Here, he had to undergo a terrifying feeling as if the **soul left the body** (soul or "astral projection"). He saw his own body lying motionless underneath, while the soul hovered in the air.

He was even told stories by the priests about the pyramid, and demonstrated to him the existence of **the soul and the afterlife** . Then suddenly he " *revived* " .

The ancient Egyptians believed in the afterlife, believing that the soul existed forever and that the body had to be preserved intact, the soul could be fully preserved.
