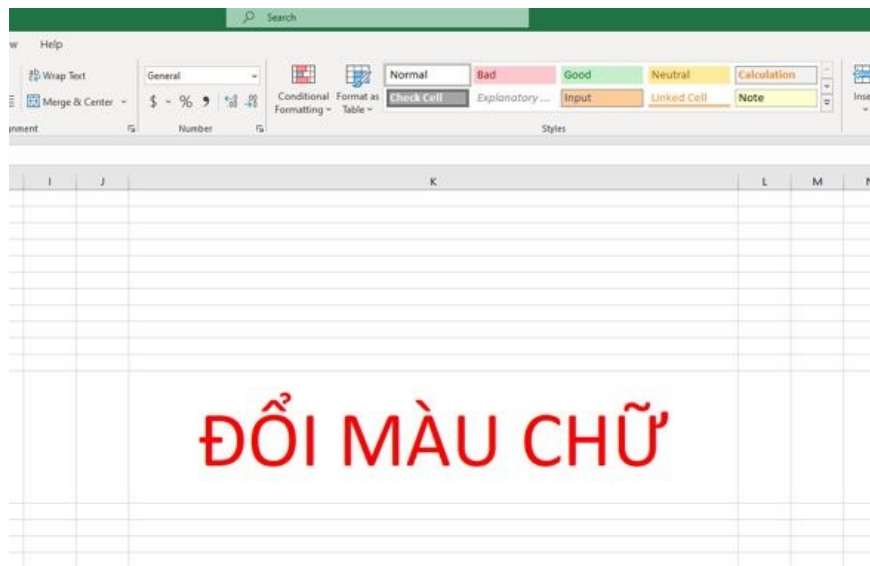
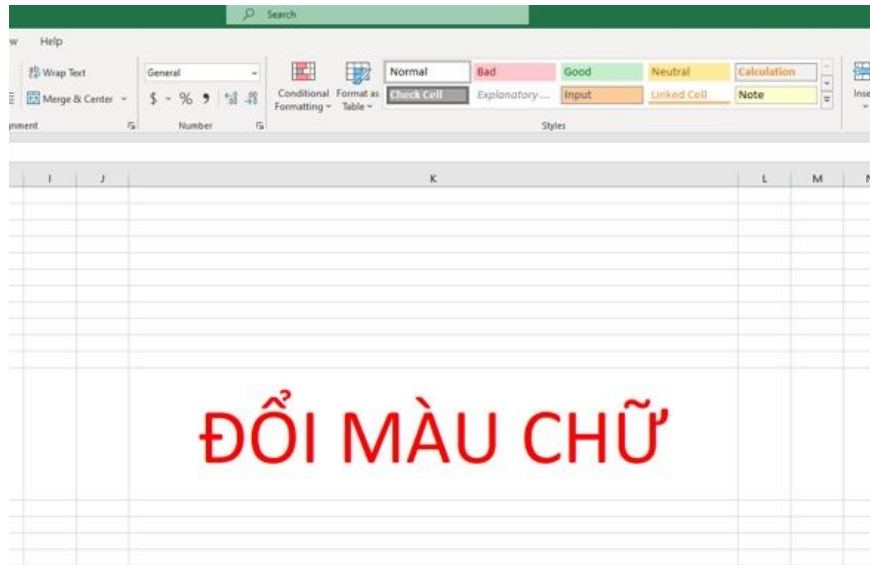
If you are a person who regularly uses Excel software for work, you will surely know. This software will allow users to quickly change the font color. This makes managing and reading data much simpler and more convenient.

