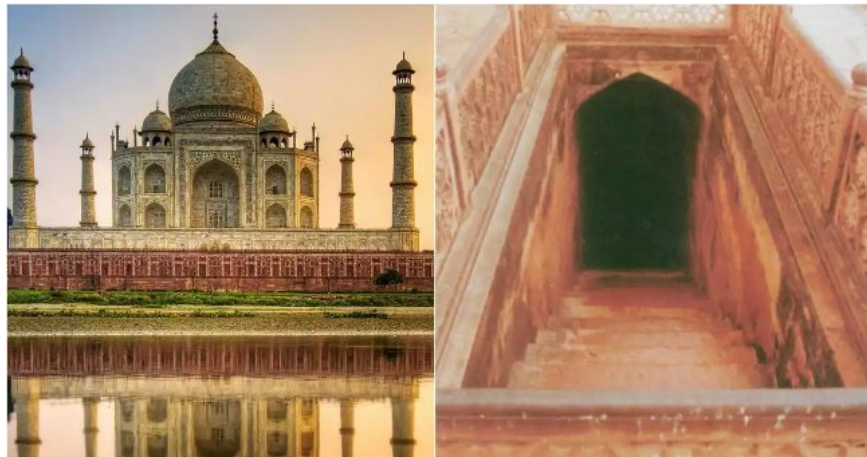

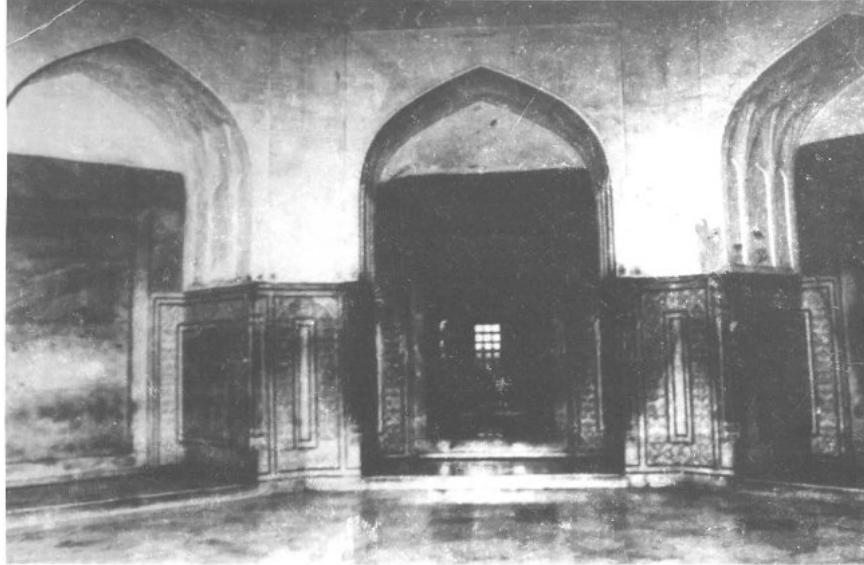

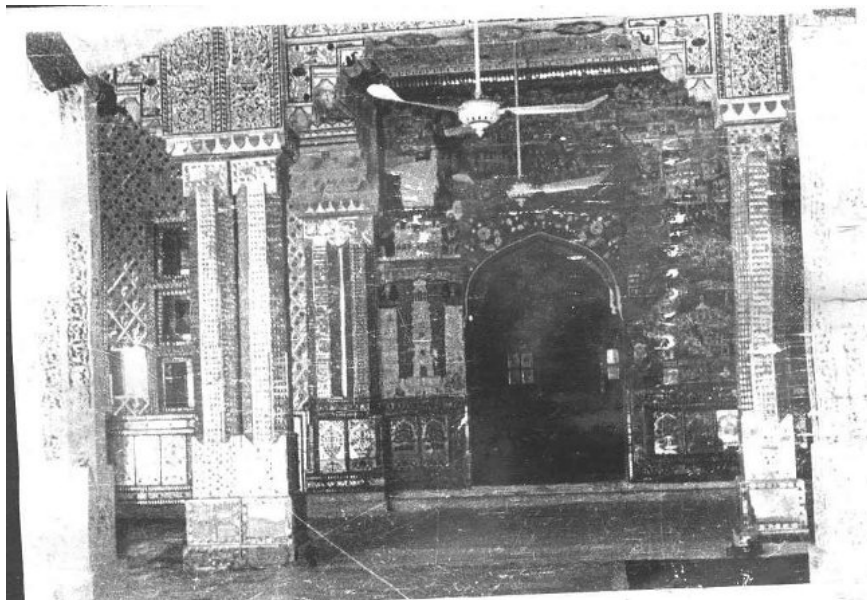

Who wants to go into these dark rooms? Many entrances to one of the secret rooms under the Taj Mahal have been sealed with bricks and lime.

