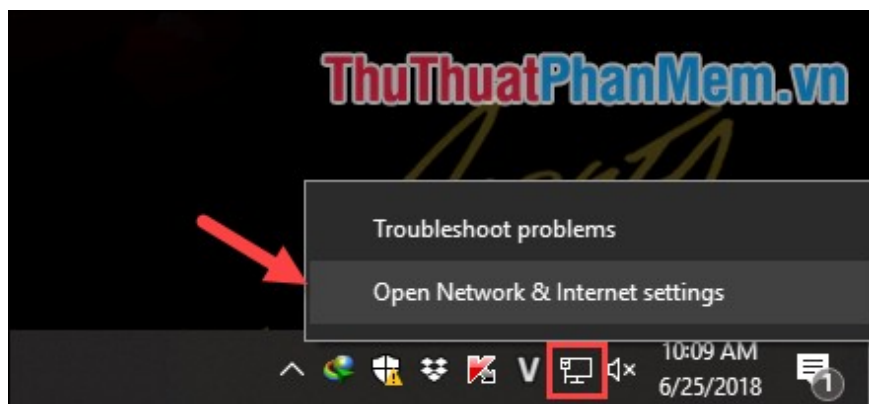


# DNS VNPT - How to change DNS VNPT for faster network access

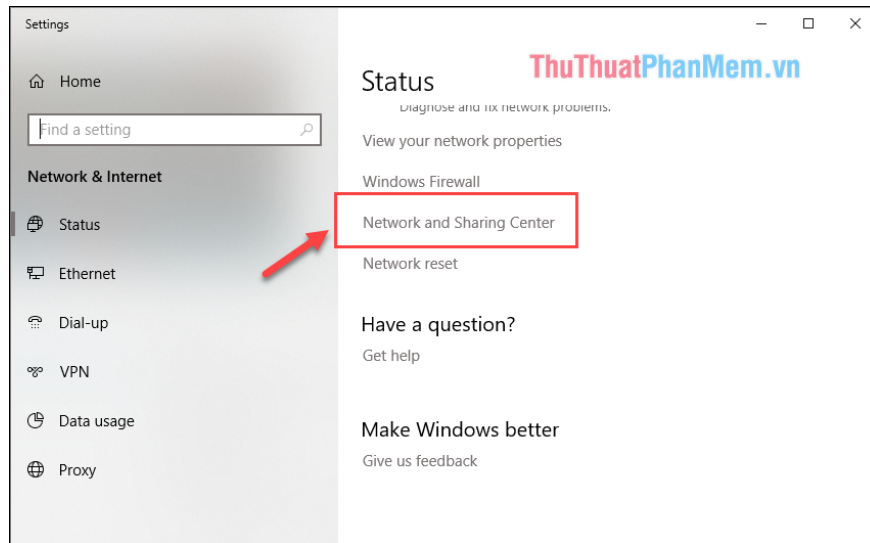
DNS VNPT - How to change DNS VNPT for faster network access. Change DNS, this solution will help us somewhat in speeding up the internet.

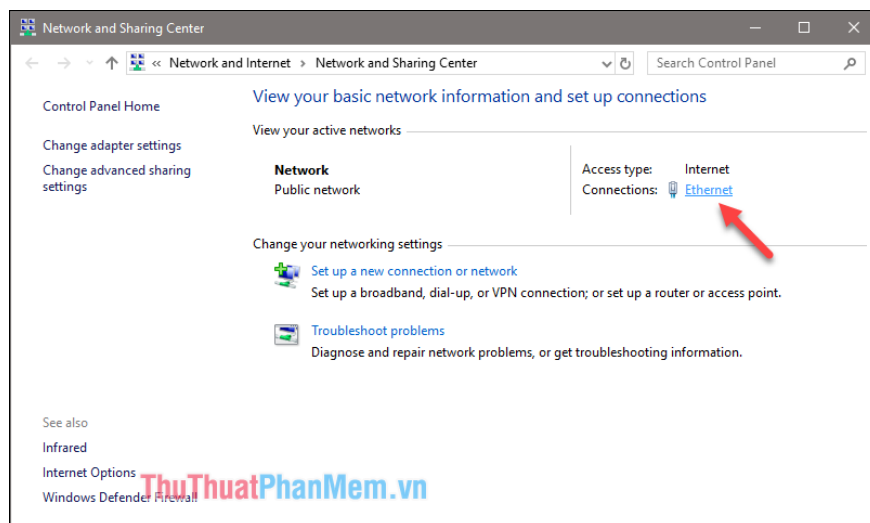
**Step 1:** Right-click on the internet connection icon and then select **Open Network & Internet settings**.