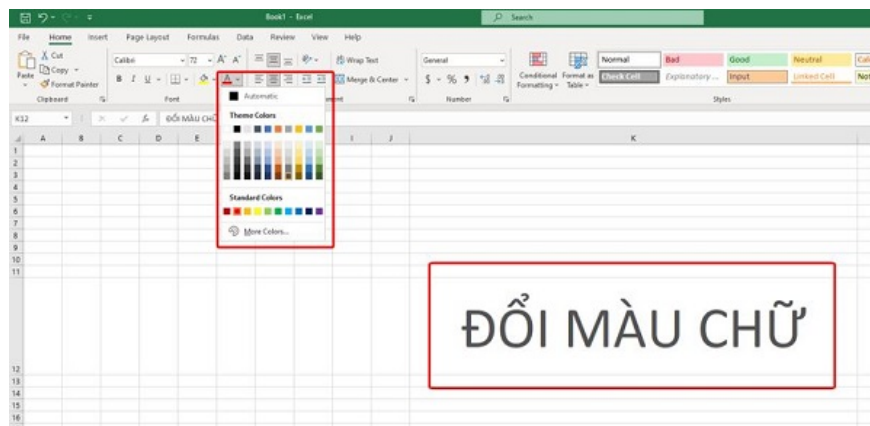
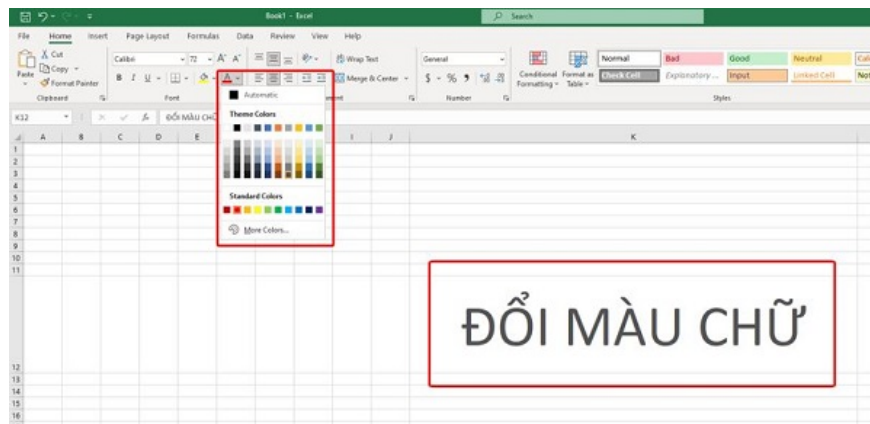


## Instructions on how to change text color in Excel

do not ignore this information!

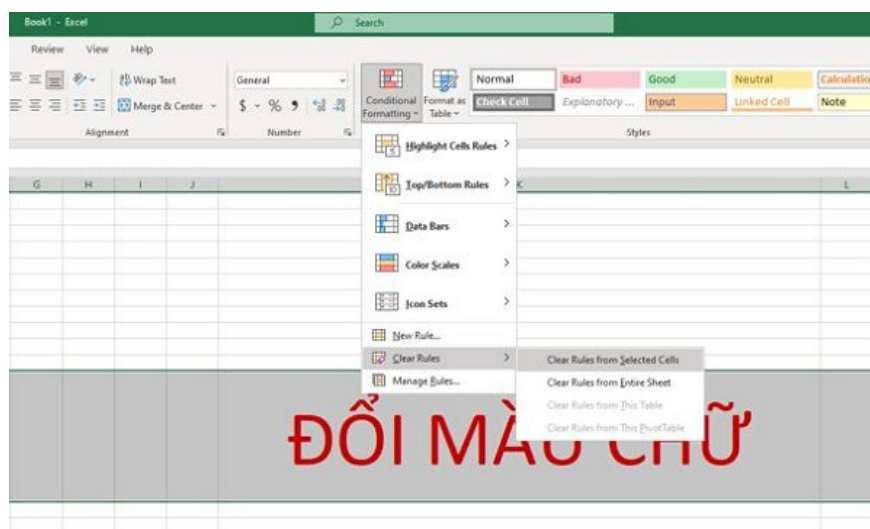
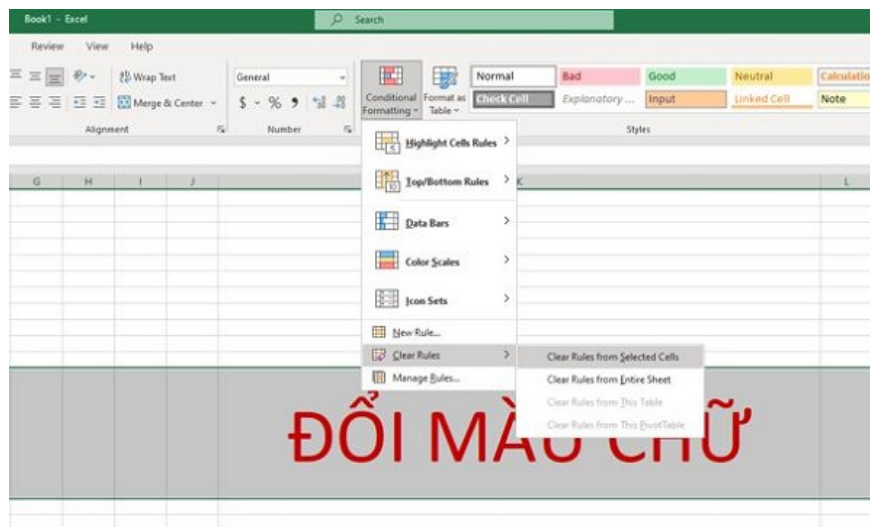
1. **Step 1** : Click to select the cell you want to change the text color. If there are many cells, highlight all the cells that need to change the text color.
2. **Step 2** : Click on font **color** and choose the color you want.



