

Differentiate Apple ID and iCloud

Specifically, on technology forums as well as forums to support iOS users, some of you use iPhone and iPad devices to say that they often confuse Apple ID and iCloud accounts together and don't know. What are the differences and similarities between them?

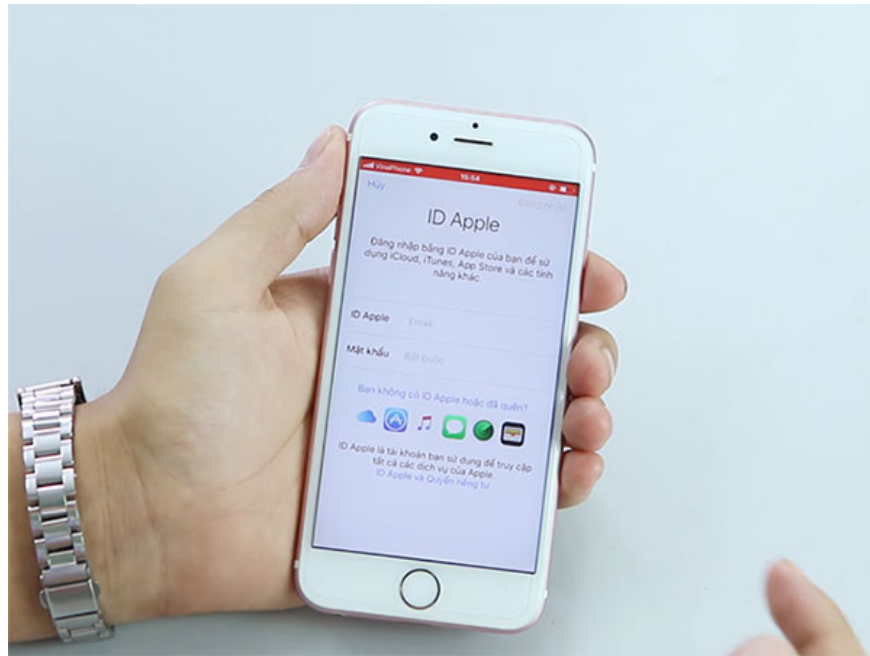

1. What is Apple ID?

Simply put, the Apple ID is the "entry ticket" that helps you register for an Apple device and use it to use other "Apple House" services, including:

1. iCloud.
2. iTunes Store.
3. App Store.
4. iBooks Store.
5. MacStore.

Every time you need to shop at an iTunes store, log in to iCloud, buy an app, use iMessage or more, you need an Apple ID account. To create a free Apple ID account, you sign up for a new account or register your existing email account as an Apple ID on any iOS device, and after registering you can use that account on another device.



Suppose, you have an iPhone and an iPad, you buy an app at the App Store on the iPhone for \$ 4.99, immediately the app information you purchased will be stored in your Apple account. ID. Now you enter that account into the iPad and the app is also downloaded on this iPad. That's called the Apple ID account identity for its services.

2. What is iCloud?

iCloud is actually a service that Apple provides, it helps you store and synchronize data such as images, contacts, notes, calendar, . among Apple devices when sharing 1 Apple ID account and device security.



Why do you often confuse your Apple ID and iCloud accounts together, that's because usually when you go to **Settings> iCloud** , if you don't enter an account, it will display a frame for you to log in, pull down. Below you will find a section to create an Apple ID account. At this point, some of you will wonder in iCloud not create an iCloud account but what do you create Apple ID? It's simple, because iCloud is an Apple service, and Apple ID is an account that allows you to use other services that Apple provides, including iCloud. So it requires you to have an Apple ID to be able to use it.

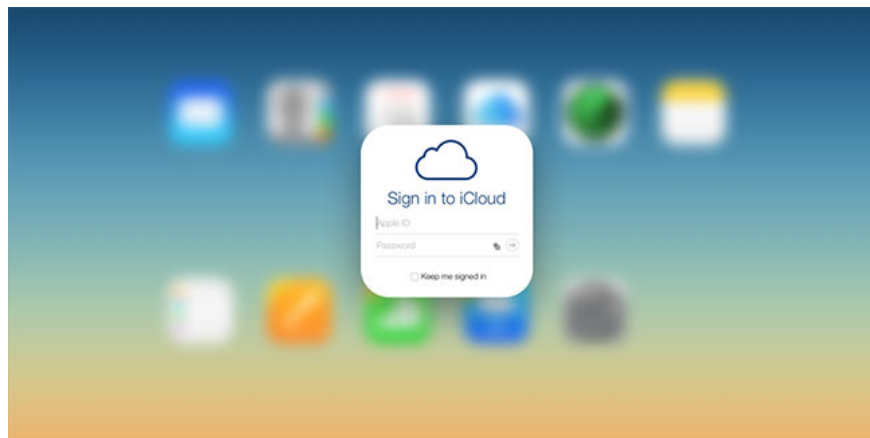


3. Importance of iCloud and Apple ID

Apple ID is an important account, because without an Apple ID you cannot use any Apple service. One advice is that you should create an Apple ID account for yourself, provide accurate information about you and save your account information somewhere to avoid trouble later. Limit use of other Apple ID accounts.

iCloud is also an important service, almost everyone uses iCloud account with two main purposes:

1. **Backup / restore data:** You can upload your personal data (contacts, photos, notes, .) and store in the cloud to easily retrieve them when lost device or whenever you want. However, Apple only allows you to use 5GB of free space, if you want to use more, you have to spend money to hire monthly.
2. **Turn on the "Find iPhone / iPad" feature:** Find My iPhone is one of the extremely useful features of iCloud, it allows you to locate the device where it is, lock or delete the account in case the device Many people have asked for this feature and have found the lost device.



Because of the importance as just introduced above, you need to secure Apple ID as well as iCloud in a thoughtful way, avoiding revealing passwords or sharing to others. If you forget your password, you will not be able to access the iCloud service again or with high iOS lives like iOS 7 and 8 when you restore the device that requires a password, you cannot enter the correct password, which means you cannot use the device. I can. Please take careful notes and use security questions in case you forget to retrieve your password.