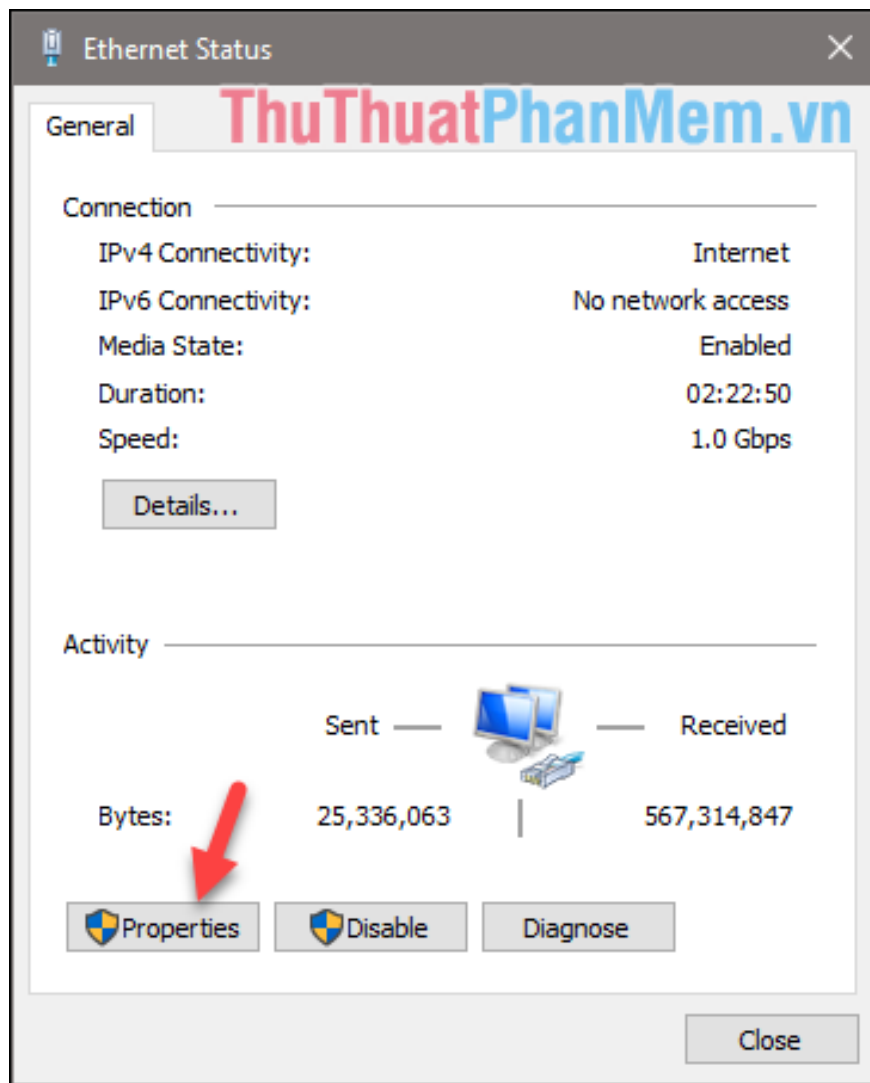
**Step 2:** The settings window appears, scroll down and select **Network and Sharing Center**.



