

Disable Link Preview on Outlook Web

The drawback of the Link Preview in Outlook is that it loses the email aesthetics, looking so much worse. If you want to disable this feature in Outlook Web please refer to this article.

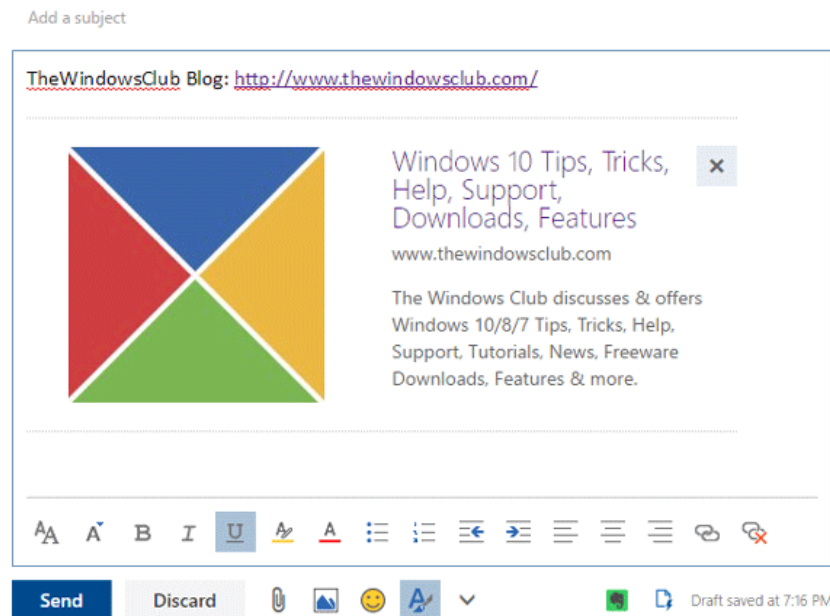
Undeniably the role of Link Preview, in some cases this feature is quite useful. Thanks to this feature, users can get a preview of the website before clicking on the link or landing on the page. However, the drawback of Link Preview is the loss of aesthetics of emails, your email looks much worse.

Therefore, you should disable this feature in Outlook Web so that the email looks better.

1. What is Link Preview on Outlook.com?

In the process of composing an email, sometimes we share links to different websites including social networking links, blog links, YouTube videos, SlideShare, . If you pay close attention you can See that after pasting the link into the email, it pulls data from the web page and displays it in the email. This feature is called Link Preview feature.

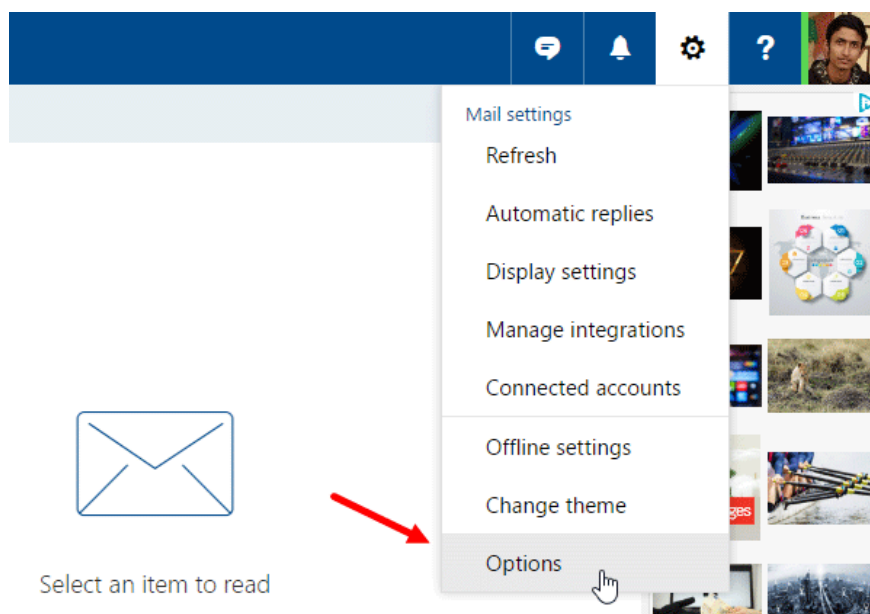
For example, if you share the URL of an article or article, you will receive the images, article titles, domain names, and meta descriptions used on that page.



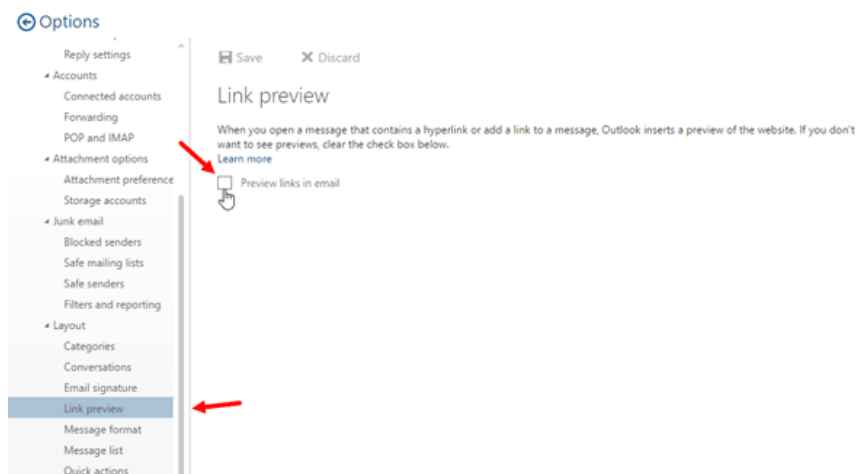
In some cases, the Link Preview is quite useful. Thanks to this feature, users can get a preview of the website before clicking on the link or landing on the page. However, the drawback of Link Preview is the loss of aesthetics of emails, your email looks much worse. Therefore you should disable this feature in Outlook Web.

2. Disable Link Preview on Outlook Web

To disable Link Preview, first visit **Outlook.com** , then log in to your account. You should now see the serrated **Settings** icon in the top right corner. Click on that **Settings** icon and select **Options** .



On the next page, navigate to **Mail** => **Layout** => **Link preview** . Or alternatively, click on this link: <https://outlook.live.com/owa/> for direct access.



By default you will see the check box next to **Preview links in email** . Your task is simply to remove it and click **Save** to apply the change.

Follow these steps and Link Preview will no longer appear every time you share any link.

In case if you want to bring the Link Preview back, do the same steps and check **Preview links in email to finish**.
