

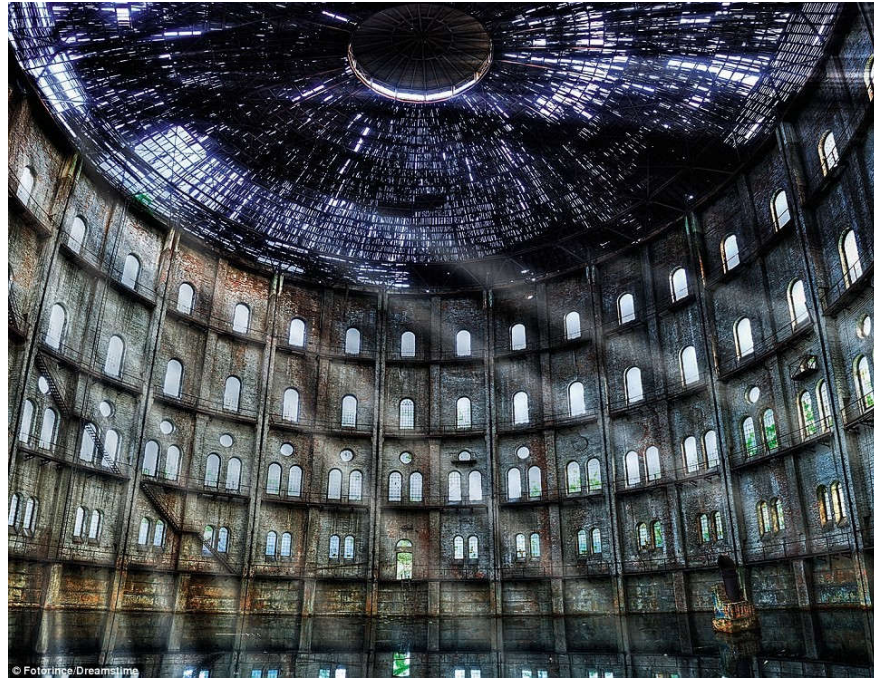
Discover abandoned places full of ghosts in the world

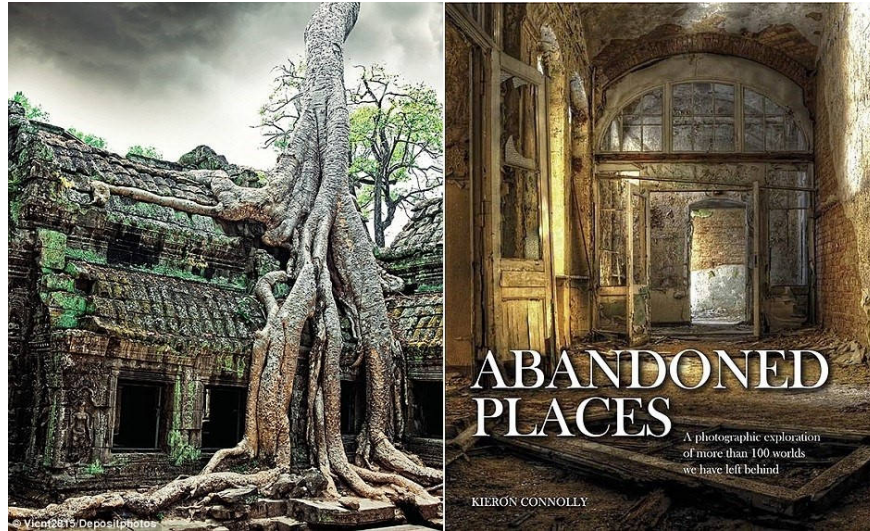
The Uyuni Shipyard , where railways and locomotives, and the shipyard serving Bolivia's mining industry were left after the industry faded away.



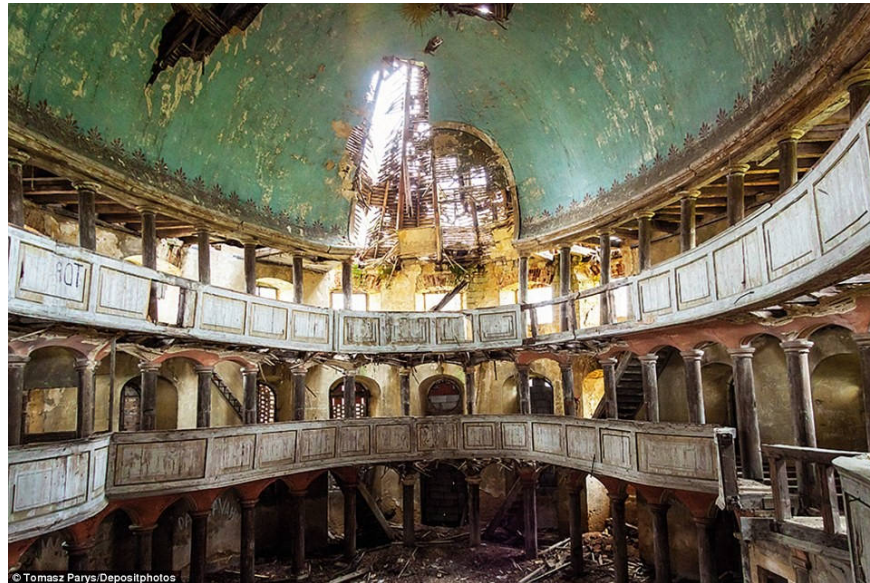
Before the 1970s, **this large building in Warsaw** (Poland) was a Wola gas plant, operating since 1888. But when the city switched to natural gas, the factory was abandoned. Currently, only a part of the factory is used as a museum.



