

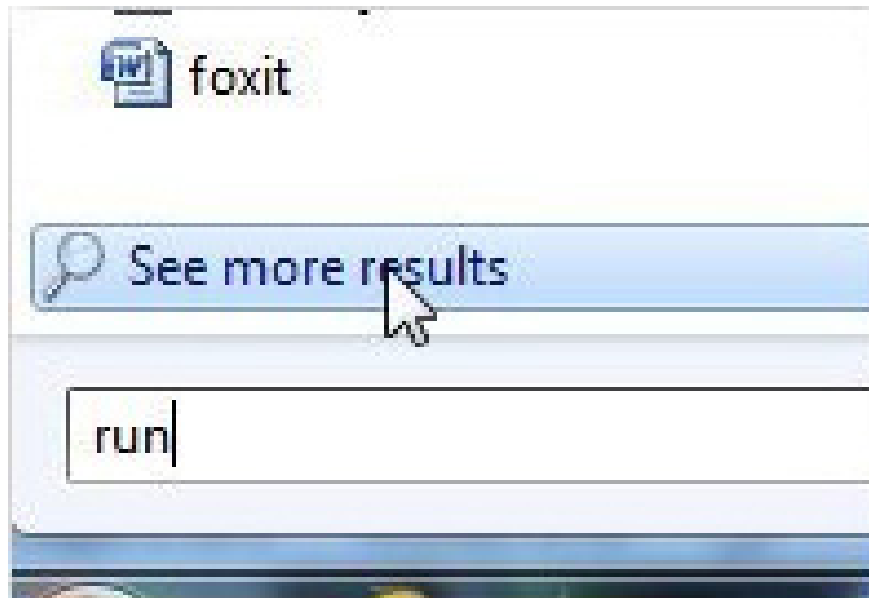
Create and manage multiple profiles in Firefox

If you share a computer with others, Mozilla Firefox has an attractive feature that allows you to create multiple profiles. This is a simple guide that explains how it works.

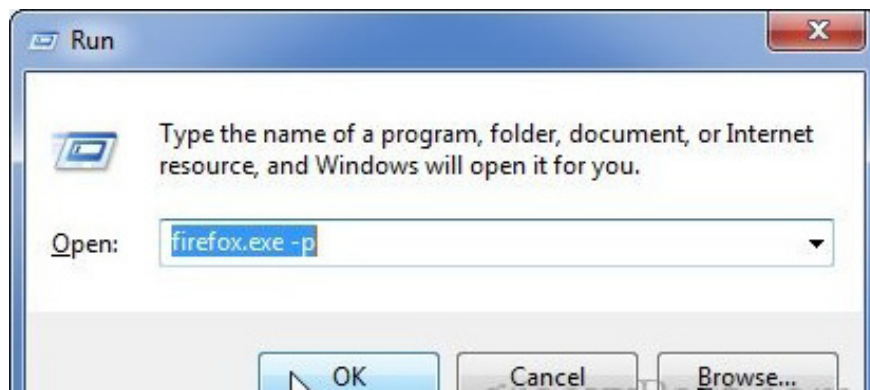
If you share a computer with others, Mozilla Firefox has an attractive feature that allows you to create multiple profiles. This is a simple guide that explains how it works.

You can save profiles according to the following path.

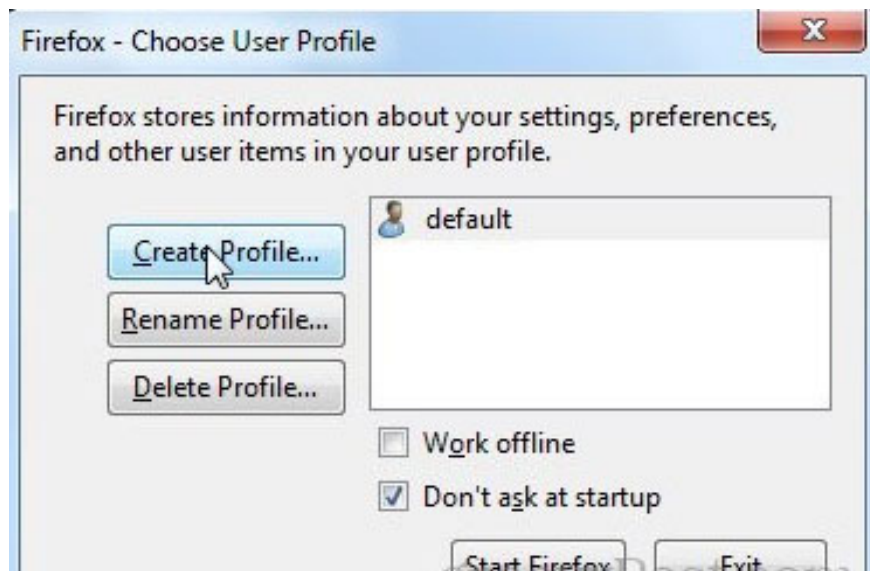
Go to **Start Menu** and type **Run** .



