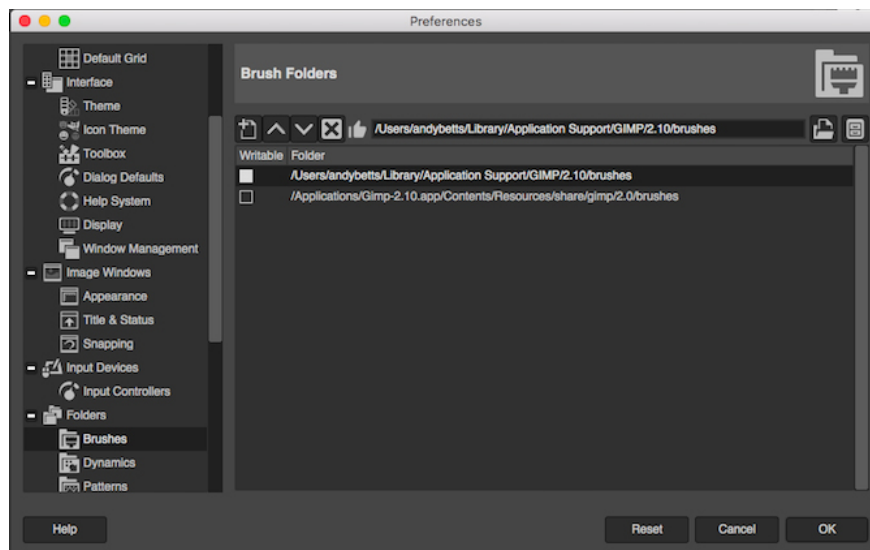

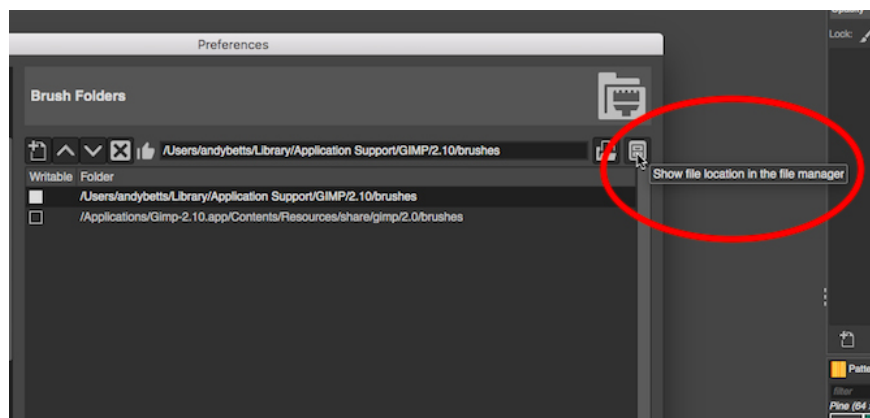

How to install the brush on GIMP

In GIMP, you can manually set the brush by pasting them into the **Brushes** folder. The location of this directory will vary depending on the operating system you use, such as Windows, Linux or Mac, but finding it on these platforms is also relatively easy.



In GIMP, go to **Preferences**> **Folders** and click on the + icon to expand **Folders** , then select **Brushes** . You will see two directories here, one is the system directory, ignore this directory. Two is the user directory, this is where you need to paste the brush.



To quickly open the Brushes folder, select it and click on the icon with the icon like the one on the right of the **Show file location in the file manager** window, then paste the brush here.

GIMP Brush has three file formats:

1. **GBR** : the most popular format, used for color brushes and regular brushes.
2. **GIH**: used for dynamic brushes created from images with multiple layers.
3. **VBR** : vector brush can adjust the size according to user needs.

You can also use Photoshop brushes in ABR format.

When pasting a brush into a folder, create a new subfolder to organize everything neatly. Name this folder as a hair brush or texture brush.

