Before Dell Adamo laptops were discontinued earlier this year, it attracted a lot of interest in "acting" a Windows-based laptop instead of the MacBook Air. However, Dell Adamo is criticized for its high price (the premium version starts at \$ 2,700) and is not strong enough.