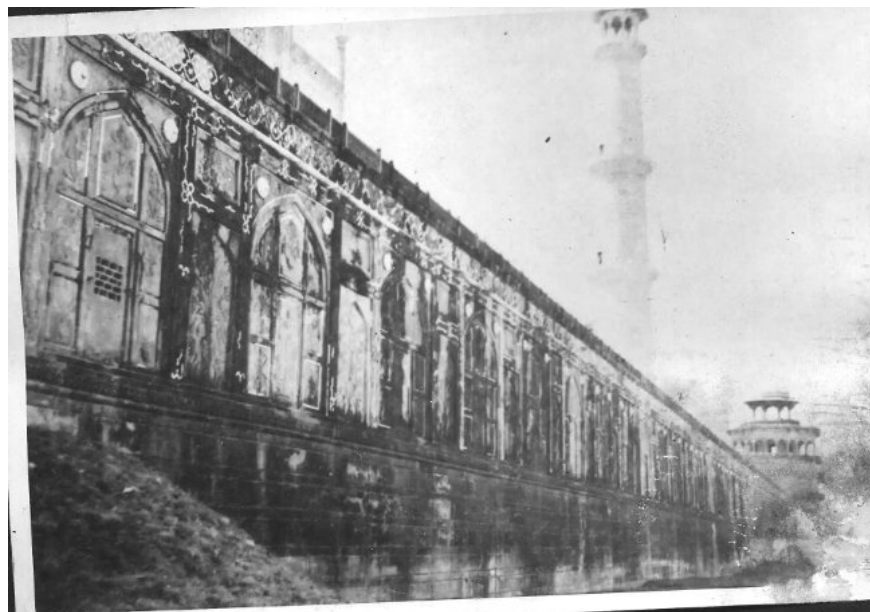
There are now thousands of such domes and all have their own myths associated with it.

From a Hindu perspective, the Taj Mahal was originally a temple for Lord Shiva.

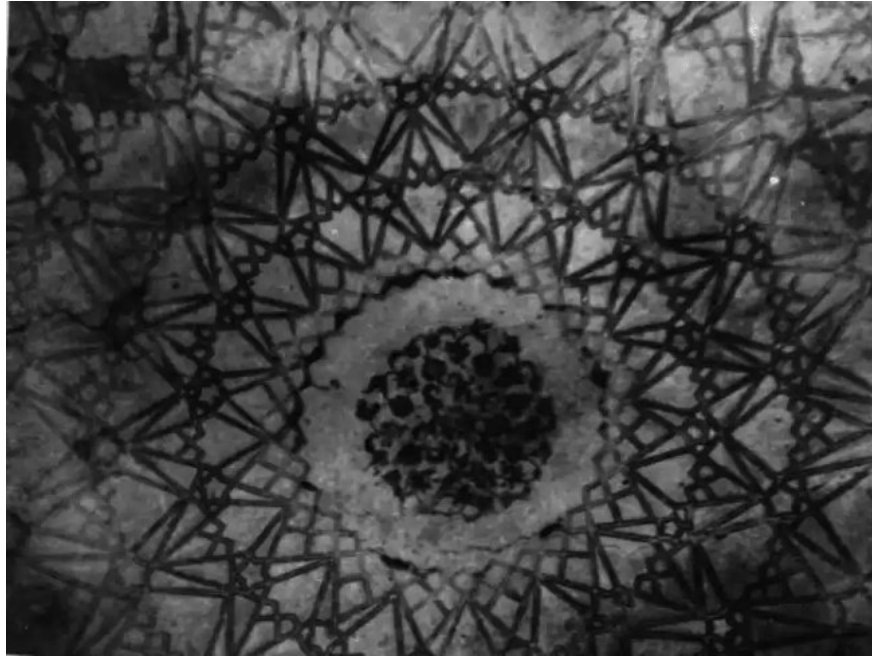
Shah Jahan covers ventilation fans with brick or marble tiles to hide any Hindu origin. He hid Hindu idols and images in those rooms.

