6. Reseller hosting is generally preferred by web developing and designing services providers

### 1. Shared hosting

### 1. WordPress hosting

WordPress hosting is a Content management system where the user just gets to view the content displayed on the website. WordPress Hosting is of two types, namely Shared WordPress Hosting and managed WordPress Hosting. Shared WordPress Hosting is the one that acts similar to Shared Hosting. The Managed WordPress hosting provides enhanced security features when compared to the Shared WordPress hosting.

### 1. **Cloud hosting**
