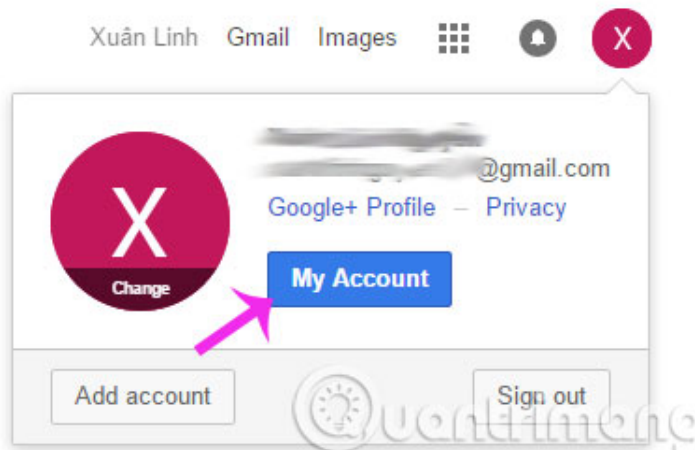

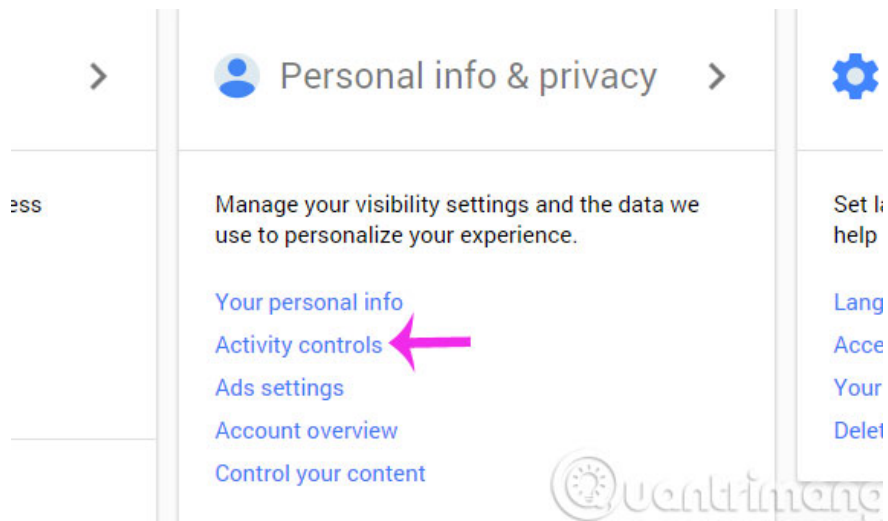

First, log in to your Google account and then click **My Account**



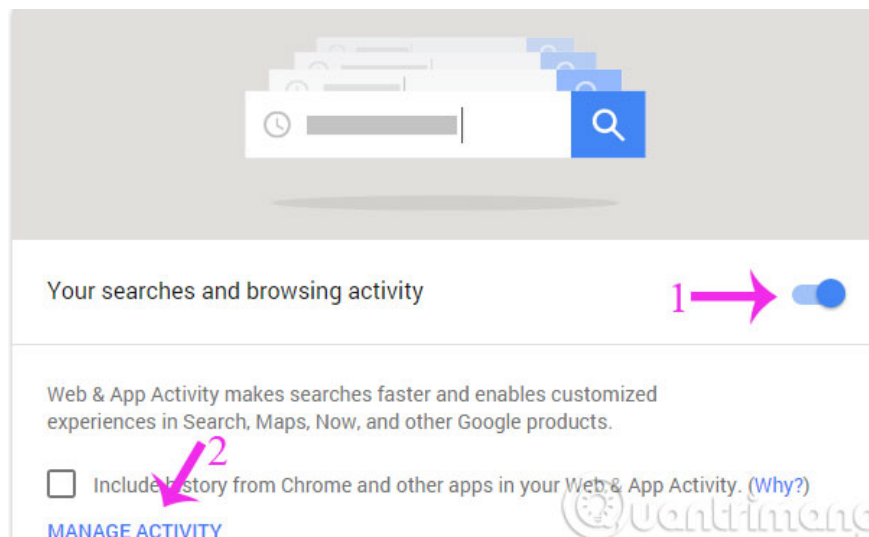
Next, click on the **Activity Controls** in the **Personal info & privacy** section

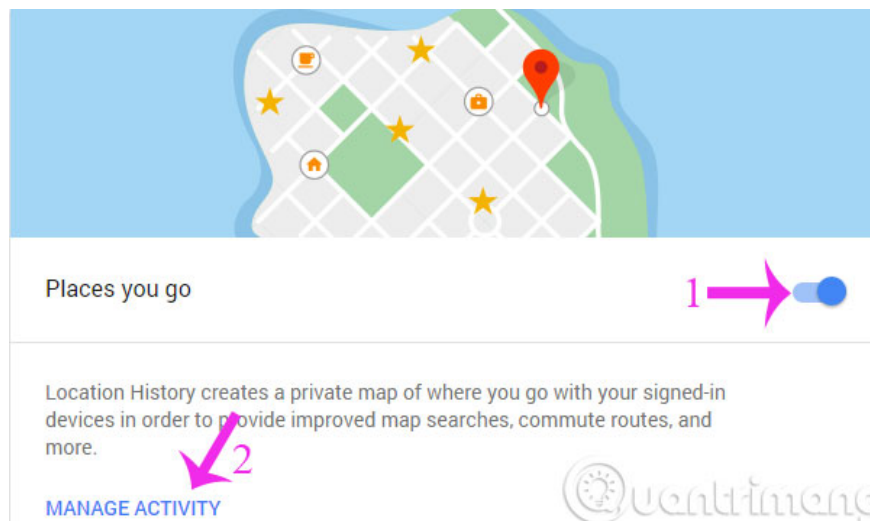


2- The location you visit

You can know which locations you have visited if "trot" using **Google Maps** by turning **ON** and clicking **Manage Activity** in **Places you go (paused)**



3- Listen to the command in Google Now again

All the commands you use with **Google Now** are recorded by Google and to listen to them again, you can turn **ON** and click **Manage Activity** under **Your voice searches and commands** .




