

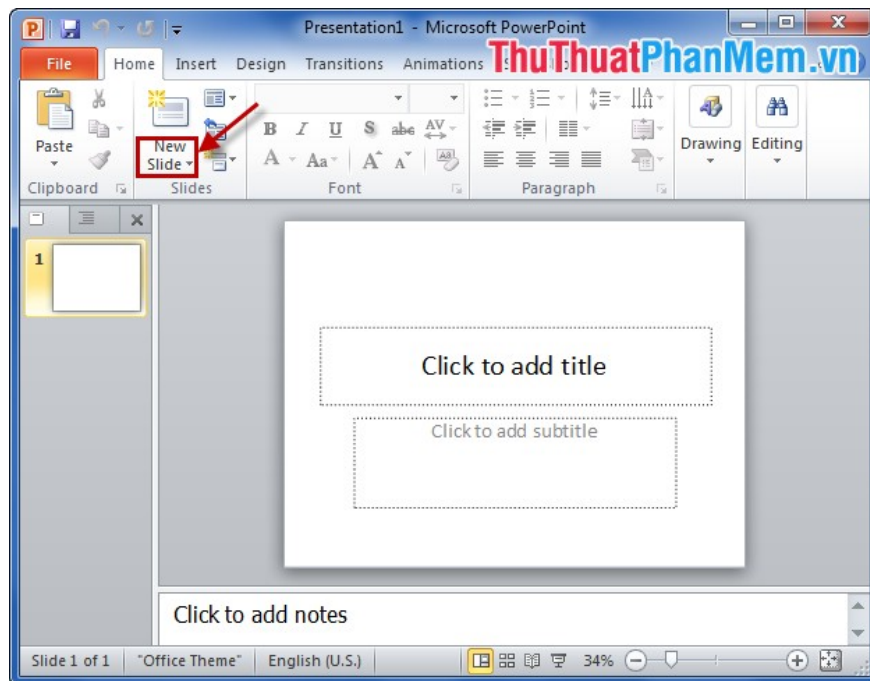
Create PowerPoint slideshows from Word documents

Create a PowerPoint slide show from Word documents - with just a few simple steps, you have created a PowerPoint slide show from existing Word documents without spending time to retype the content.

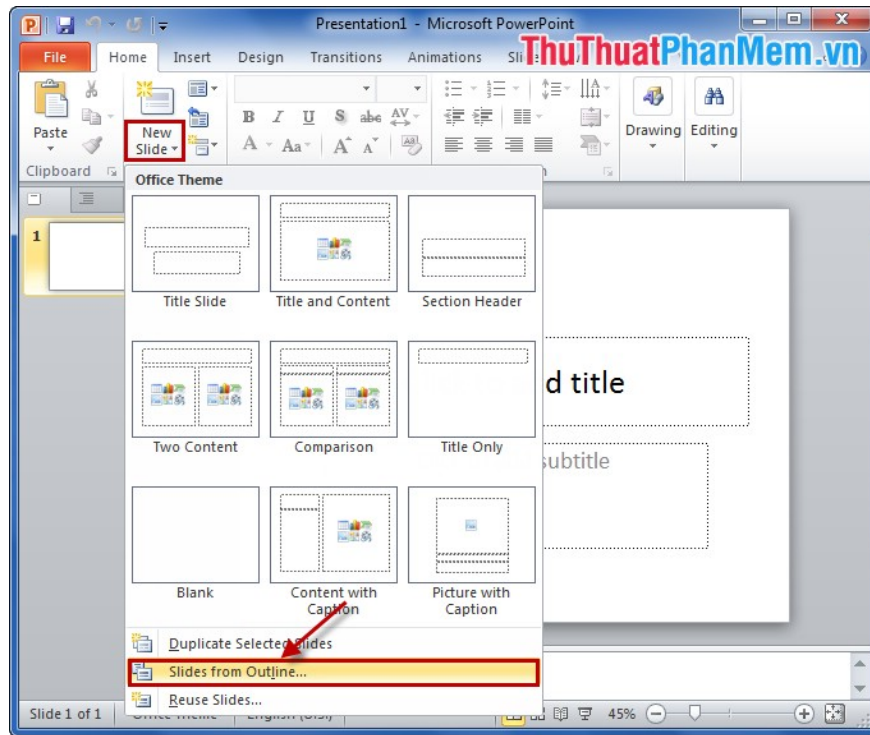
You have a Word document that contains all the necessary content, you want to create a PowerPoint slide show from the contents of that Word document. If the Word document is short, you can re-enter the content from Word into PowerPoint, but if the Word document content is long, it will take a lot of time if you re-enter the content into PowerPoint.

But with just a few simple steps, you have created a PowerPoint slide show from existing Word documents without spending time to retype the content. You refer to the steps made in the article below.

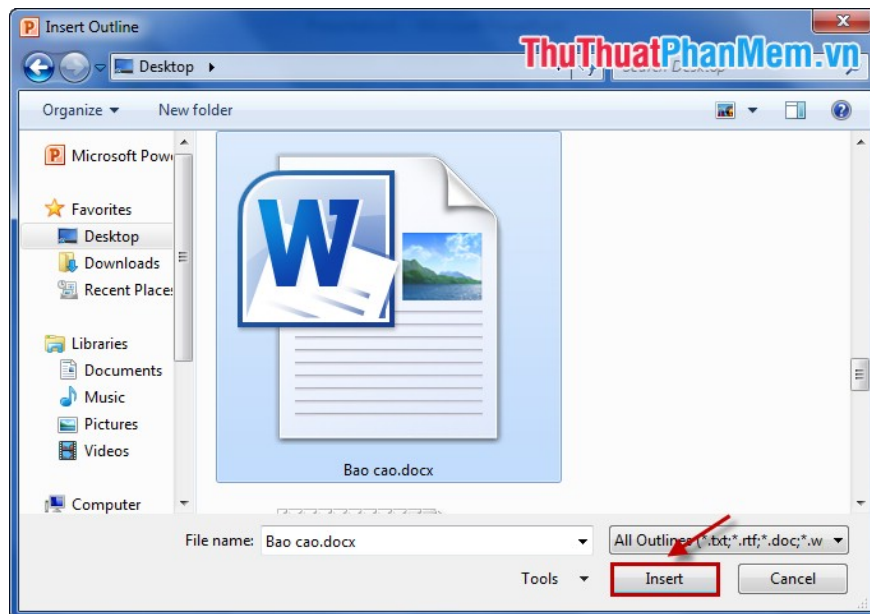
Step 1: Open Microsoft PowerPoint, in the **Home** tab, click on the word **New Slide** .



Step 2: In **Office Theme**, select **Slides from Outline** .



Step 3: The **Insert Outline** window appears , find the Word document you want to insert into the Slide and click **Insert** to insert.



Step 4: Depending on the length of the Word document, the process of inserting into PowerPoint will be fast or slow. After finishing the content of Word documents will be inserted into the Slide in PowerPoint except images. You need to edit the content in the slide and add images to make the slide more suitable.
