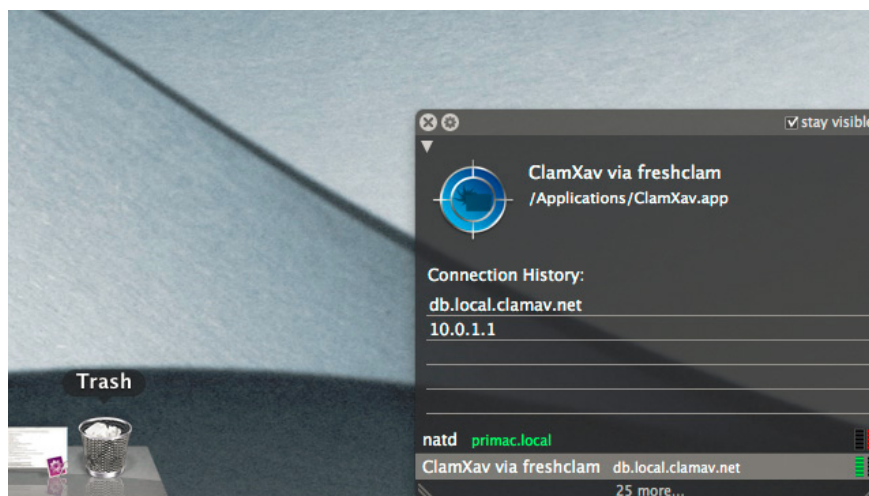

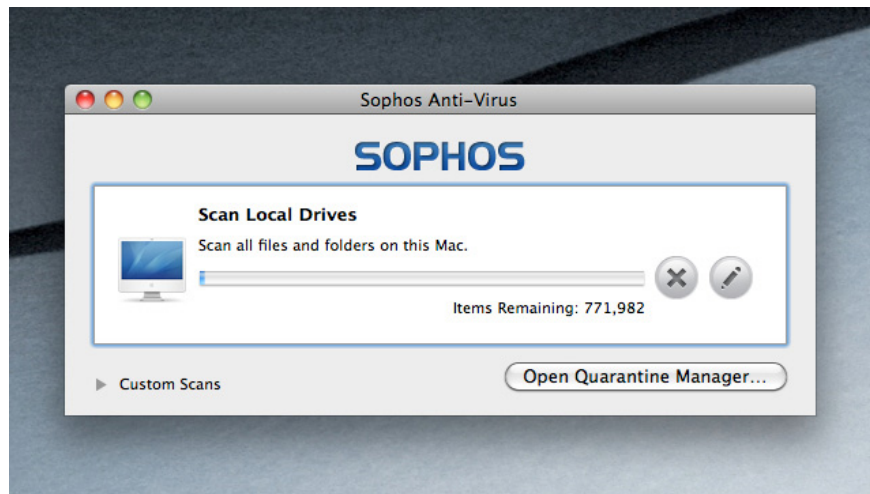

1. Little Snitch:



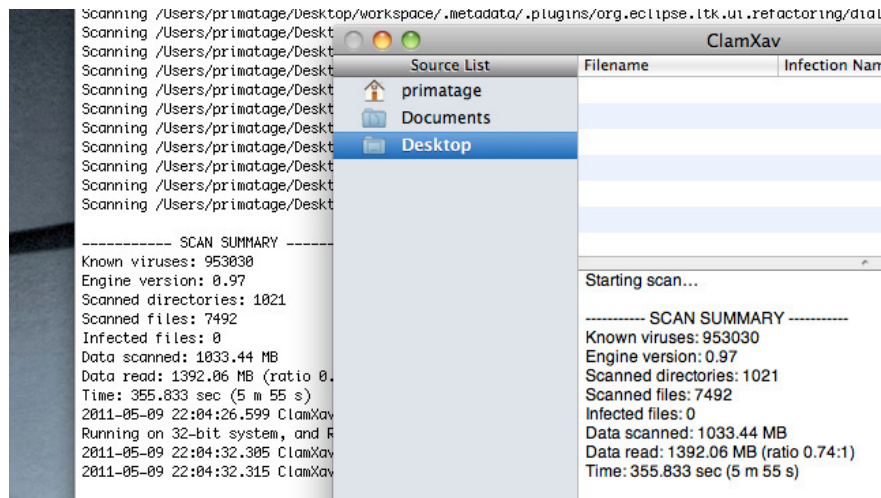

Every time an application makes a connection request, Little Snitch will display a pop-up window asking the user to accept or reject the program's activity, accompanied by a temporary selection or permanently accept, set up rules - fixed rules. Besides, Little Snitch also has the function to display exactly what activities are going on, programs that are 'communicating' over the Internet. The program has a trial period, and the price is \$ 29.99 copyright.

2. Sophos Free Antivirus for Mac:



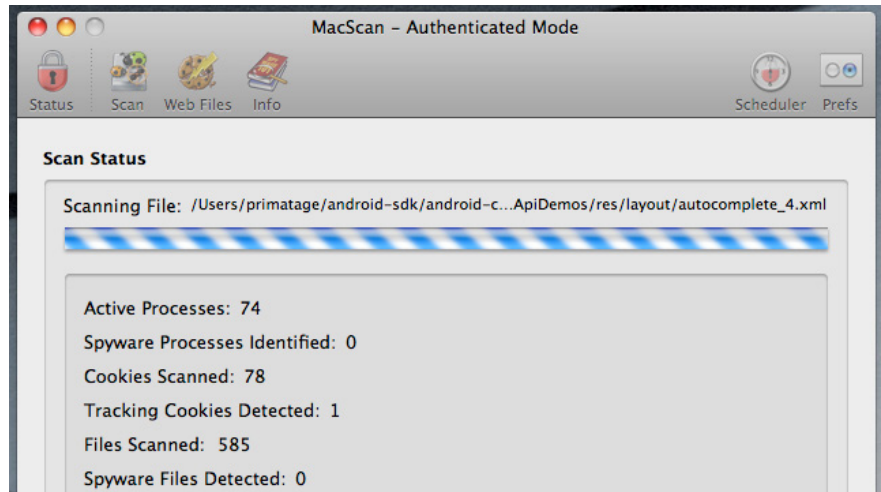

3. ClamXav:



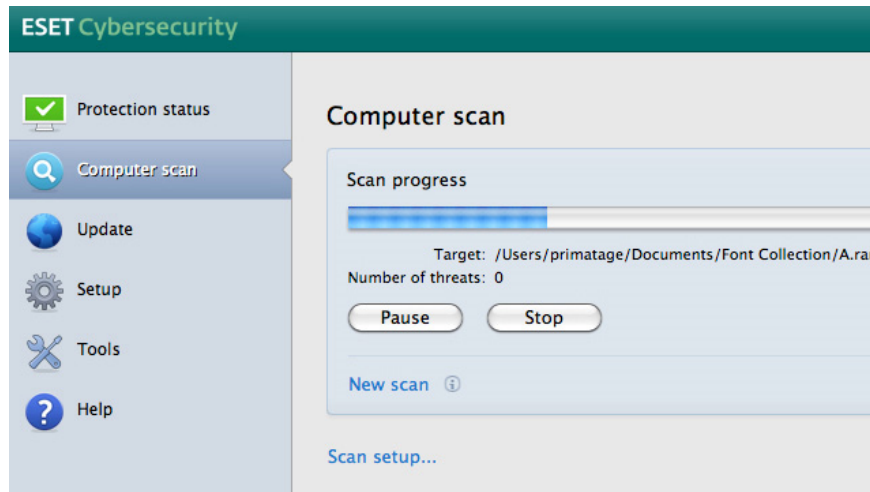

4. MacScan;



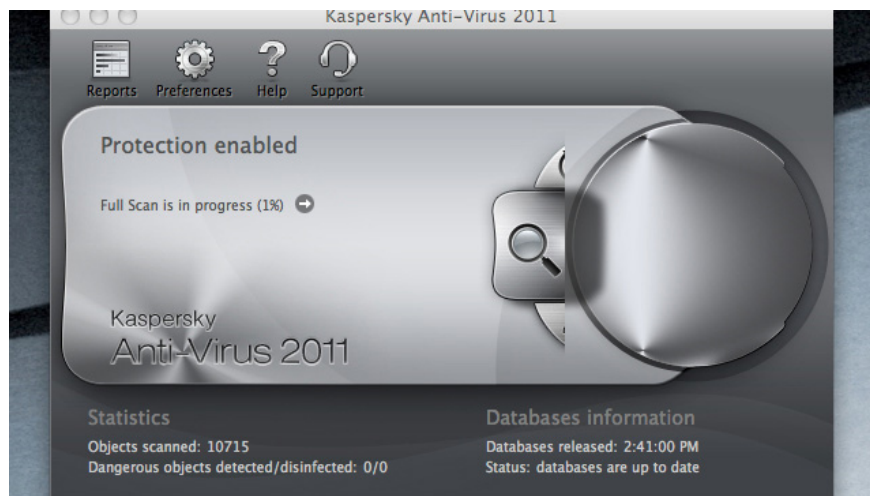

On the other hand, if you want to upgrade to a fully functional version (with a price of \$ 29.99), it will be difficult to implement, so the free version is still used by most people.
