

Dwarf mushrooms want to increase height when taking photos? Use a heightened 'cheat' way like Mark Zuckerberg

Many people will assume that Mark Zuckerberg is said to have a professional photography team to record his images or he used something to cheat his height like wearing vertical stripes or wearing padded shoes high (or Timberlands shoes). But in fact, Mark doesn't need to use those ways, but he has applied some "visual trick"

tricks to be able to "cheat" his height in divine "virtual living" pictures. . Specifically, in photos posted on Facebook or on newspapers, Mark often chose to stand near the camera or keep himself higher than others who are walking or standing around him, however he 'distracted' viewers by standing back or slightly leaning to create the feeling that he is standing away from the camera like others. In this picture you can see that Zuckerberg has giant legs, or he stands closer to the camera.



Taking photos so that it looks much higher than others is much more difficult than taking photos so that the subject looks high in standing alone photos. Although for others, height may not be a problem, but Zuckerberg still needs to maintain his image. According to Fortune magazine, 58% of the 500 executives are over 180cm. But looking at these photos, Zuckerberg looked taller, even higher than the "giant" Bill Gates (1m80) when they both sat on the sofa. Why?



Let's try to see how Mark Zuckerberg's 'secret' photography is effective in reality:

Want to look taller than the person next to you, the easiest way is to choose someone who is lower than you to stand when taking photos. When shooting, you just need to stand slightly toward the camera, so you can easily make a difference in both. Or you can stand upright with the camera. In addition, shoes and a hat, we can also "cheat" the height quite a lot.



This method is extremely simple, but in life you can not always choose people who are lower than you to capture. What if you have to shoot people who are as tall or even higher than you? Surely with this type of shooting will make you "drowned" completely with the person next to you, now try to tiptoe to step closer to the camera when taking photos, when the camera is taken, you can rotate half and leaning forward to cheat height. For girls, to increase height, you can wear gaucho hat, hat . to look higher. Or . find the lowest person in the crowd to stand next to the photo.



We have found three basic tips to help you look taller when taking pictures:

Get closer to the camera, but "trick" by turning yourself a bit toward the camera to create a sense of two people standing in the same position.

Maintaining excellent shooting posture: Straight shoulder, lifting chin up, feet upright. But just like Zuckerberg, it looks very natural, not as serious.



Wear a hat, and guide it up.

Find the lowest person in the group and stand next to them.



Looking higher can not change the fact that you are low, but it can deceive the public, at least until they know your tricks.

Avoid wearing overly fancy dresses, looking simple will help you not need to be the center of the picture, but still tall, healthy!



Finally, use your fresh smile and poise, confidence to show off the lens. In this way, Mark Zuckerberg attracted every glimpse into his performance rather than his true height.
