

Edit, create effects for images in PowerPoint

Introduce how to edit images in PowerPoint. 1. Change the position and size of the image. - Rotate images in different positions - click on the image with a circle containing an arrow - hold and hold the mouse button and adjust it to the angle you want

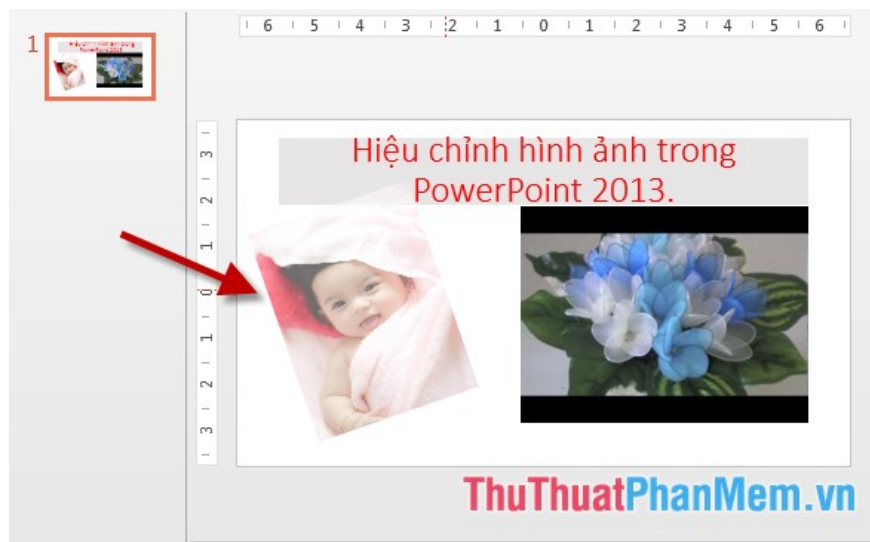
The following article introduces you to how to edit images in PowerPoint.

1. Change the position and size of the image.

- Rotate the image in different positions -> click on the image that appears with a circle containing an arrow -> hold and hold the mouse button and adjust it to the angle you want to rotate:

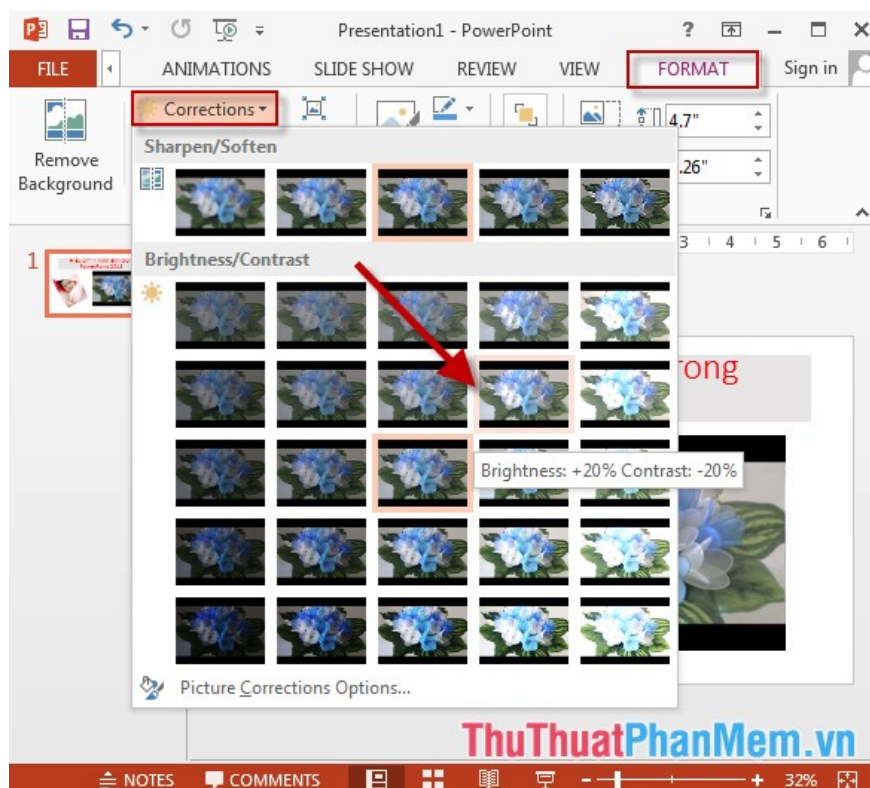


- To resize the image by clicking the white rectangle icon on the image, hold down and drag the image in the desired direction:

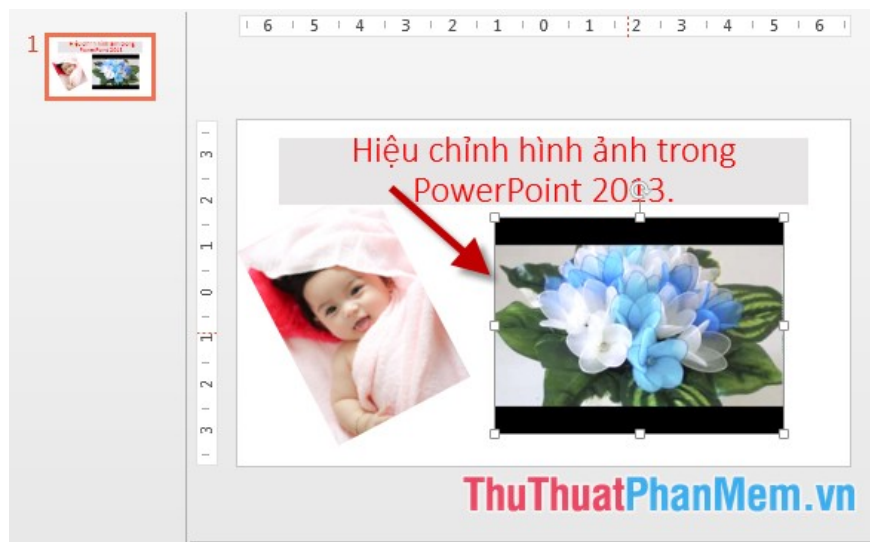


2. Change the brightness of the image.

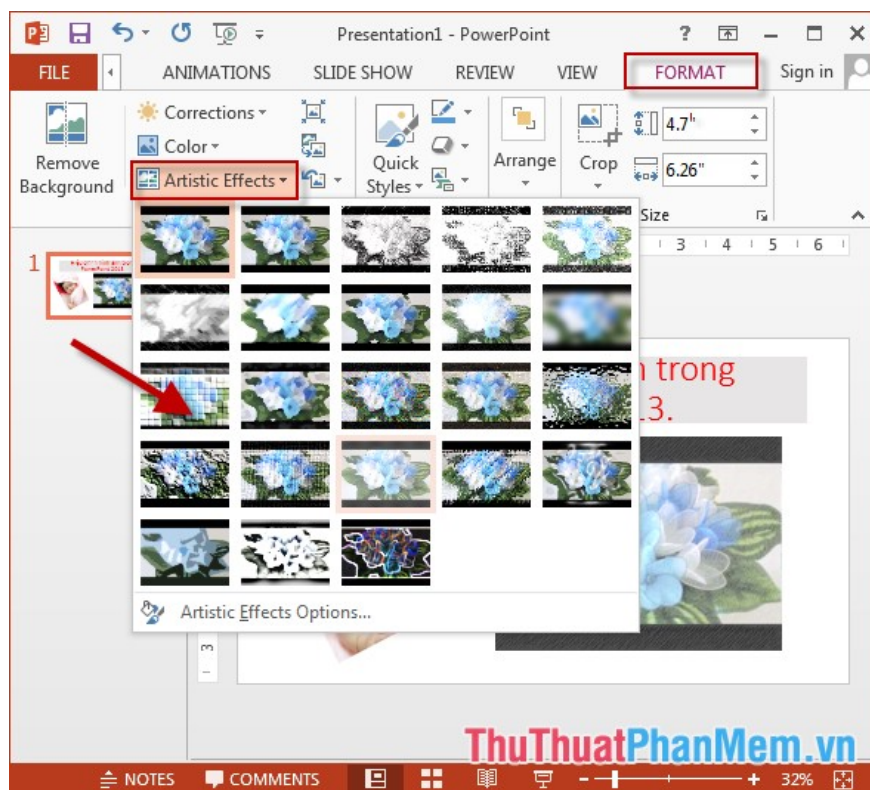
- Click on the image you want to change the brightness -> **Format** -> **Corrections** -> select the type of light and dark image you want to change:



- Image results have been changed:

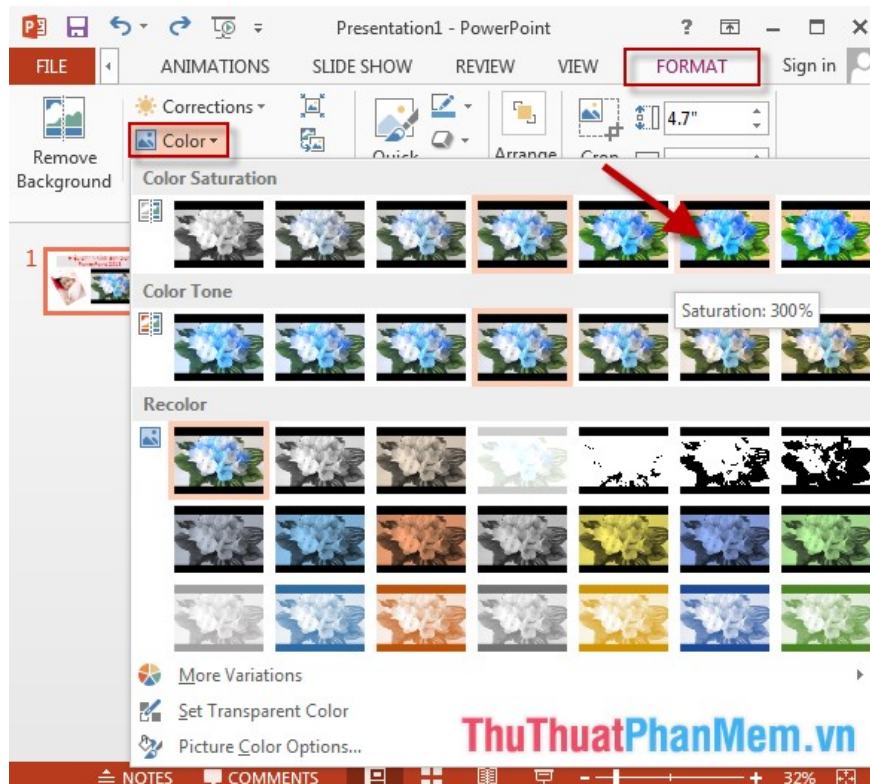


- You can click **Artistic Effects** to add some color contrast effects to the image:

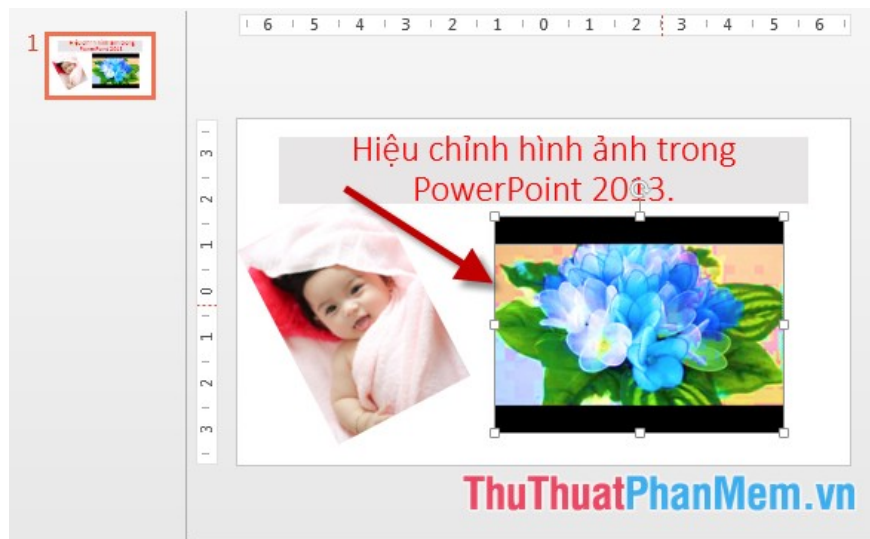


3. Change the colors for images.

- To change the color of the image, click the object -> **Format** -> **Color** -> choose a color style that suits your image:

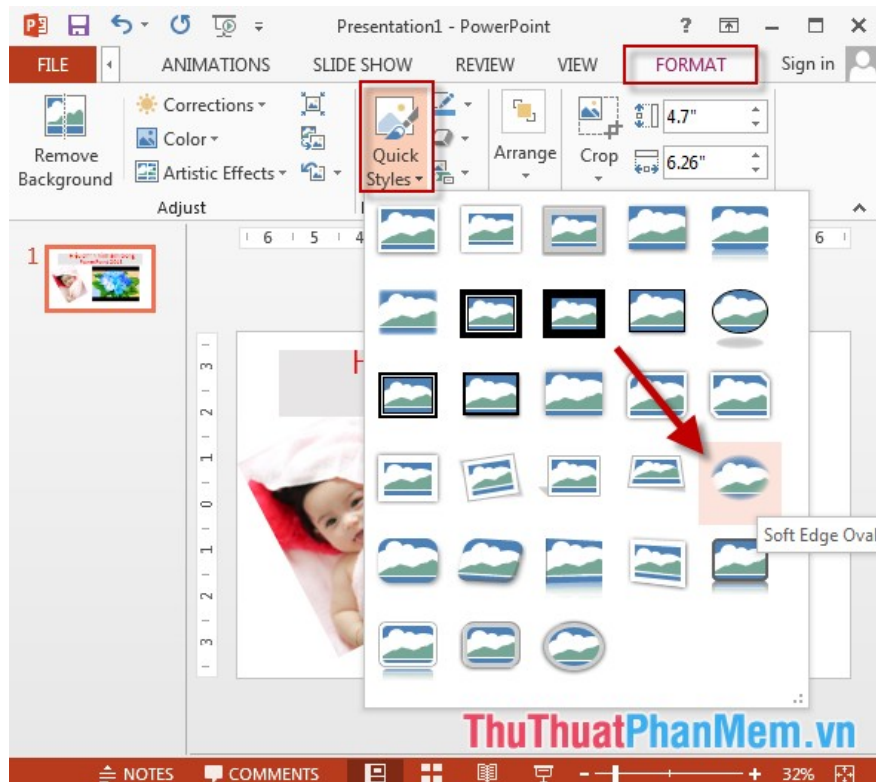


- Results after changing the color for photos:



4. Create effects for images.

- Click on the object -> **Format** -> **Quick Styles** -> choose the **Style** to create the image:

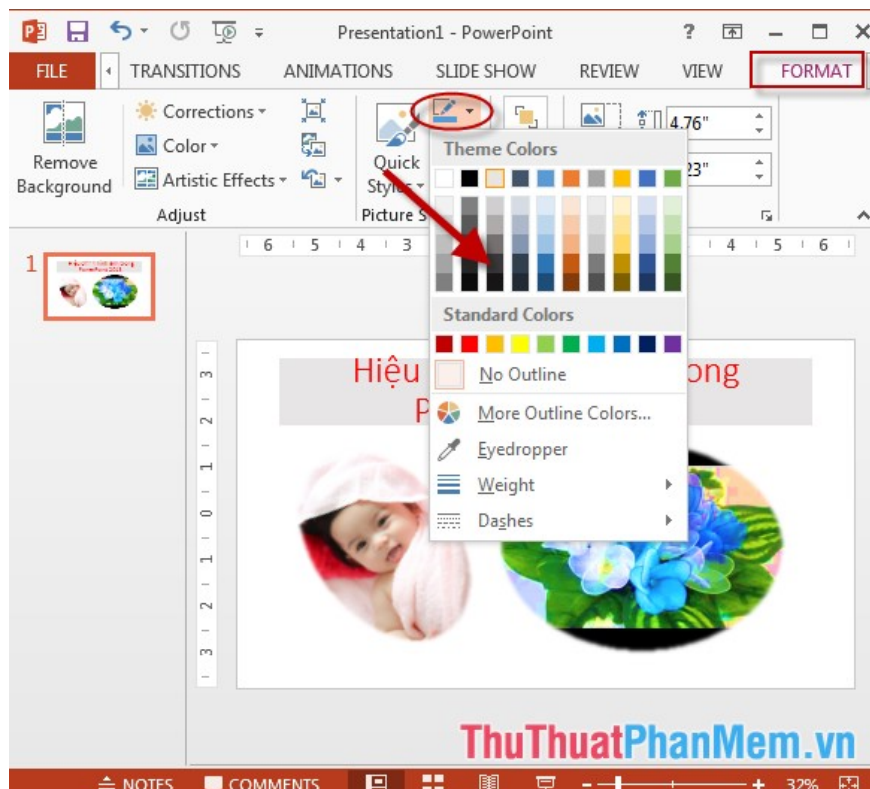


- Results after styling the image:

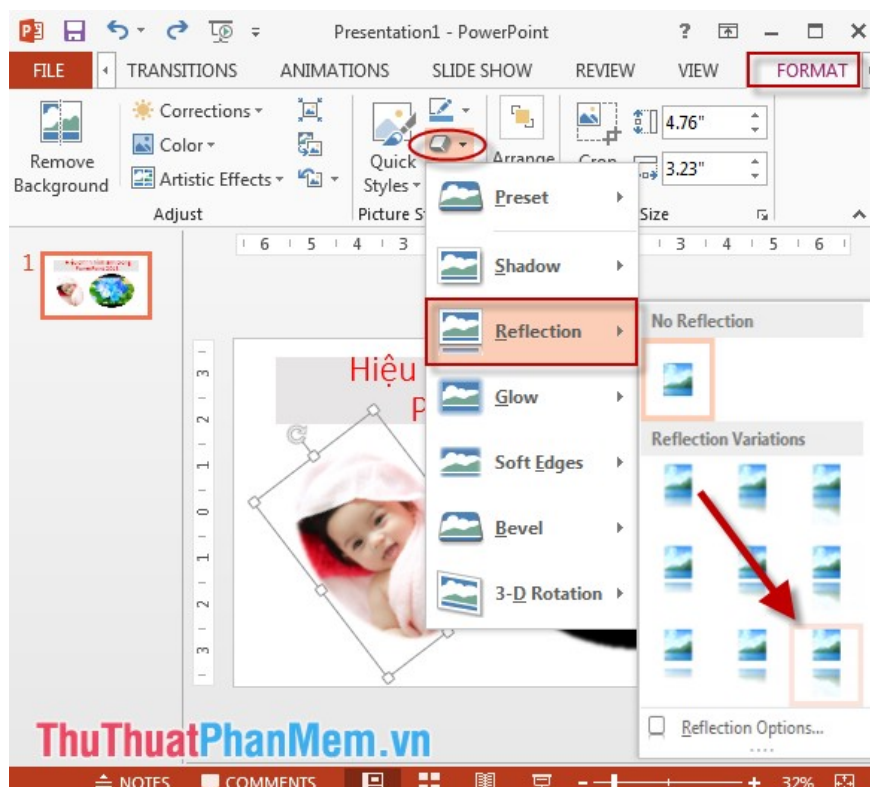


5. Change color, contour effects for images.

- Click on the object -> **Format** -> click the **Picture Color** icon -> choose a color for the image:



- To select effects for images -> go to **Format** tab -> click on **Pictures Effects** icon -> select effect type, for example here choose shadow effect for images:



- Image results after calibration:
