

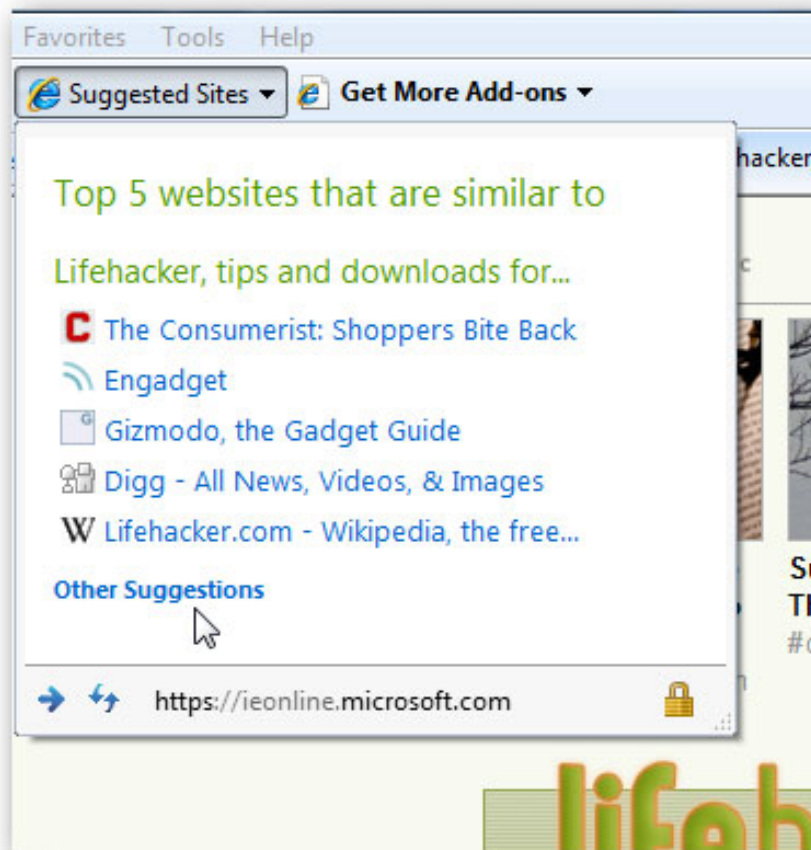
Disable and remove Suggested Sites in IE8

In this article we will show you how to disable this feature Suggested Sites and remove it from the Toolbar.

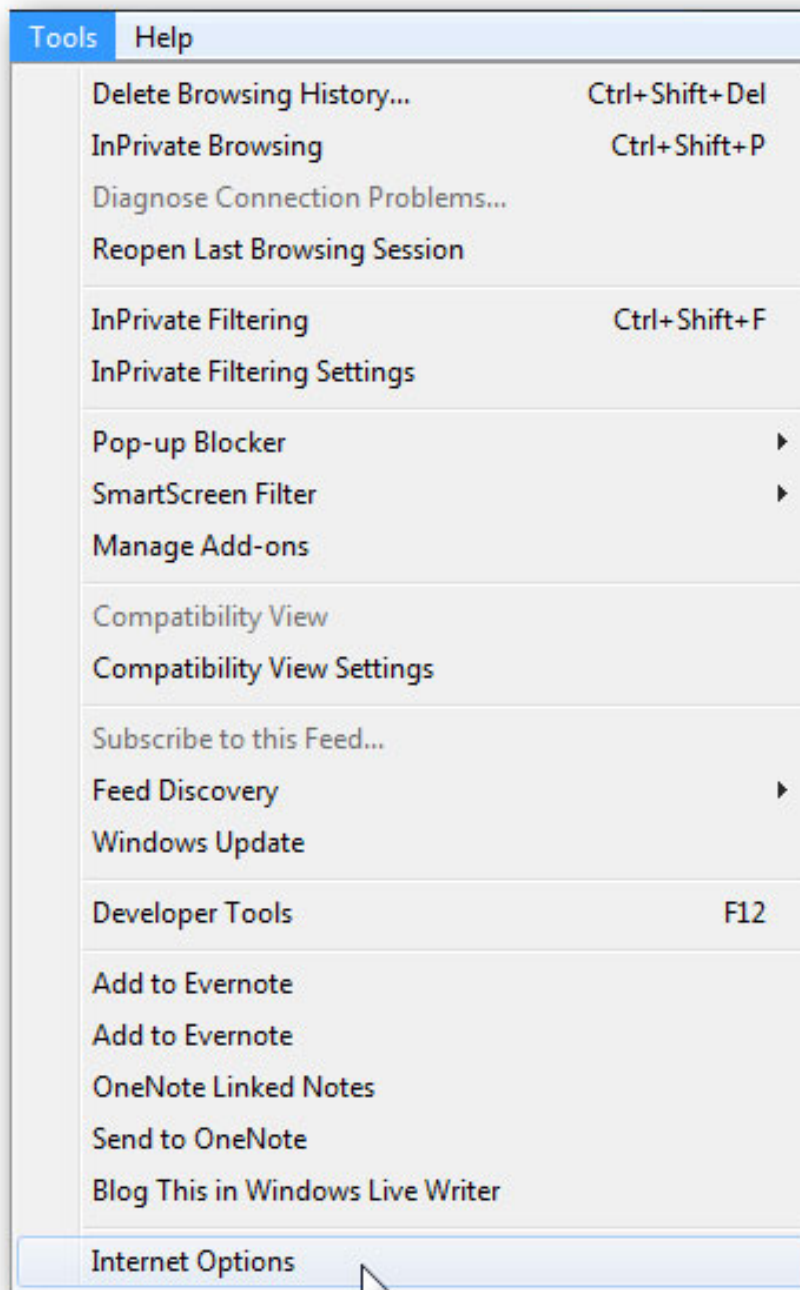
Network Administration - If you are an Internet Explorer 8 user of your choice or due to work requirements, you will definitely see the Suggested Sites feature in Favorites Bar sometimes annoys you. Therefore in this article we will introduce to you how to disable the Suggested Sites feature and remove it from the Toolbar.

Turn off Suggested Sites feature

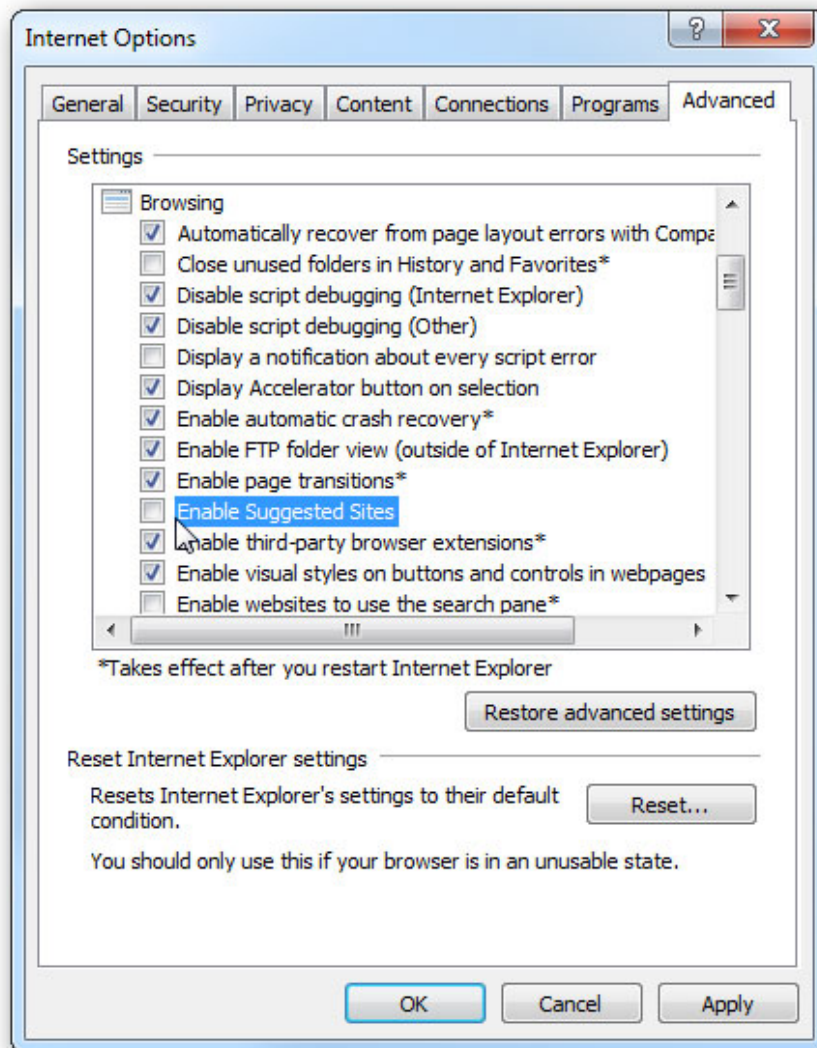
Suggested Sites is a feature available in Internet Explorer 8 (*in Windows 7 by default*) and allows you to find sites similar to the page you will visit. When Suggested Sites is turned on, your browser history will be sent to Microsoft, and conducted compared to the list of newly updated relevant sites.



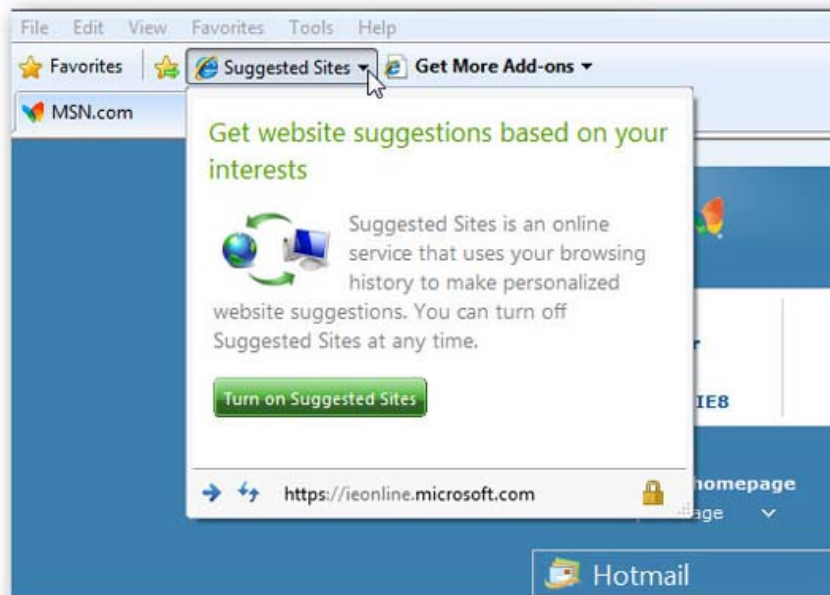
To turn off this feature, click **Tools Internet Options** .



Click the **Advanced** tab, then scroll down and find the *Enable Suggested Sites* section, then cancel the check box next to Enable Suggested Sites and click **OK** .

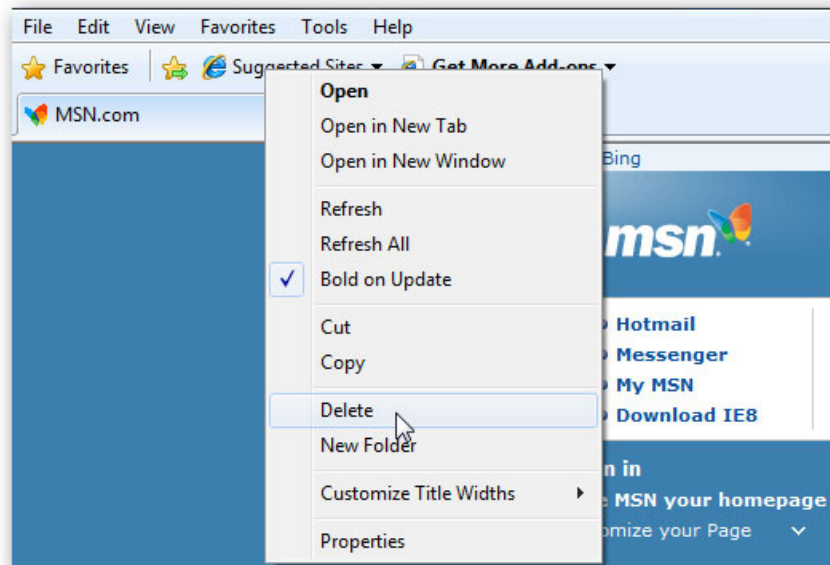


Now, when clicking **Suggested Sites** , you will see that it has been disabled and you can activate it back from here if you want.

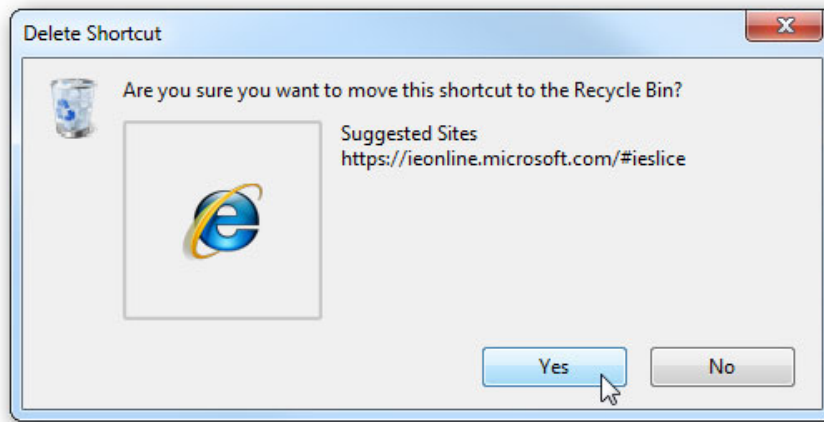


Remove from Favorites Bar

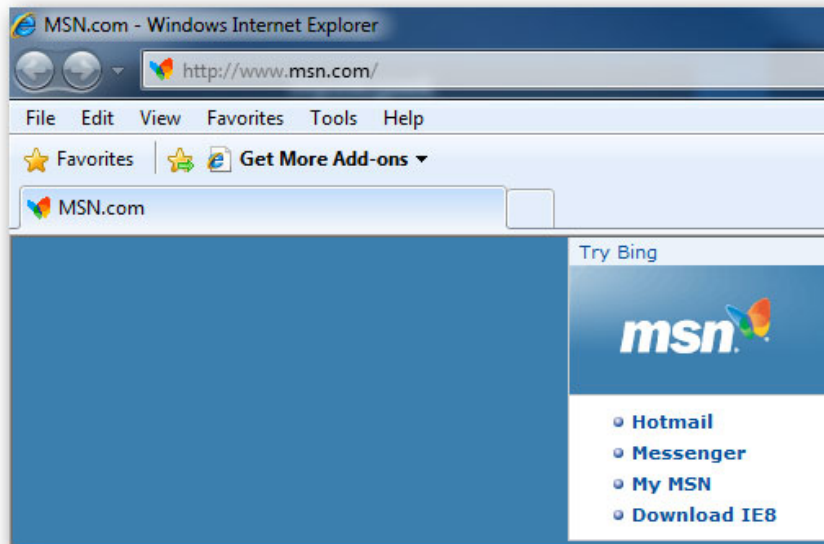
You can turn off Suggested Sites feature, but in addition you can also remove it from the favorites bar. Very simply, just right-click **Suggested Sites** , then click **Delete** .



Click **Yes** in the confirmation screen.



At that time, Suggested Sites feature was turned off and it was also removed from the favorites bar.



If you are concerned about Microsoft detecting your browsing, then turn off the Suggested Sites feature. When not using this feature, you can also remove it from Favorite bar.