Once finished, open the **Brush** dialog and access the **Menu Brushes**> **Refresh Brushes** . You can select the brush from this dialog box. To change the brush size use the options box in the bottom right corner or use the square brackets key ([and]).

Now that you know how to install brush on GIMP, look at the following beautiful brush sets.

Beautiful free brushes for GIMP

1. 37 brush trees



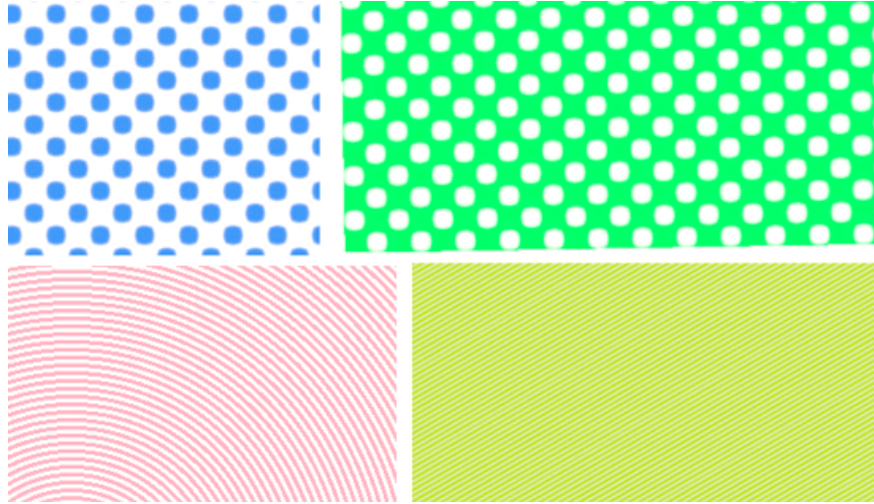
This brush set consists of 37 trees with high resolution and looks very similar. It has at least 16 different types of trees with opposite directions such as Christmas fir trees, golden autumn trees, etc. Each of these trees is about 1,000 pixels wide, so it is suitable for demanding projects. Highest resolution.

2. Brush irises



The brushes for this iris help you easily change the eye color for the model. It includes 9 colors to choose from. By setting **Blend** mode to **Overlay** or **Screen** , you can combine it with the original eye to create a realistic effect.

3. Micro model brush



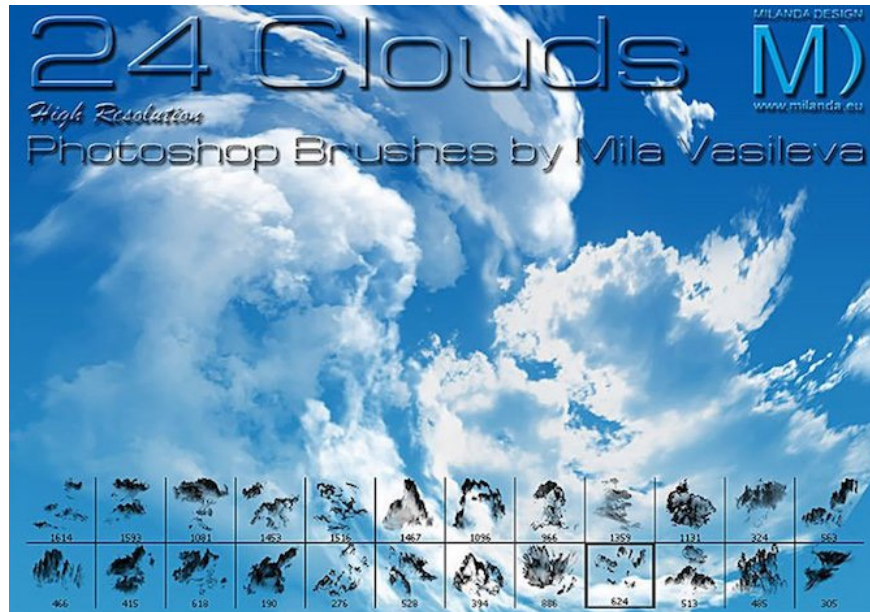
If you use GIMP for graphic design, you probably can't ignore this brush set because it will save you time. This brush set has 31 styles: dots, stripes, waves, zigzags, etc. . suitable for creating backgrounds or Lichtenstein-style Port art.

