Brown snakes began to appear on the island after World War II. After 70 years of settling there, they proliferate, grow and now become the scariest "enemy" of many animals and animals. people on the island. Biologists estimate that for every hectare of forest there are 70 brown snakes.

With aggressive nature and night hunting. They are responsible for 10 out of 12 native bird species being extinct. They even attacked cattle and humans and destroyed power lines and phones, causing power outages and outages.

Brown snake venom attacks the nervous system and endangers human life if it is not treated and treated promptly.

In response to the situation, in 2013 the government of Guam and the US authorities issued a solution to eliminate this snake.

Because brown tree snakes do not have enemies, they must use **Acetaminophen** , an active ingredient in human pain relievers, but extremely dangerous with brown snakes.

They fed thousands of rats with a series of baits containing this compound (Acetaminophen is also dangerous for rats) and spread them down about 40 hectares of forest to snare snakes. The results were quite satisfactory, but only a short time later this snake quickly proliferated again.

Perhaps the government and the people here still have to "think" many other measures, to eliminate the "assassins" that destroy and protect the safe natural environment for other animals.
