What is MySQL? MySQL is a database management system, ideal for both small and large applications, supporting SQL standards.

PHP and MySQL: MySQL PHP combined with cross-platform (you can develop in Windows and serve on a UNIX platform).

Why use PHP? PHP runs on different platforms (Windows, Linux, Unix .), compatible with almost all currently used servers (Apache, IIS .), free to download from sources Official PHP.

To gain access to a PHP-powered web server, you need to install **Apache** (or IIS) on your own server, install PHP, and MySQL or find a web server with PHP support feature and MySQL.