Type **firefox.exe -p** to open the profile manager for Mozilla Firefox. Make sure Firefox is turned off before typing the command, otherwise it won't open Profile Manager.



Users will see profiles in Firefox. Now, click the **Create Profile** button to open a new window. Click **Next** .



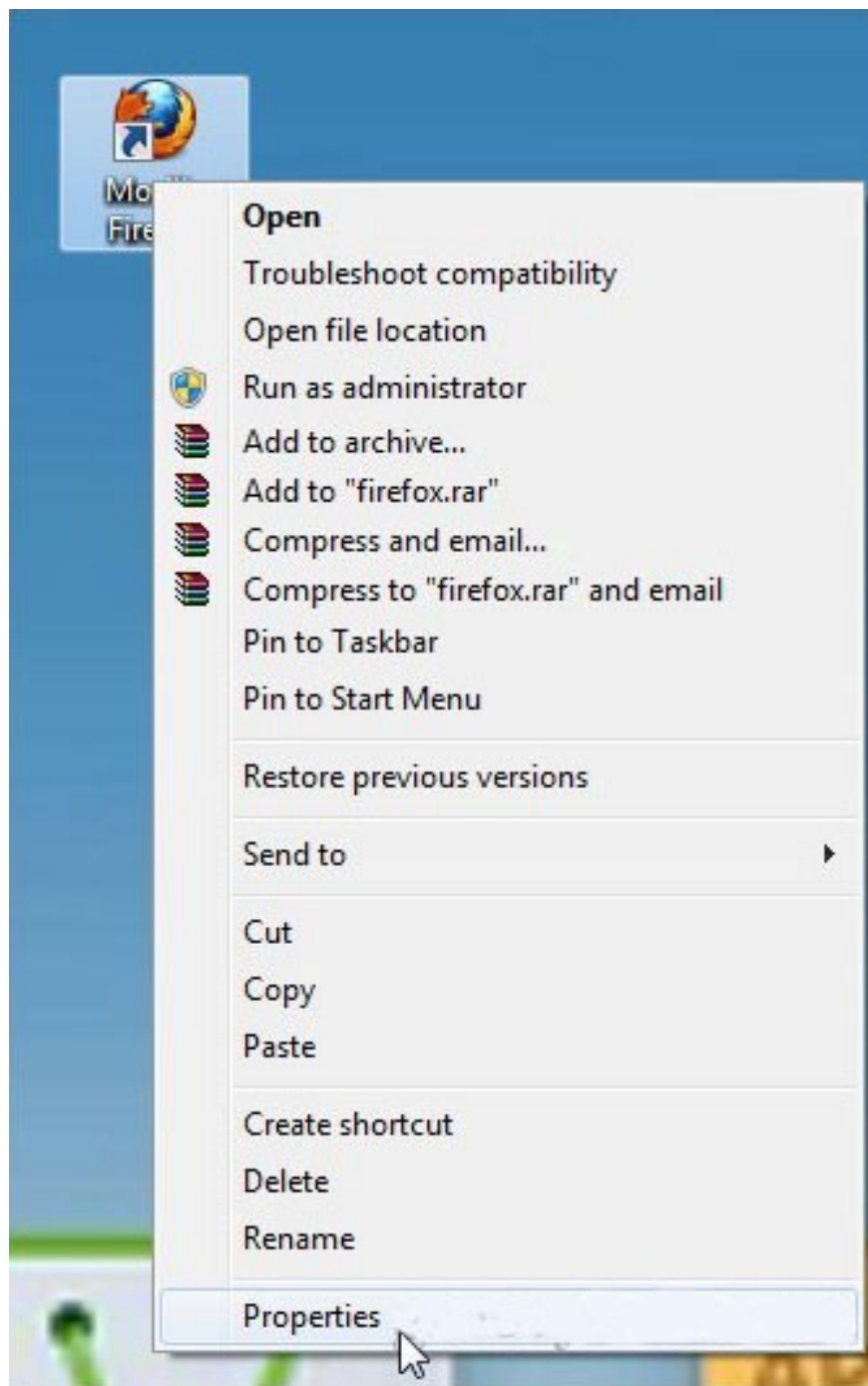
Type the new profile name and click **Finish** .



