Accordingly, this tomb was discovered right at the **Necropolis, Poggetto Mengarelli** , in the town of Etruscan of the old city of Vulci, **central Italy** .



The new discovery shows that this is the grave of a man, of the VIII century, BC and a system of unbelievably diverse antiques.

A few bones and teeth, some **long bones** , personal ornaments made of copper, a **ring** , a metal buckle were also found.



An ancient impasto jar and a 2-cup wine cup made of painted ceramics are found in the tomb.



Three bowls and two ceramic cups have horizontal stripes, and a kyathos (a deep bowl for drinking water / wine) is placed opposite the head of the remains.



A razor-shaped razor, half of a moon made of bronze with magnificent motifs, a distinctive iron spike and a series of copper rings, a small ax and a blade discovered next to the **skeleton** .



All reflect a particular, confusing burial form of **the ancient** Eighth-century and BC **inhabitants** .

In addition, there is a **crypt of the** same type and time was unfortunately looted, found in the same area, south of the cemetery.
