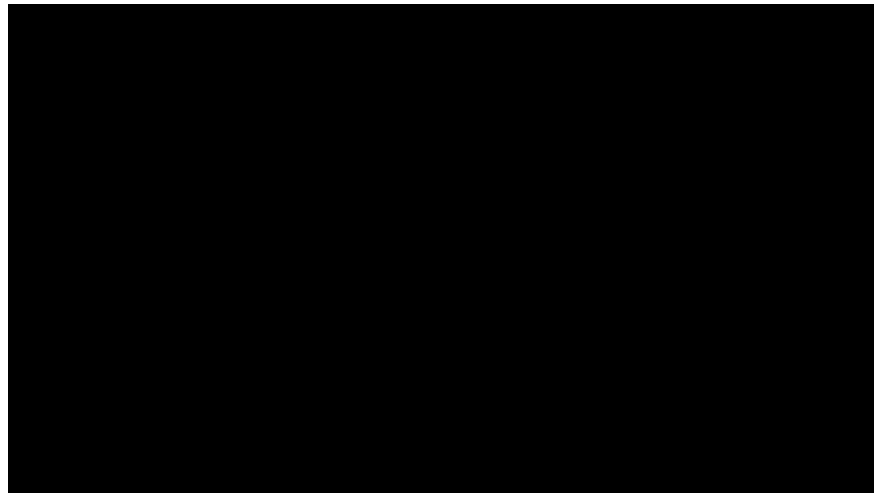


# Decode the mystery of the interesting phenomenon that slammed into the mouth of a new beer bottle spitting foam

Javier Rodriguez-Rodriguez, the head of research from the University of Carlos III (Spain), said that when a sudden smash of a beer bottle's mouth, wave pressure appears and penetrates through the liquid. This pressure goes to the bottom of the bottle and bounces up, then bounces back to the bottom. The up and down movement of compression and expansion waves produces bubbles and causes them to break quickly.



The results showed that 'mother' bubbles formed from bursting bubbles form "carbon" "bubbles" of carbonic bubble clouds.
