

Do not do the following if you do not want the laptop screen to be damaged

To keep the laptop screen from being damaged, please note the following and keep your computer screen in the best mode.

The laptop screen is something you have to see every day when working, so try to keep it in the best working condition. To keep it from getting damaged, please note the things that TipsMake notes below!

9 easy actions to make your laptop screen broken

Press hard on the screen

Use your finger, or any other hard, pointed object to press firmly on the screen. This method is about 90% successful, depending on your "internal work" and . "cruelty". If you are not brave enough, you can let your pet dog or cat use its claws to scratch the screen hard.

Dropping the laptop

Dropping the screen from above to the ground, making sure not only the screen but also your laptop is at risk of going to a second-hand store, or into a scrap warehouse. The higher the drop from a position, and let the screen contact the ground first, or the screen is open, the greater the chance of damage.

Apply a strong force on the computer

Close the laptop screen, and then stand or sit on it (depending on how you like!), do you see the screen go back down while you're doing that? This concavity is proportional to the possibility of screen damage.

Shoot water or food at the screen

Pour or splash food, coffee or soft drinks (carbonated, mineral salts better!) onto the screen. If you do this while the machine is working, the screen is on, the sooner the screen will "die". If the screen is not damaged, it will also be white speckled as if it has "dermatology". Touching your food-covered fingers to the screen has an equally "cool" effect!

Dropped water into the screen slot

Pour water (or any solution, including glass cleaner) into the slots on the four sides of the screen. This way, you also have the great ability to destroy the keyboard or many other parts.

Do not turn on screensaver mode

Turn off Screensaver mode and power saving mode in the operating system, then let the screen work continuously 24/24 with a single color. Bright white is probably a very interesting option if you do it this way.

Open and close the laptop too forcefully

In your spare time, you can open and close the laptop screen quickly, strongly and many times. Unfortunately, this method can only break or cut the connecting cables, and if you spend a little money to replace a new cable, the screen may work again.

Let the laptop soak in the sun and rain

Take the laptop to the garden and then let the screen dry in the sun, or leave it next to the aquarium for moisture, or leave it in a place with a lot of dust. When the screen is broken, no one will be able to find out the reason for its failure, if you do it this way. In case you do not have free time during the day, in the evening, take your computer out to sit under a high-pressure lamp that is equally valuable.

Try to explore the interior of the laptop

Get the PC repair kit, remove the screws, and then open the monitor to see how it's installed. At least after reassembling you can also make the screen no longer "stand still".

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
