In 1885, Van Gogh once complained to his brother about the fact that he had to pick up hundreds of flies or more, dust, sand . from the paintings.

When examining the picture under a microscope, researcher Mary Schafer accidentally discovered this object hidden under green and brown patches on the painting.



According to experts, this grasshopper has died before accidentally entering and becoming part of the "Olive tree". Because they found that this grasshopper was missing the chest, abdomen and there was no sign of movement in the picture.
