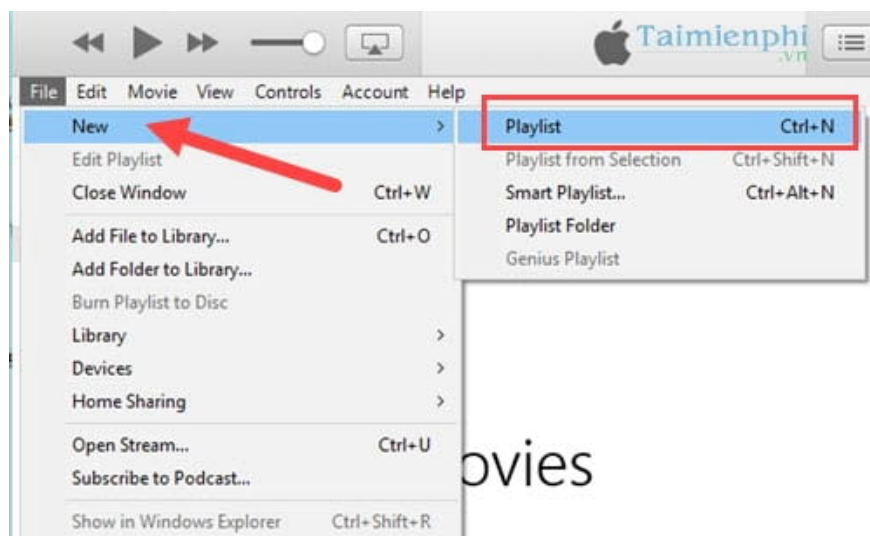

Instructions on how to copy videos to iPhone and iPad using iTunes.

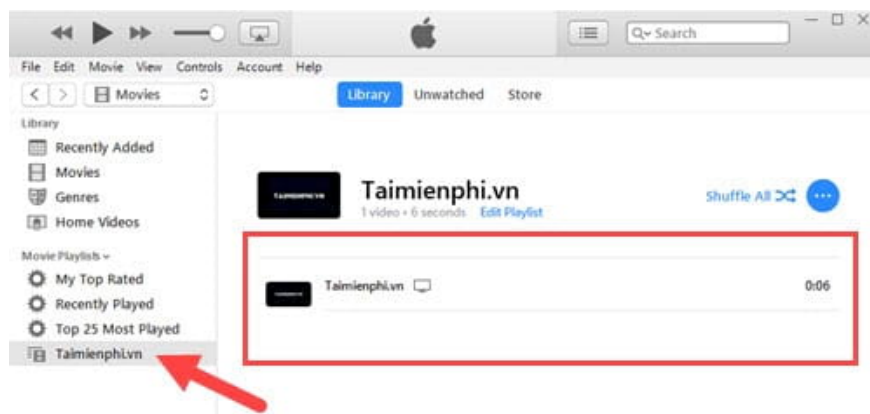
Step 1: First, open iTunes and select the **Movies** section to view the list of movies in your library.



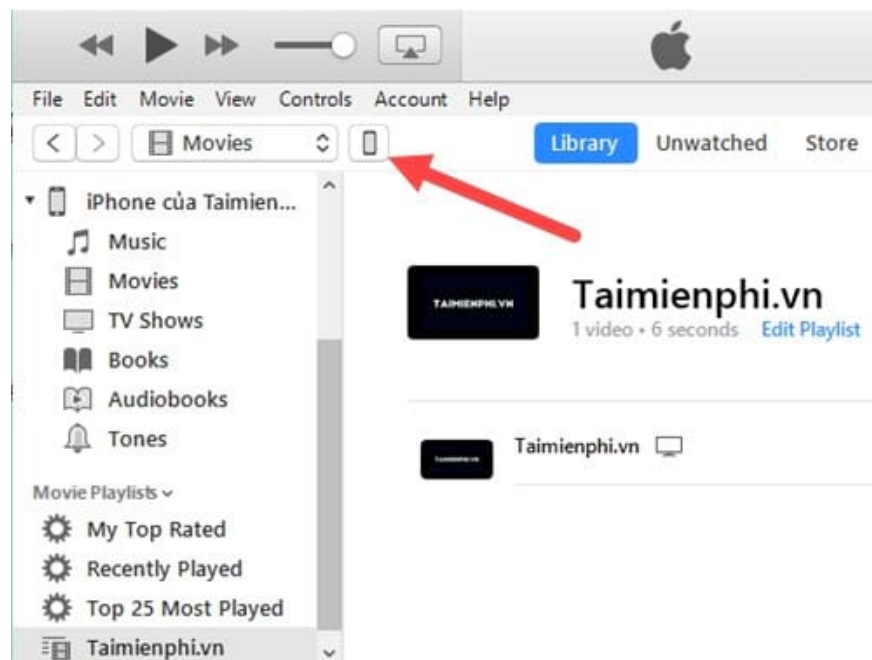
Step 2: Click on **File** in the menu bar, then select **New > Playlist** to create a new playlist for the movie.



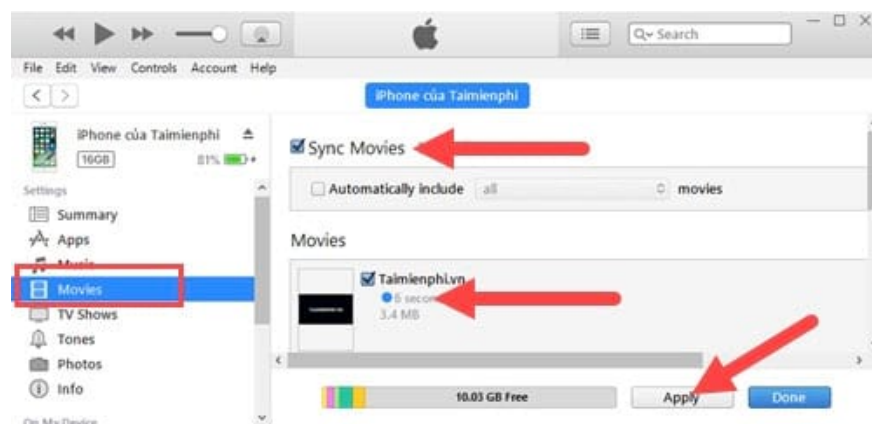
