

Download 2.8 million high-quality images from the Smithsonian Institution of the United States for free

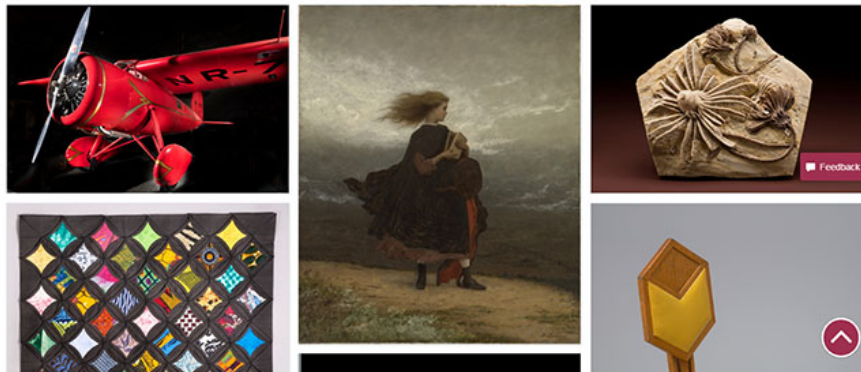
The trend of digitizing and sharing image data publicly has been strongly responded by many storage facilities and museums.

The Smithsonian Institution, also known as the Smithsonian for short, is a long-standing museum and research center managed by the US Government. The Smithsonian Institution was established on August 10, 1846 with the aim of 'strengthening and disseminating knowledge' to the community, and has now become one of the most important cultural and educational institutions in the country. this.

Recently, the Smithsonian Institution has publicly released a huge archive of 2.8 million high-quality 2-dimensional and 3-dimensional images related to different areas of life, and especially unlimited. access and allow free download for personal use.

These images are from 19 Smithsonian museums, 9 research centers, libraries, and archives from the US National Zoo. These include extremely valuable materials that can be used as very useful study and research materials, with content spanning many areas, including science and culture.

Notably, all of these images are uploaded under the Creative Commons Zero (CC0) license, which means that without any copyright restrictions, anyone can use it freely.

The Smithsonian Institute says it plans to release 200,000 additional images publicly this year, and of course there is no copyright restriction, bringing the total number of documents released to the public to 3 million.

This is only a small part (about 2%) of the photo documents that the Smithsonian Institution is hosting. In the future, the institute plans to digitize all of the 155 million photos they've stored for nearly 200 years.

In early February, the largest museum complex in France Paris Musées also shared publicly and allowed free download of 150,000 copies of painting. Two weeks ago, Google continued to share more than 1,000 beautiful wallpapers with themes of the world landscape on the Earth View collection. All have received positive support from the public.