Jet Star gliders in Seaside Heights (New Jersey, USA) were flooded and left after Hurricane Sandy collapsed most of the jetty in 2012.



Ta Prohm Temple in Angkor Wat, Siem Reap, Cambodia is surrounded by the roots of old trees. The temple is surrounded by tropical forests and cinemas.



The Protestant church in Zeliszow village (Poland) built in the 18th century was abandoned. The roof of the church has a big hole, peeling paint and wood fragments lying on the floor.



The hotel has an unfinished human face, looking down at the valley below to impress Kieron Connolly. This hotel is located near the ghost town of Ma Feng Do, on the north bank of Changjiang River, China.



In 1978, the Romanian government decided to exploit Europe's largest copper mine in the region. All people must go to the city. **The village of Geamana** is sunk in the sea. Today, water in this area is red due to cyanide and other chemicals. You can only see the spire of the church above the water.



In the early 1908, in Cape Romano (Florida, USA) for the construction of houses using solar energy. But after Hurricane Andrew (1922) and hurricane Wilma (2005) flooded here, the houses were badly damaged and destroyed part of the coast. Currently, no one lives in this area and visitors can only come here by boat.



Located in the Wonderland amusement park on the outskirts of Beijing, this unfinished castle was abandoned because investors withdrew.



1859, **the town of Bodie** (California, USA) was bustling because people flocked here to find gold. The gold fever passed away, it was abandoned and became ruined. Today there are many tourists come here to travel and take pictures.



This vehicle graveyard is located in the Kabul Military Training Center, Afghanistan. Leaked tanks and armored vehicles after many years were not used.



Beelitz-Heilstätten Hospital in Brandenburg (Germany) was built between 1898 and 1930 to serve the army during World War I and World War II. Where used to treat Adolf Hitler fascist. The hospital was abandoned after 1994. With the mysterious, creepy areas such as surgery rooms, psychiatric treatment rooms, . this place became an attractive destination for curious people.



Rubjerg Knude lighthouse located in Denmark was built 2300m high. Due to the erosion and impacts of sand dunes, the lighthouse stopped operating in 1968. As expected, the lighthouse will collapse into the sea by 2023.



Since 1997, the capital of the **island of Montserrat** (British territory) is buried in volcanic ash and so far people have not returned.



The diamond mine in Mirny (Siberia) is the second largest artificial pit in the world with a depth of 525 meters and a diameter of 1200 meters. In 2004 the mine was officially closed and the towns around that area were no longer living.



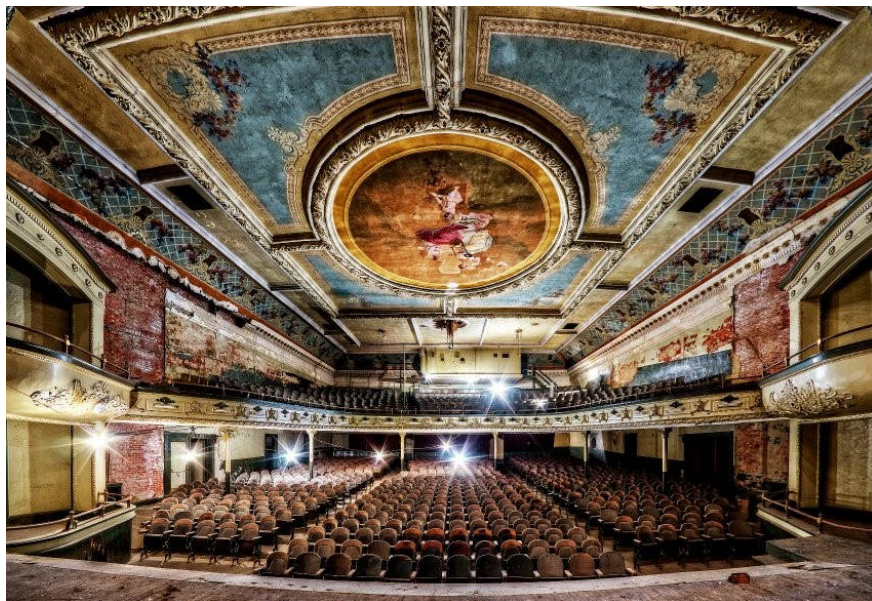
The World War II fortress was located at the mouth of the River Thames and the North Sea off England was built in 1942, and stopped in 1950. This fortress consists of solid small towers designed like the ones in Fiction film.



Japan's Hashima Island is often called the island battle. The island is about 6 hectares and there are more than 5,000 people (including miners and their families) living here in 1959. Due to failed business, in 1974, the mine closed and the people were forced to leave the island. In 2015, this uninhabited island was recognized as a world heritage by UNESCO.



The luxurious **Hachijo hotel** is built on the volcanic island Hachijojima, once known as Japan's Hawaii. However, this hotel has been closed since 2003 until now.



Orpheum Theater with a capacity of 1,500 people opened in 1912 in New Bedford, Massachusetts, USA. The theater was then used as a theater before closing around 1958-1959.



In 1944, the entire population of France's **village of Oradour-sur-Glane** was massacred. The village became a memorial after World War II.