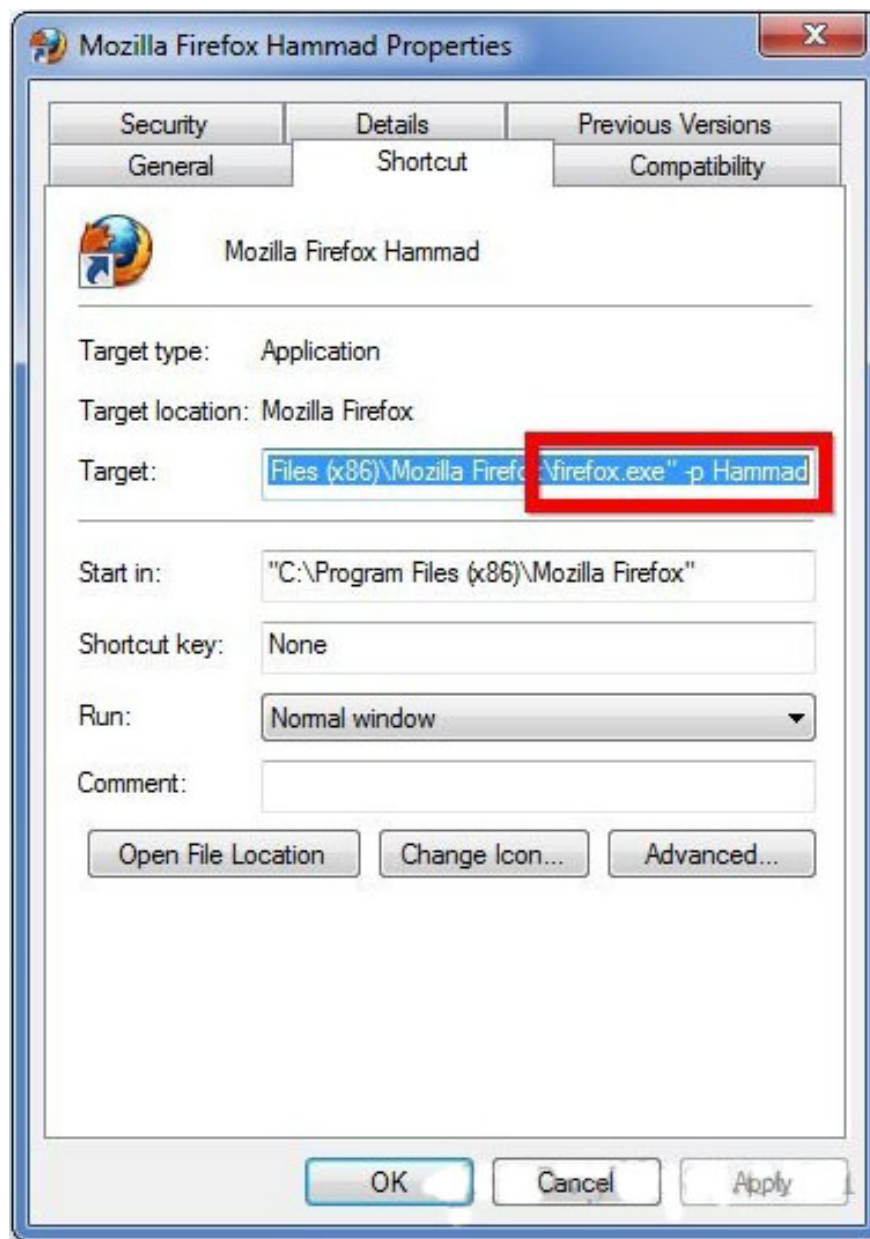
By default, Firefox will ask the user what kind of profile to use at every Firefox launch. Cancel this function by unchecking the option box **Don't ask on Startup** . Instead, the article will guide you to create a Firefox icon for each profile.



Create the shortcut icon and right-click the icon, select **Properties** .



In the **Shortcut** tab, paste the path '**C: Program Files (x86) Mozilla Firefoxfirefox.exe' -p Hammad** and click **OK**.



Now, whenever you want to access another profile, you just need to create a new Firefox icon. Extremely wonderful but simple.

In addition, Firefox stores profile information in the directory below, in case you want to delete profile or other data.

C: Users\AppData\Roaming\Mozilla\Firefox\Profiles