## How to handle when you can't change the text color

If you have followed the instructions above but still cannot change the font color, it is likely that the Excel file has been set to change the font color according to the cell in the **Conditional Formatting** section . However, you do not need to worry too much because with the following steps, you will be able to return the Excel file to normal.

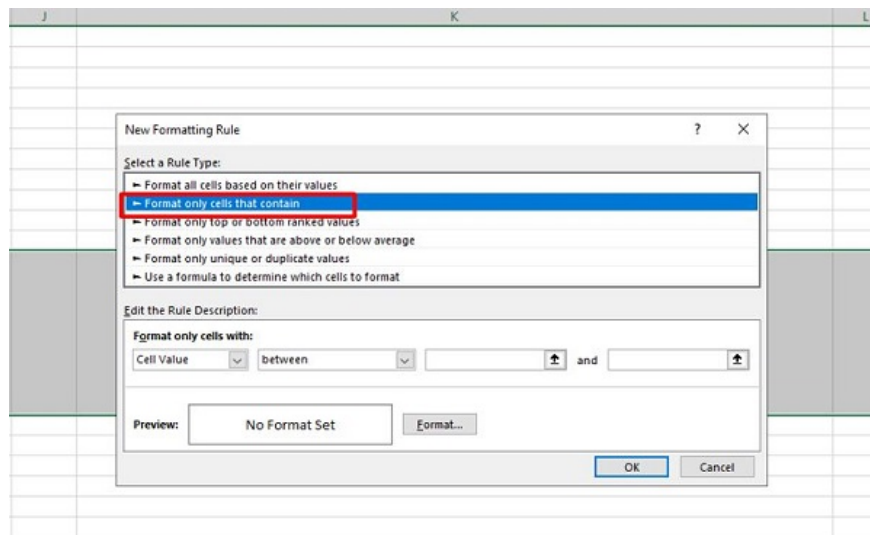
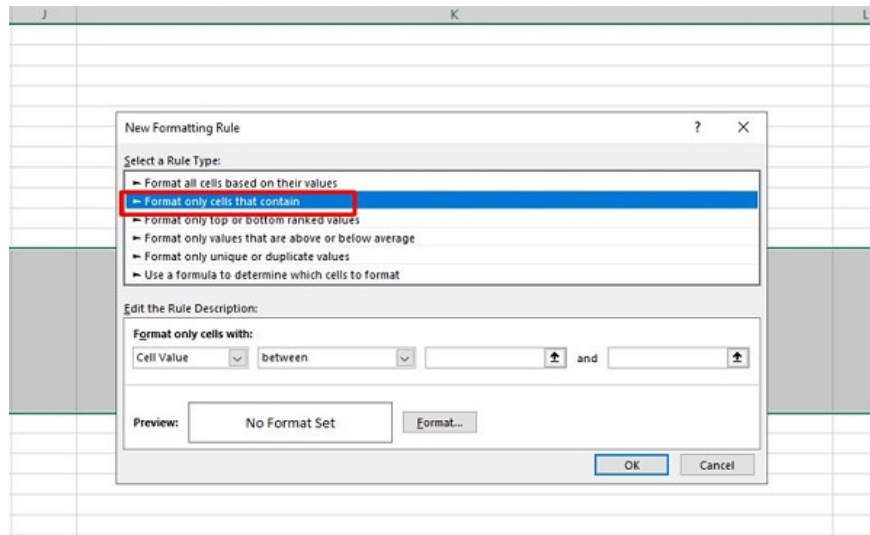
1. **Step 1** : Highlight all the cells whose text color you cannot change. Then go to the **home** tab and select **Conditional Formatting** .
2. **B2** : When the menu appears, select **Clear Rules > Clear Rules From Selected Cells** . At this point, the setting to change the text color by cell has been removed and you can change the text color in the way I instructed above.



