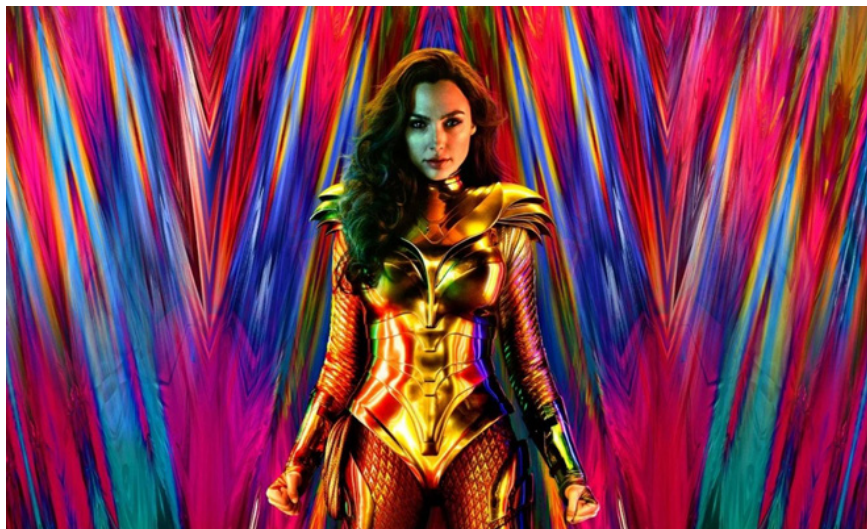


## Due to COVID-19, Wonder Woman 1984 may not hit theaters and only stream applications

It won't be available until early June, but it is possible that the cinemas will still be closed due to the epidemic!

In the past, the fact that a movie was produced but ultimately did not open in theaters, but could only see through streaming applications, showed that the film had failed from its inception. But in the context of the COVID-19 epidemic, which is still raging today, even the blockbusters of a big producer like Wonder Woman 1984 may have to do the same.



This information was published by *The Warp* , under which Warner Pictures chairman Toby Emmerich and senior advisers were discussing whether this was a viable option. Director Patty Jenkins and producer Charles Roven have not even participated in this discussion.

As planned, Wonder Woman 1984 will be released on June 4, or about 3 months. Some sources said that the company had planned to leave the calendar until August, but no later than 2 months, no one was sure what the situation would be like.



Contrary to the aforementioned information, Warner Bros film distribution president Jeff Goldstein said that there was no studio release. Producer Charles Roven even called the film premiere online a 'crazy' idea, and the only way for a successful film worldwide was a grand premiere.

Indeed, these claims are well grounded. As a sequel to a very successful film, about a famous DC heroine, Wonder Woman 1984 can easily bring in more than \$ 1 billion for Warner Bros. It is impossible to make such a large amount of money by publishing it online. Now all we can expect is that the COVID-19 epidemic will be pushed back, and the Wonder Woman 1984 can be enjoyed on the big screen!
