

Don't buy headphones if they lack this important function!

When shopping for a new pair of headphones, your specific requirements will be different from everyone else's. However, there is one important feature that you should not ignore.

Headphones have come a long way. Now, they are integrated with many features such as noise cancellation and indispensable convenient connection tricks.

What is Multipoint connectivity in headphones?

Multipoint connectivity in Bluetooth headsets is exactly what it sounds like. Using this feature, you can connect headphones, earbuds, speakers or any supported device to at least two source devices.



For example, if you're using headphones with Multipoint connectivity with your laptop, you can pair them with your phone at the same time. When you switch audio sources on your device, such as switching from watching YouTube on your laptop to listening to music on your phone, the headphones will automatically switch.

The many variations and implementations of this technology vary by manufacturer, but the core concept remains the same. Multipoint connectivity isn't perfect and has some limitations, such as only being able to listen to one audio source despite being connected to multiple sources, but overall it does its job well.

How does Multipoint connectivity help in everyday use?

Do you wonder what makes this technology so invaluable? Try to remember the last time you tried to unpair your headphones from one device to connect to another!

Unlike the old 3.5mm headphone cable, which can be plugged or unplugged at any time, Bluetooth takes a few seconds to connect or disconnect.

If you have connected a Bluetooth headset to your laptop and receive a phone call, you will have to spend a few minutes struggling trying to switch devices or answer the phone. Depending on how often you need to switch between devices, this can be a bit of a pain.



In this case, you'll need to switch the Sony WF-1000XM3 between your laptop and phone every time you leave your dorm desk or receive a call. Doing so many times is too troublesome. Since upgrading to the Sony WH-CH720N with Multipoint connectivity, pairing the headset with devices has become a thing of the past.

Most Bluetooth devices will automatically connect to the previous device they were paired with. In the case of Multipoint connectivity, the headset connects to both the PC and laptop at the same time, so juggling between devices is no longer a problem. If a call is received on the phone, the headset will automatically switch and then switch back when the call is disconnected.

Overall, Multipoint connectivity is a quality-of-life feature that you'll really appreciate if you want to use your headphones for everything. Depending on how much you're willing to spend on headphones, it's worth spending more if possible.
