

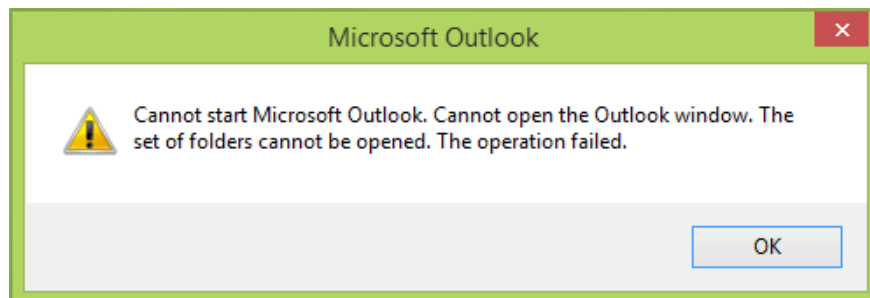
Error cannot open Outlook, this is a fix

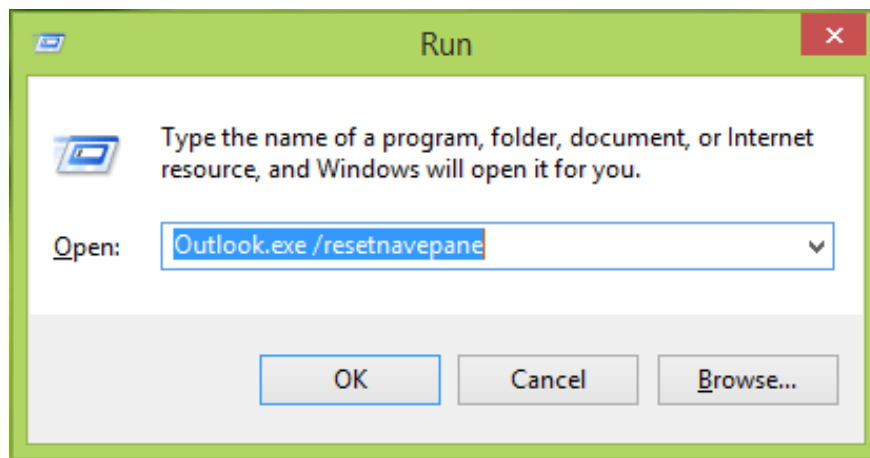

Could not open Outlook:

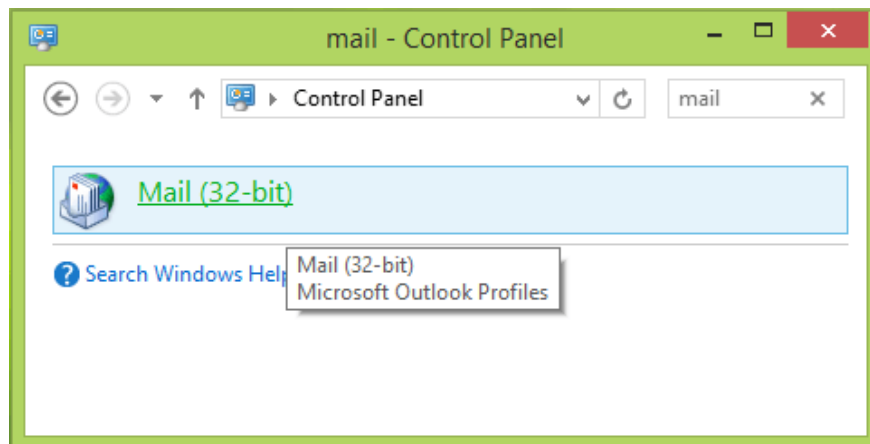
1. Press the **Windows + R** key combination to open the Run command window. Here you enter the command line below and press Enter:

Outlook.exe / resetnavpane



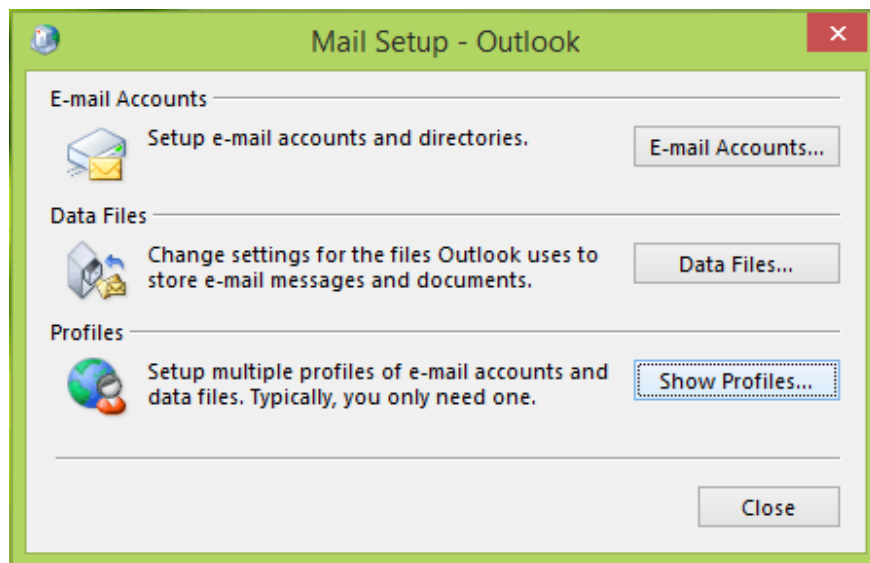
Now Outlook will start reinstalling the profile configuration to fix the error.

2. Open Control Panel then enter the **mail** keyword in the Search Control Panel and press Enter.

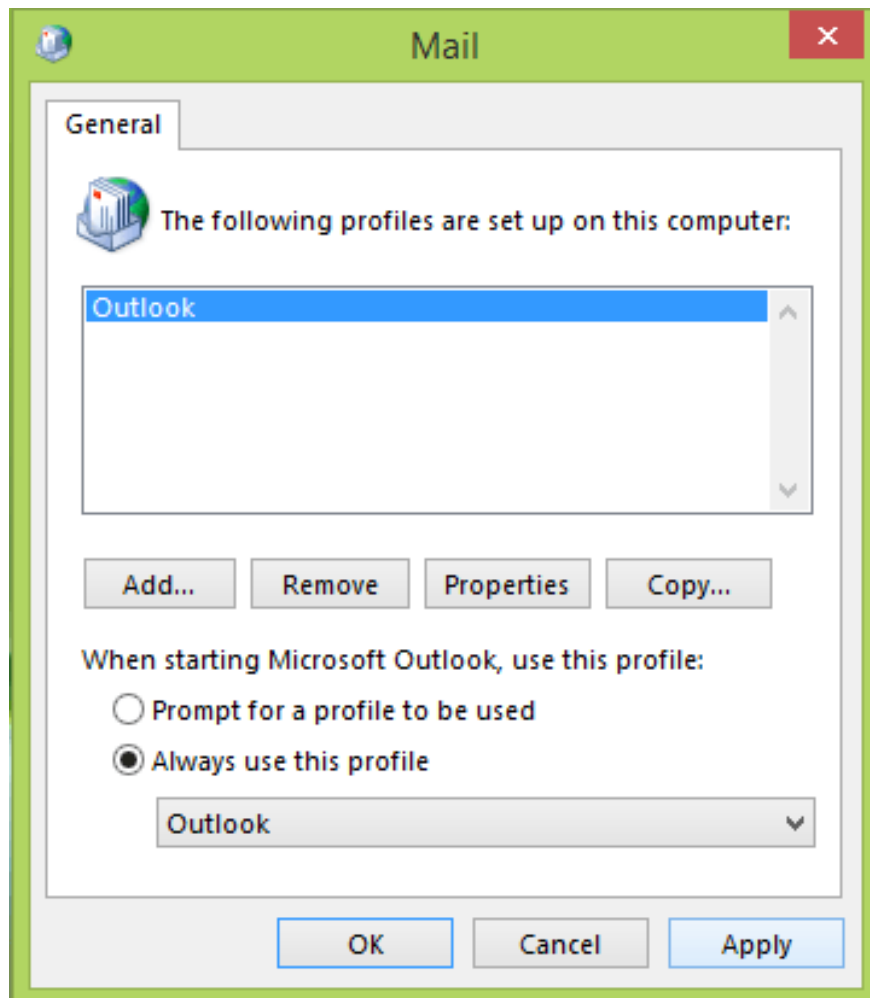


Next click on the **Mail** icon .

Now on the Mail Setup-Outlook screen, here click **Show Profiles** .



Next on the Mail window, add your new profile, then select **Always use this profile** and add a new profile from the dropdown menu.



Click **Apply** then click **OK**.

Finally restart your computer and proceed to reopen Outlook if it is okay.