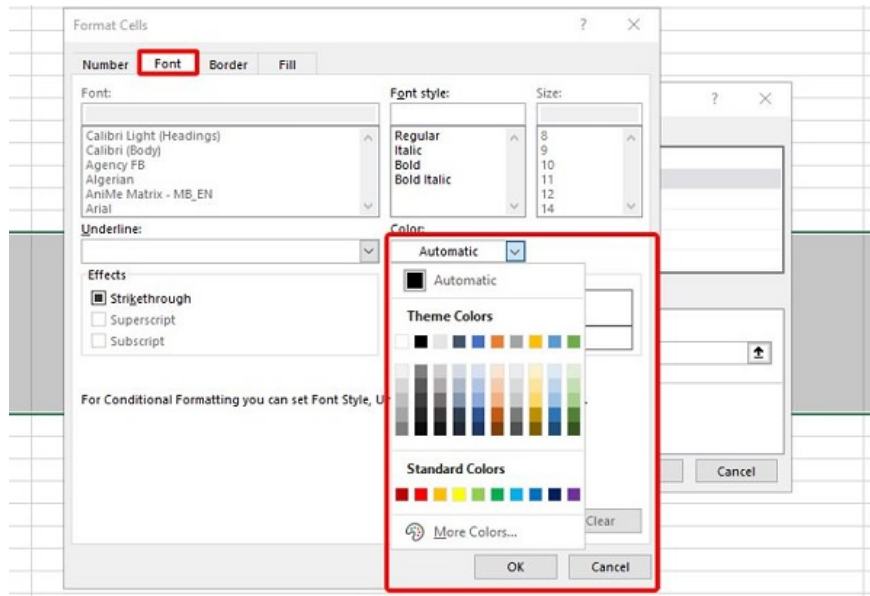
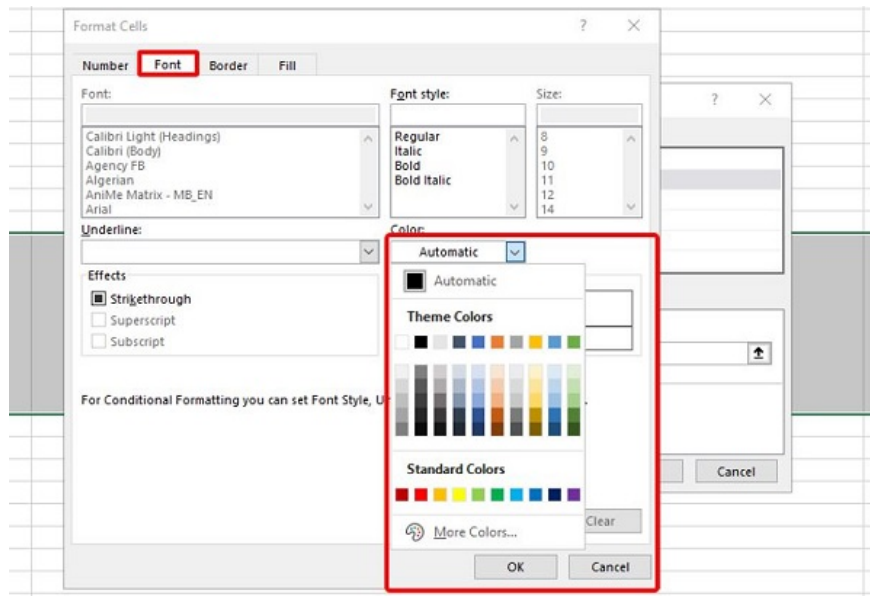
## Instructions on how to color text in Excel according to conditions quickly and effectively

Next, I will guide you how to color text according to conditions in Excel. In case you have too much data and do not want to change the text color manually, this will be an extremely effective solution for you.

1. **Step 1** : Highlight the area you want to color the text, then go to the home tab and select **Conditional Formatting** . When the menu appears, select **New Rule...**
2. **B2** : When the **New Formatting Rule** window appears, select **Format only cells that contain** .



1. **B3** : In the **Format only cells with** section , you edit the values ??of the cells as needed. Once set up, select the format section to open **Format Cells** .
2. **B4** : Expand the color section to select the color you want, then click **ok** to save the settings.



**Note :** in the **New Formatting Rule** table there will be many different options. To be able to use it correctly, please learn carefully before setting it up!
