The Mi-26 first appeared in 1984, in Afghanistan to carry out the task of transporting combat equipment, evacuating wounded people from the battlefield and recovering damaged Mi-8 helicopters.

In 2002, the Mi-26 continued to fly into Afghanistan's sky once again to evacuate damaged two AS532 helicopters Cougar and MH-47E Chinook in the mountains.

This Russian army's iconic helicopter could easily carry light tanks and infantry fighting vehicles.



In 2009, residents in St. Petersburg were shocked to see a Mi-26 carrying a Tu-134 plane from Pulkovo airport to the EMERCOM training area.

But this giant helicopter is used not only in the military, but also for industrial use, such as carrying construction materials, even for fighting or rescuing a polar bear. lost mother. But perhaps the most impressive Mi-26 was when carrying a frozen mammoth weighing up to 20 tons.



However, in 2002, the world's largest helicopter Mi-26 was shot down, killing 127 people on board during the second Chechen war in North Caucasus.
