

Distinguish real and fake goods when buying 'apple flaws'

iPad 2, iPhone 4, iPod, MacBook ... now appear quite popular in Vietnam market. However, many people still cannot distinguish the real and fake 'apple' when standing in front of an electronics store.

In order to identify genuine Apple products, the buyer should note the product's stamp. Because genuine Apple products such as iPad, iPhone, iPod, MacBook . distributed in Vietnam market must always ensure full 2 types of stamps: stamps of distributor of products, standard conformity stamps paste on the side of the product container.

In particular, the distributor's stamp clearly indicates the origin of the import. The standard conformity stamp is issued by Ministry of Information & Communications to affirm product quality in accordance with standards of IT products circulating in Vietnam. This certificate is only applicable for products with genuine origin after inspection.

In addition, buyers need to pay attention to check whether the product has intact seals and the distributor's warranty card. This will ensure consumers' rights when warranting product warranty later.

There are a lot of Apple products on the market that do not have clear origins. Due to the overconfidence of stores with the ' *apple* ' logo and due to little technical knowledge, users can buy genuine air. Floating goods are not only of poor quality, but when the product has problems, consumers are not entitled to Apple's warranty policies.

Many Apple stores are ready to buy the *genuine* 'Apple' box used to repackage old Apple products or refurbish out-of-warranty products sold to consumers.

Another way is that users can access the list of qualified stores that they have officially recognized on the website at <http://store.apple.com/vn>. After that, the buyer continues to click on the ' **Find a Reseller** ' item and select the country (Vietnam) to find the store list.