The symbols are derived from Hinduism



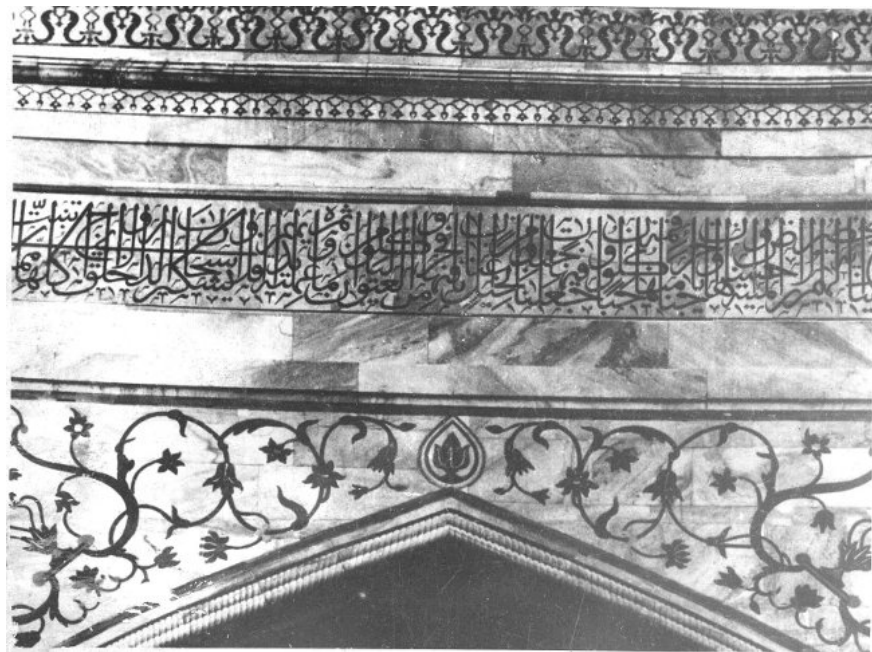
The pillars are full of sculptures of gods and Hindu goddesses.

Ignore divine obsession and explain with science

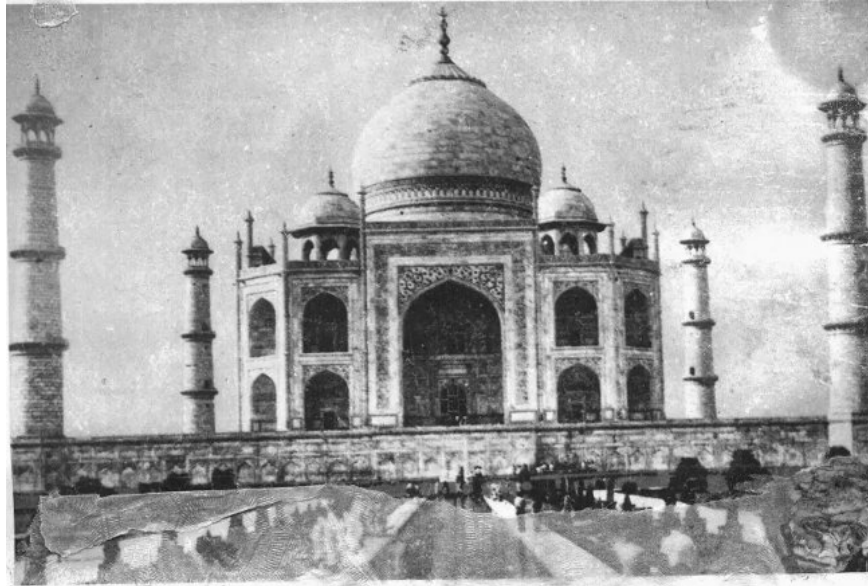

A place to review history



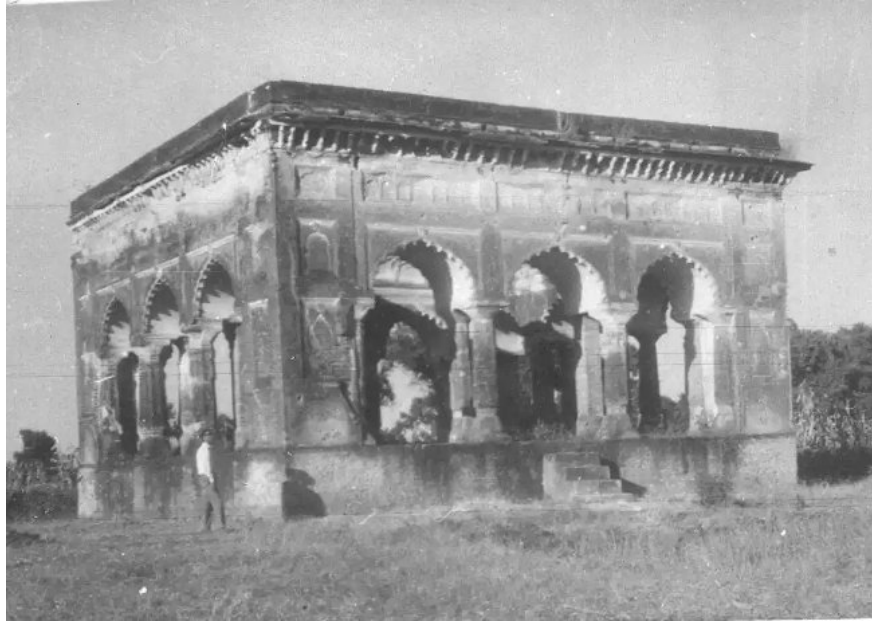
