## 4. Reasons why you will love Windows 10

- Improved Start menu: Microsoft has added Live Tiles and allows users to drag tiles around, or resize and remove them with a right-click.
- Running Modern UI applications on the desktop: Open a Modern UI application on the desktop just like any other application, using the usual window size controls in the upper right corner of the window.
- Cortana: Search for files on your computer and online information, or add events to your calendar.
- Multitasking with Task View: Working with multiple windows is much easier. Press **Alt + Tab** or click the **Task View** button on the Task Bar to see all open windows.

- Work with multiple desktops: Create multiple virtual desktops and switch between them easily.
- Aero Snap upgrade: Capture windows on the left and right halves of the screen, or drag windows to a corner to capture them in a quarter-screen angle.
- Never miss any notifications: Notifications are saved in the new Action Center.
- Battery saving: Activate **Battery Saver** and it will limit your PC's power usage by closing unnecessary applications and reducing brightness to save as much energy as possible.
- Improved Command Prompt: Easily resize windows and their content (instead of disappearing behind a scroll bar), select, cut, and copy text using the mouse, and take advantage of keyboard shortcuts.

## **5. Minimum system requirements for installing Windows 10**

- CPU: Compatible 1 GHz or faster processor, or System on a Chip (SoC).
- RAM: 1 GB for 32-bit or 2 GB for 64-bit.
- HDD: 32 GB or larger.
- Graphics card: Compatible with DirectX 9 or later with WDDM 1.0 driver.
- Resolution: 800x600.
- Network connection: Internet connection is required to perform updates, as well as to download and utilize certain features.
