

# Elden Ring: Top 5 Best Great Spears and Where to Find Them

Great Spears - one of the most powerful weapons available in the Elden Ring, but where to find them earlier in the player's journey?

Great Spears are high-damage weapons and the option to attack from great distances. However, these weapons are quite heavy and reduce the player's mobility. Great Spears are also ideal for combat on horseback due to their incredible range. Fortunately, the Elden Ring offers a wide variety of Great Spears available to players.

This article lists 5 of the best Great Spears in the Elden Ring as well as their locations on the huge map of Lands Between.

## #1 - Lance



Lance is one of the most powerful Great Spears available to Elden Ring players. In addition to the usual advantages that this weapon brings, Lance can stun many enemies in the game.

In fact, if any enemies are trying to dodge when entering combat (PVP or PVE), the player can simply use basic attacks to catch them off guard. This weapon can also be combined with Ashes of War, which means the crafting variety is also quite rich.

**Location:** At the top of the Ruin structure there is a barracks with foot soldiers, Godrick Warriors, and Godrick Knights southwest of the Deathtouched Catacombs.

## #2 - Treespear



Treespear is one of those really good goddamn weapons that can appear in a variety of situations. Its scaling is also impressive, and its heavy attacks can stun enemies quite well.

This weapon can work perfectly in faith/skill oriented builds incorporated in the Elden Ring. Unfortunately, it cannot be matched by Ashes of War.

**Location: Taken from a caravan on the edge of a collapsed bridge southeast of the Liurnia of the Lakes site.**

### #3 - Siluria's Tree



This is a really powerful Great Spear that excels at heavy attack. This weapon can very well deter enemies and is a great counter-attack against aggressive opponents.

Also, its weapon skill called Siluria Woe is impressive as it can destroy a large number of enemy bosses in the game.

The only problem is that the Siluria Tree's divine damage becomes ineffective late game due to its resistance. However, it is still a good weapon, worth using in a single-player turn.

**Location: Obtained after defeating Crucible Knight Siluria in Deeproot Depths**

## #4 - Vyke's War Spear



One of the most exciting weapons available to players in most of the Elden Ring. Vyke's War Spear comes with a Madness status effect in its passive form.

This special weapon can be used for various works related to the Flame of Frenzy spell. Unfortunately, the status effect also reduces the variety of buildings available to the player in the game. Overall, Vyke's War Spear is a decent weapon and an interesting one.

**Location: Taken from Festering Fingerprint Vyke**

## #5 - Moghwyn's Sacred Spear



Of the Great Spears available to players in the Elden Ring, Moghwyn's Sacred Spear is probably the weapon that offers the most value.

Firstly, the weapon comes with a passive bleeding status effect, which is extremely effective against most enemies in the game. Second, the weapon art "Bloodboon Ritual" is super powerful and can kill enemies in PVE.

Finally, when it comes to PVP, this weapon is so underpowered that players have requested a nerf since its release. This is due to the fact that one can hit an enemy once when this weapon is used properly.
