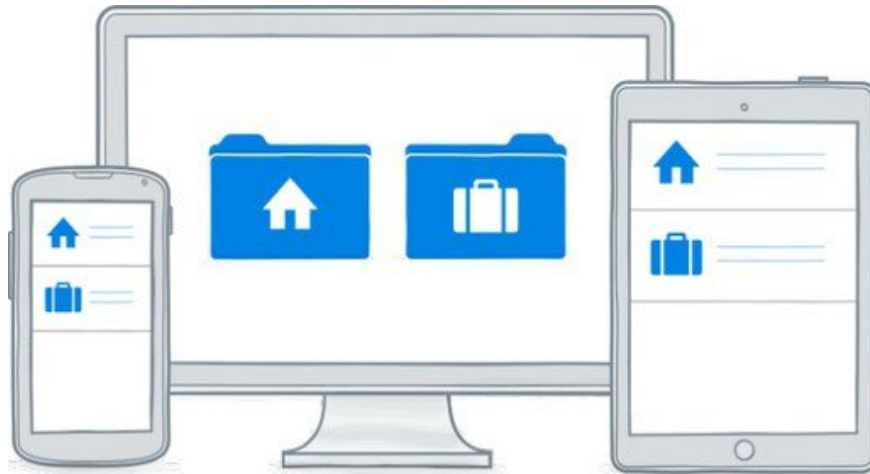


Dropbox cloud storage service will support multiple accounts in April
