

Download Chrome 64, try making silent video autoplay to see

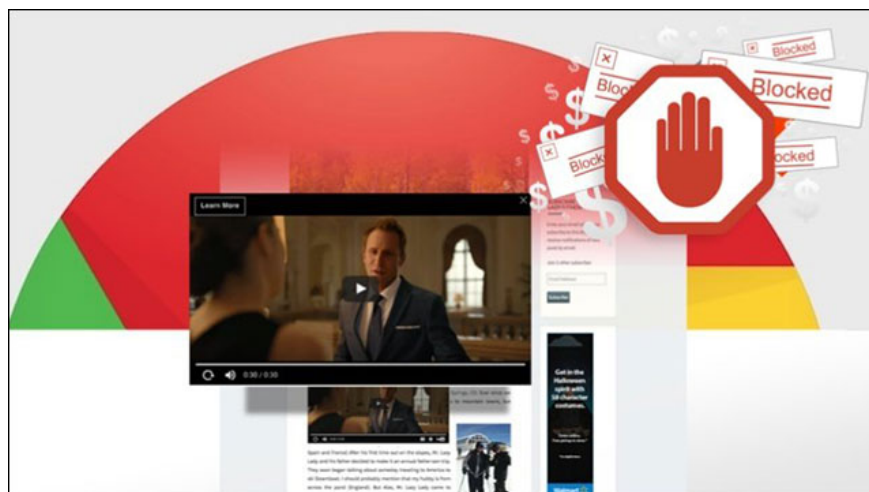
No longer bothered by spontaneous videos in the browser.

In September, Google said that Chrome 64 will fix a problem that users are very interested in because it makes them very uncomfortable, it is auto-broadcast content, most importantly the ability to disable video autoplay.

If you want to experience this feature right away, you can start downloading Chrome 64 Beta.

Google said the ability to automatically block video playback is part of Chrome's overall advertising block effort that it has been working on for a while. The official version will be released in January.

However, automatic content blocking does not apply simultaneously to all websites that you will have to set up for each page. But the good point is that it will also block any content that is on the subpage that you are redirected from the main domain.

In addition, according to page *9to5Google*, Chrome 64 also improved pop-up blocker, added security methods to avoid being redirected to malicious pages, support HDR video playback when turning on HDR mode on Windows 10. On Chrome OS also features screen splitting to do many things on multiple windows at once.
