In the virus is detected there is dangerous virus Safesys.exe. It can go through Deepfreeze (freeze program), then write a malicious code into BootSector. This code is capable of creating an Internet connection when the computer is closed on the LAN, which will clog almost the entire connection port. The most dangerous thing for a computer when infected with Safesys.exe is that it will call many other viruses on the network to come and destroy it.
