

Doing as smartphones, tablets dirty and wet?

Wipe the screen safe for smartphones and tablets?

To clean your smartphone and tablet screens, use a soft, lint-free cloth. You should fold the really thin cloth. Never use paper towels or towels with paper ingredients as this will scratch the screen. To clean the fingerprints, dust, gently wipe with a very thin, dry cloth.

When the screen gets ink, food, makeup

If the screen is infected with lots of difficult stains, turn off your device. If it is convenient, remove the battery. Then, gently wipe the thin cloth with clean water and gently wipe the screen, then wipe it with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid dampening the speaker or mic. If the stains remain, you can use more liquid and soap mixtures. When your smartphone or tablet is completely dry, install the battery and turn on your device.

Do not use detergent

You absolutely must not use window cleaners, other cleaning chemicals or solvents to clean smartphones and tablets and should not spray or spray directly on the screen. Some screens like the iPad and iPhone have a special coating, and if you use non-specialized detergents, this class will be lost.

Do not use a hair dryer to dry

If your device is damp, immediately turn it off and remove the battery. Then let it dry, then turn it on, not use a hair dryer or microwave to dry. Some argue that putting wet equipment in a bowl of rice may reduce the humidity of the device, but this method has not yet been verified. There are also several sets of drying products for moistened devices.