4. Brush the water



To create a water effect that looks like real is not an easy task, but thanks to this water brush set you can create it quickly and efficiently. Although only two brushes are received, it can help you create "ripples" on a flat surface before, combined with varying sizes, weights, and color waves, you will have a water surface. looks real.

5. 24 cloud brushes



Creating photos with true sky is not easy, but with this cloud brush will help you a lot. It includes 24 different cloud types for you to choose from. These clouds have a color that has a white one for you to mix with some dark gray clouds that show a stormy scene or a little orange for the sunset.

6. Brush the flying bird



Another way to make your sky more interesting is to add a few birds on it. This brush set provides 22 types of birds with different flying postures. You can change the color of these birds to match your design. But let them be small and dark to be of good quality when used in photos.

7. 20 PS fire brushes



Fire is common in graphic design but it is painful to draw it from scratch. This 20 flame brush set will solve the problem for you. These brushes can be used alone, but if you stack some brushes with other colors on its layers, you'll create a spectacular fire scene.

These brushes are in ABR format, it is designed for use with Photoshop but you can also use them for GIMP.

8. Brush light beam



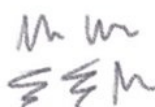
This brush set has 26 light beam variations, which simplifies the process of adding lighting effects to your artwork. It includes light rays, reflected light, torches, lighthouses, etc. These brushes are in high resolution mode, so you don't need to worry about quality when using for love projects. high demand.

9. Brush pencil

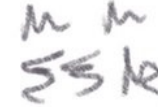

If you use GIMP to sketch, you won't be able to find a better brush set than this pencil brush. It has only three pencils of different sizes, but with the right Force settings, you can absolutely bring a sense of authenticity like when using a real pencil.

10. Brush oil paint

JON NEIMEISTER DIGITAL OILS

This brush pack contains 8 main brushes with 8 different modes each allowing for a wide variety of painterly brush strokes, as well as a handful of smoother brushes for rendering, and texture brushes for adding grit.

The different brush modes help to replicate the complex nature of real paint, to make it easier to find the right brush, all 8 of the main brushes follow this pattern:

- Separator** - For visual clarity, this box separates the different brush types
- Brush Type** - Fat, Flat, Round, Flat 2, and Flat 3
- Thin** - Very little paint is loaded on the brush, for smoother strokes
- Thick** - A lot of paint is loaded on the brush, for chunkier strokes
- Wet** - The paint is thinned down, covering more canvas and seems transparent
- Dry** - The paint is straight from the tube, more opaque and more textured
- Clean** - The brush paints with only your foreground color, making pure colored strokes
- Dirty** - The brush paints with both foreground and background colors, based on pen pressure

TIPS

The "Dirty" brushes are best for authentic wet in / wet / blended strokes, put one color in the FO switch, the other in the BG, then use pressure to mix them.

For the most convincing results, use the same process as you would with oils. Begin with an underpainting, and paint on a layer above it so you can scratch out the wet paint on top and let some of the underpainting show through.

Constantly vary your brush direction and pressure for less obviously digital strokes.

Pay attention to your stroke direction. Most of the brushes have a hard edge on one side and a soft edge on the other, so which direction you paint is important.

These brushes are of high quality and provide a professional feel to users. It offers 5 standard brushes with variations to easily fit into different parts and paint sizes. You can even mix these paint colors together by combining the foreground and background colors.

11. Brush watercolor



If you're looking for a watercolor brush, download this brush right away. Although there is only one brush, it is designed like a real brush using real water colors.
