

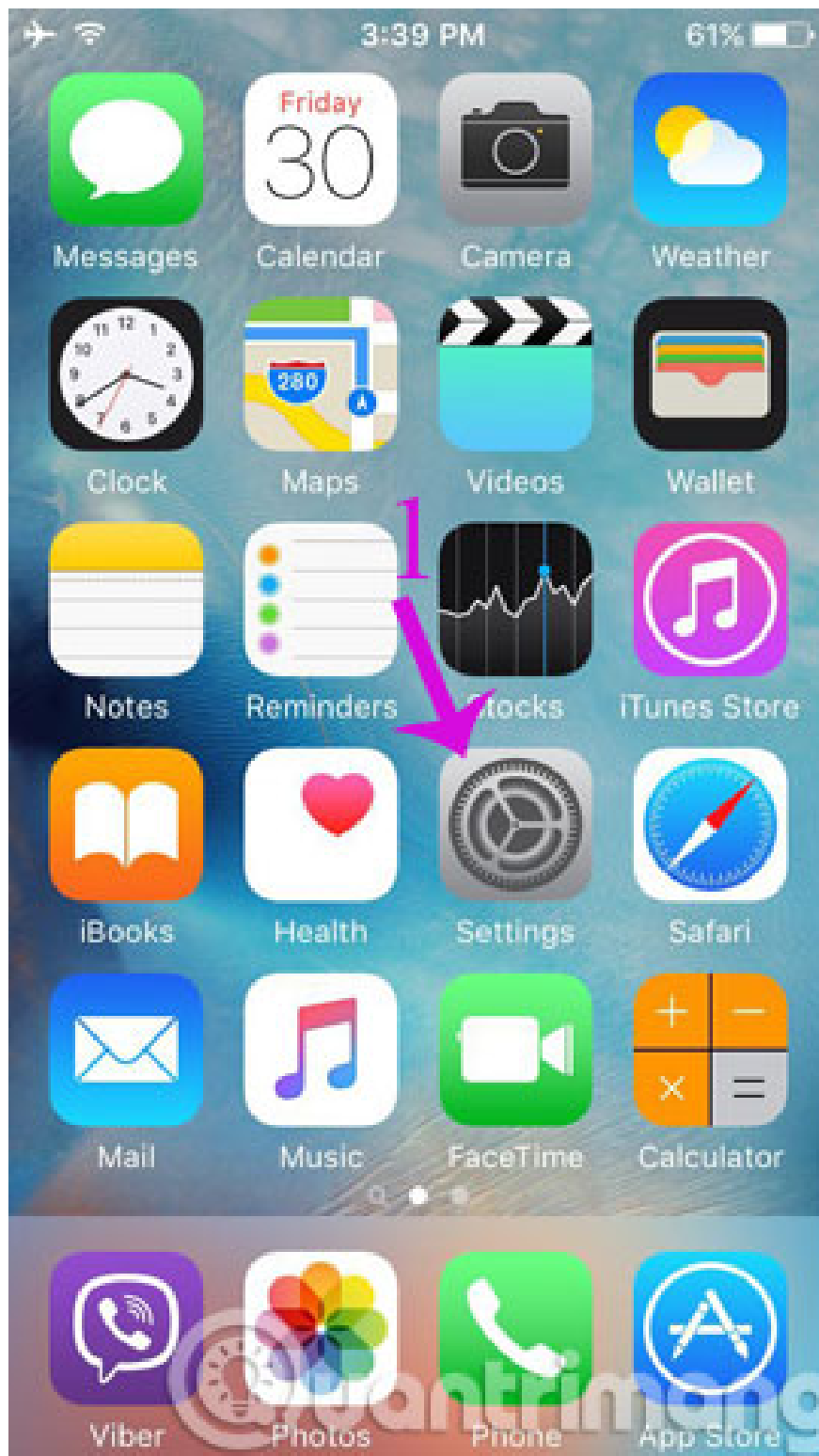

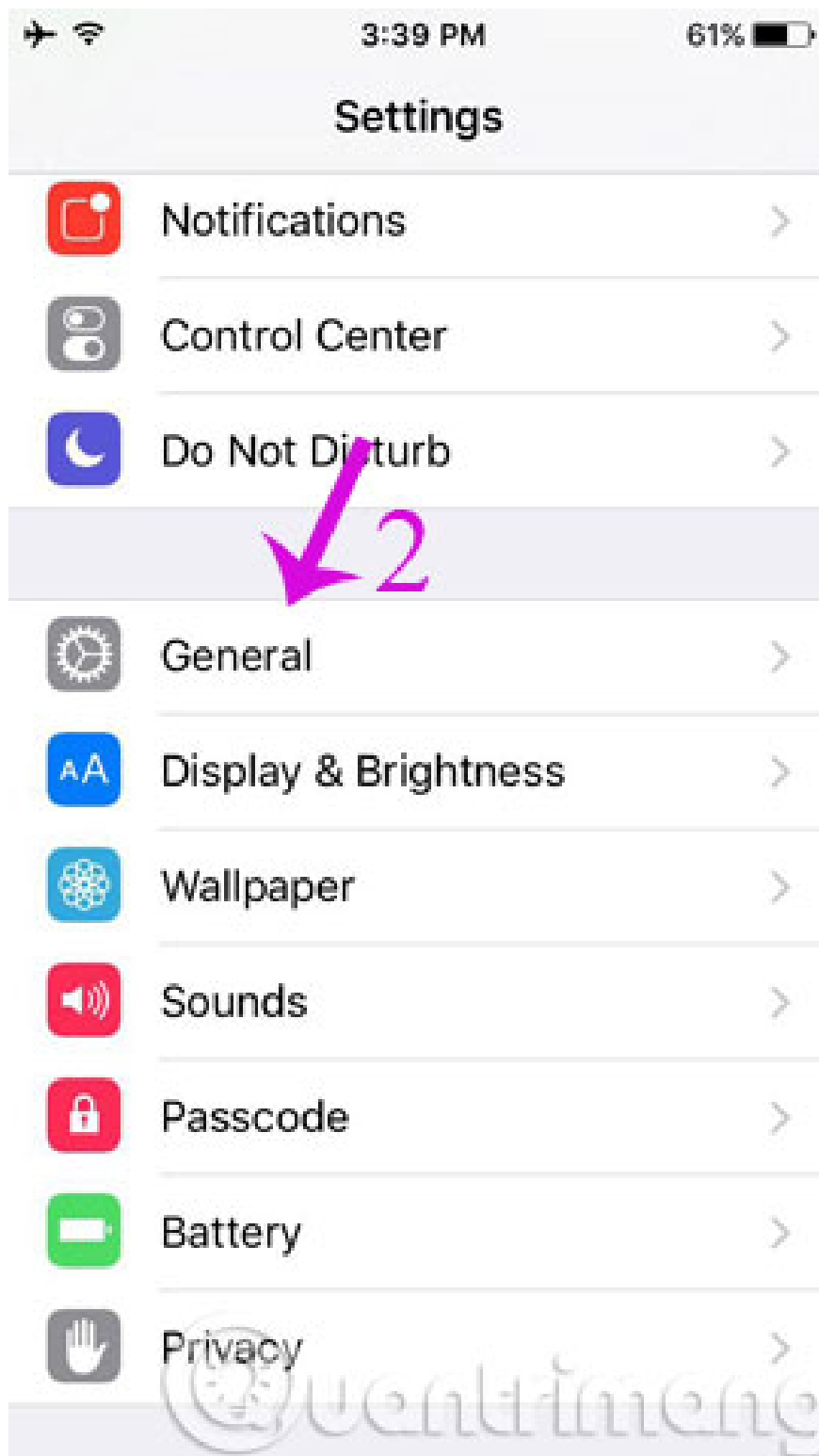

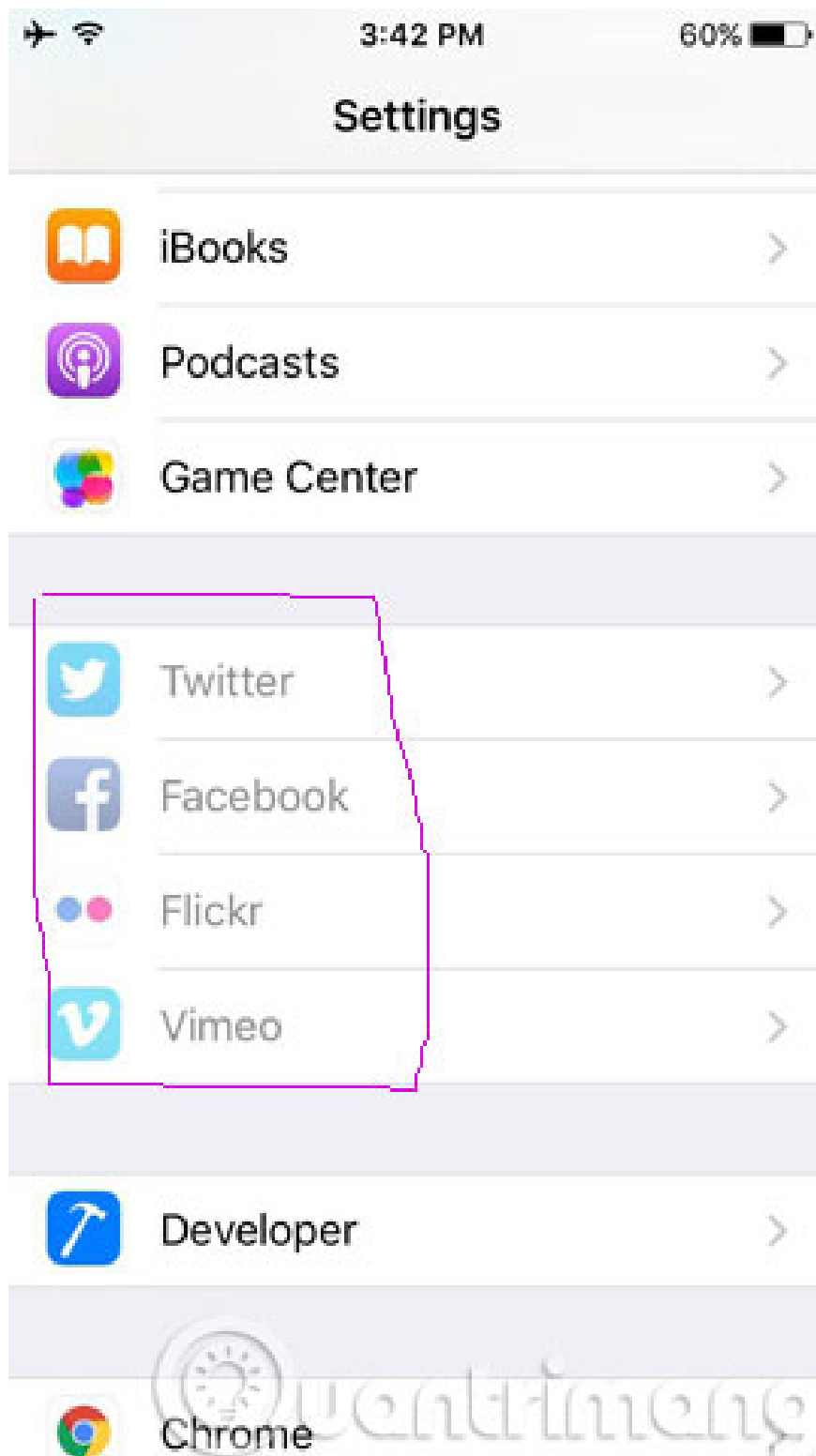




Step 3 : Inside the Accounts interface, check to **Don't Allow Changes**



Step 4 : Go back to **Settings** , you can see a lot of applications such as **Facebook** , **Twitter** , **Flickr** , **Vimeo** have been blurred and unusable.



In case, if you want to reactivate, just repeat the above steps and check on **Allow Changes** and exit is done.

By locking the feature to change your login account to iCloud, you can be more secure when you lend your device, others will not be able to access your iCloud account anymore.