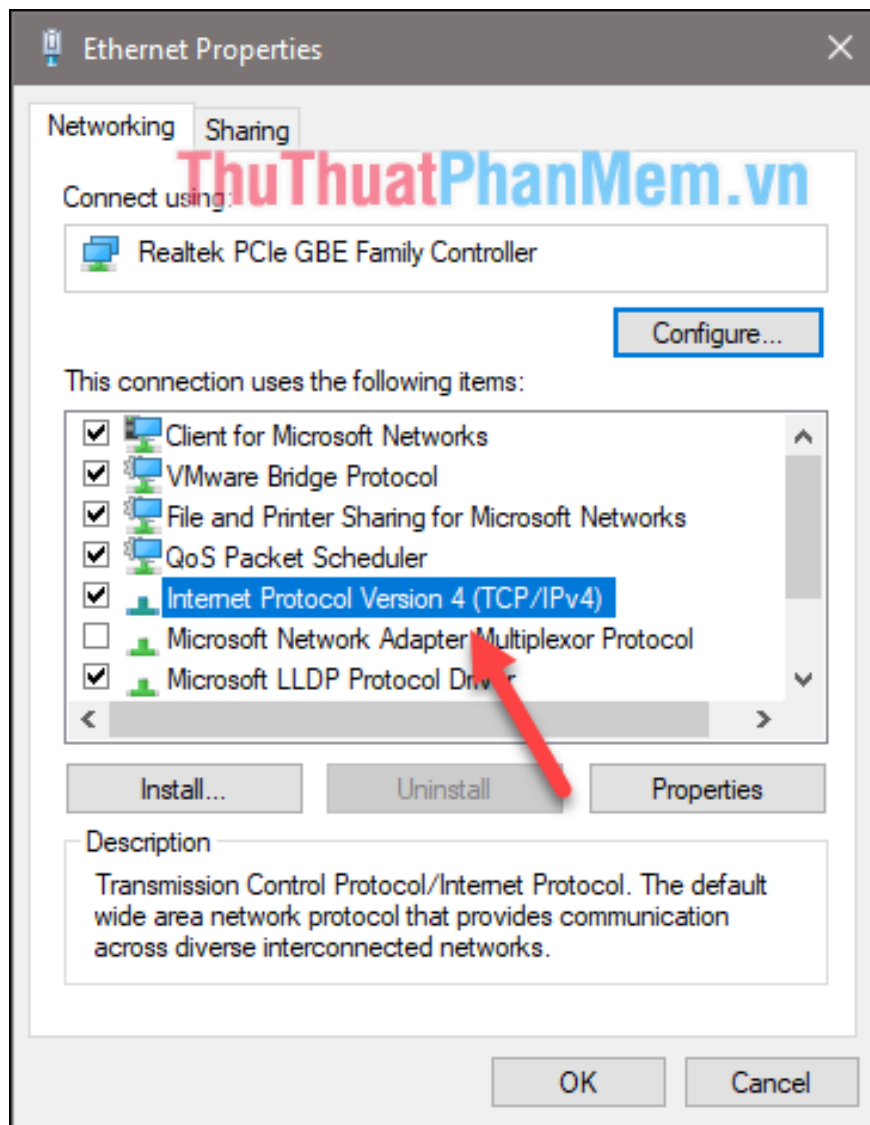
**Step 3 :** Click on the name of the **Connections** .



**Step 4 :** A new window appears, select **Properties**.

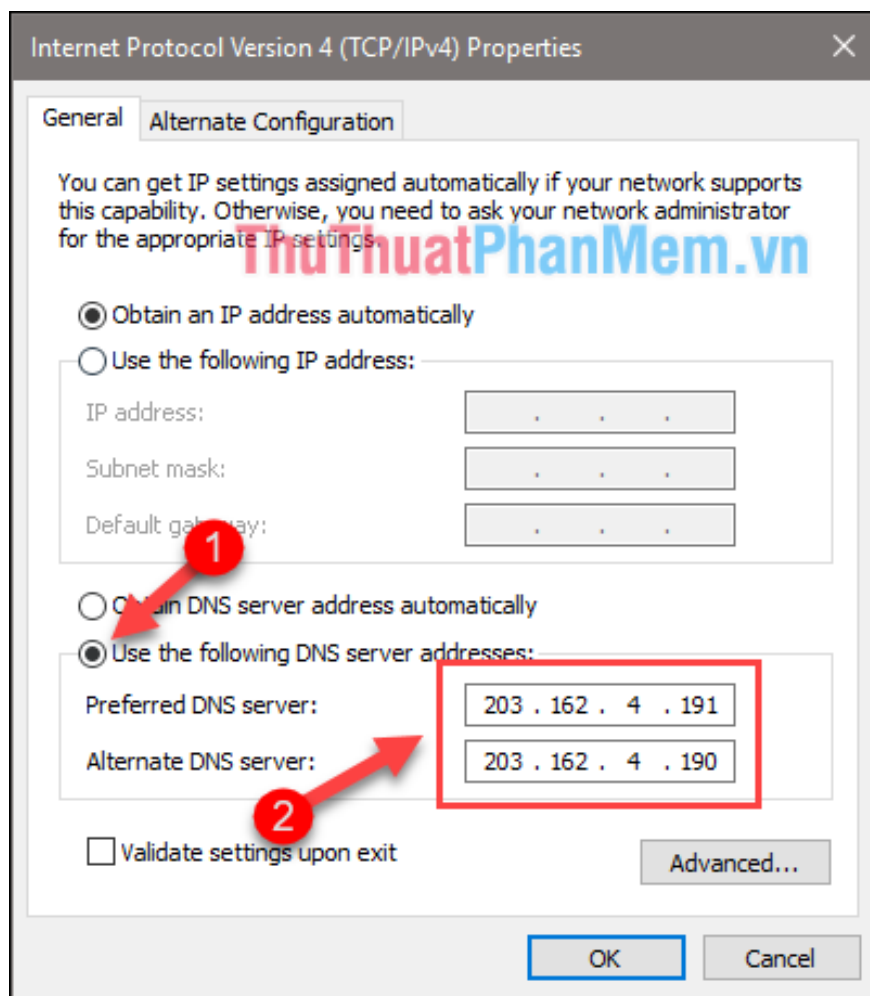


**Step 5 :** Double click on **Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP / Ipv4)**.
