

# Crafting forges in Minecraft 1.20 is extremely simple.

In Minecraft, armor sets are typically crafted from corresponding metal ingots. Therefore, the forging feature is limited and usually only used to repair broken tools or upgrade tools and armor to Netherite equipment. However, the new forging pattern in version 1.20 has completely changed this. So, don't miss out on how to craft the new forging pattern in Minecraft 1.20.

Minecraft version 1.20 introduced a new item called the Smithing Template, along with a new crafting mechanism. Now, when you download Minecraft 1.20, you can collect Smithing Templates all over the open world. To help you acquire more of this item, TipsMake will show you how to craft Smithing Templates in Minecraft 1.20.

## How to craft a forge in Minecraft 1.20

## Method 1: Pick up the forging sample from the chest.

Currently, the most basic way to obtain forging blueprints is to explore the world and pick them up from chests inside structures such as Fortress Ruins, Ancient Cities, Forest Temples, Stronghold Fortresses, Shipwrecks, Desert Temples, etc. However, you first need to update or download Minecraft 1.20 to your computer.



Each building will only contain one type of forging template, making it extremely difficult to collect them, especially in dangerous buildings. You can refer to the drop rates for forging templates in different buildings as follows:

- Netherite Upgrade fork: Appears in Fortress Ruins with a 100% chance in treasure chests and 3.2% in other chests.
- Coast Armor Trim fork: Appears in Shipwrecks with an 11.1% chance.
- Dune Armor Trim fork: Appears in Desert Temples with an 11.1% chance.
- Eye Armor Trim fork: Appears in Stronghold Fortress, shrine chests with a 4.8% chance, and library chests with a 9.1% chance.
- Rib Armor Trim fork: Appears in Nether Fortress with a 4.8% chance.
- Sentry Armor Trim fork: Appears in Bandit Outposts with a 20% chance.
- Snout Armor Trim fork: Appears in Fortress Ruins with a 4.8% chance.
- Spire Armor Trim fork: Appears in End City with a 4.8% chance.
- Vex Armor Trim fork: Appears in Forest Mansions with a 4.8% chance.
- Ward Armor Trim forging pattern: Appears in Ancient Cities with a 4.8% chance.
- Wild Armor Trim forging pattern: Appears in Forest Temples with a 20% chance.

## Method 2: Replicating the forging pattern

Despite being difficult to find, crafting templates only serve to decorate armor and upgrade equipment. Therefore, Minecraft allows you to use one existing crafting template to duplicate an identical one. This means you only need to find one item of each crafting template to use as many as you want without worrying about running out.

To duplicate a forging pattern, you need one forging pattern, seven diamonds, and one block compatible with that pattern. Each type of forging pattern is compatible with a different block, specifically:

- The Netherite Upgrade forging requires Infernal Stone.
- The Coast Armor Trim forging requires Cobblestone.
- The Dune Armor Trim forging requires Sandstone.
- The Eye Armor Trim forging requires Endstone.
- The Rib Armor Trim forging requires Infernal Stone.
- The Sentry Armor Trim forging requires Cobblestone.
- The Snout Armor Trim forging requires Blackstone.
- The Spire Armor Trim forging requires Purple Heart Block.
- The Vex Armor Trim forging requires Cobblestone.
- The Ward Armor Trim forging requires Deep Layer Cobblestone.
- The Wild Armor Trim forging requires Moss-covered Cobblestone.



If you have enough materials, you can duplicate the forging pattern by placing the forging pattern in the center of the top row, with a block corresponding to the forging pattern in the middle and the rest being diamonds.

After downloading and installing the latest version of Minecraft 1.20, players will have access to a new and more visually appealing Sniffer mob. Detailed information about the addition of the Sniffer mob in Minecraft 1.20 can be found [here](#).
