To ensure a smooth recovery process, make sure your battery level is at least 50% to avoid the risk of sudden power failure. Additionally, remembering your Google account or Huawei ID is mandatory, as the system will require ownership verification immediately after the device restarts.

How to quickly reset a Huawei tablet

There are two common ways to **reset a Huawei tablet** : restoring from system settings or resetting using the hard keys.

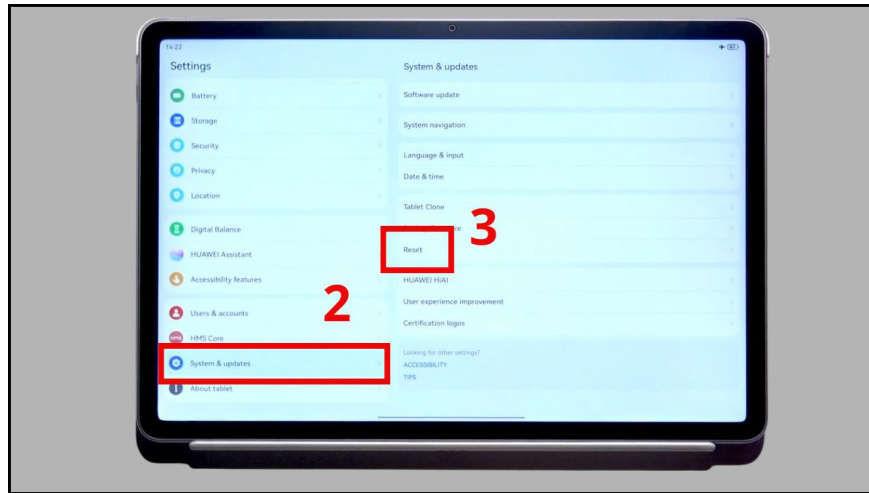
Restore factory settings from the Settings section.

If your Huawei tablet can still access the home screen, this is the safest and quickest method.

1. Step 1: Open Settings.



1. Step 2: Select System & updates ? Press Reset



1. **Step 3:** Select **Reset tablet** .

1. **Step 4:** Select **Reset tablet** .

Once complete, the Huawei tablet will automatically restart with a completely new interface and settings, just like when it was first unboxed.

Note: The reset steps may vary slightly depending on the Huawei tablet model and the installed software version.

Reset your Huawei tablet using the hard buttons.

1. **Step 2:** Select **Touch to Power off** ? Press and hold **the power button and the volume up button** simultaneously until the logo appears.

1. **Step 3:** Select **Clear data** ? Select **Factory reset**

1. **Step 4:** Enter **Yes** and select **Factory reset** ? Wait for the process to complete.

1. **Step 5:** Select **Back** ? Select **Restart** .
