

# Discovered an ancient mound of 2,500 years old in England

A huge strange object like a mound has just been found at Skipsea Castle in England estimated that this mound is 2,500 years old.

A strange mass of objects like a mound just found near **Skipsea Castle** in England is estimated to be 2,500 years old.

According to British archaeologists, this mound was created by **the Norman** strain, who lived in the year from 1086 in the area near Skipsea castle.
